This Officer further states the facts below are based on personal knowledge and/or interviews with witnesses, fellow Peace Officers and/or review of official Law Enforcement reports. The above listed crime(s) committed on June 13, 2010, at the location of Kiowa/Bennett Road and County Road 194, Town of Bennett, Incorporated Unincorporated (check one) Elbert County and State of Colorado. 2. The suspect was arrested at 1714 hours on the 18th day of December, 2017. 3. The brief facts in support of the probable cause for the warrantless arrest of the above named suspect are as follows: On 6/14/10, Elbert County Sheriff's deputies responded to the area of Kiowa-Bennett Road and County Road 194, unincorporated Elbert County, town of Kiowa, state of Colorado, for a suspicious death on the southwest corner of Kiowa-Bennett and County Road 194. Original Elbert County The victim was identified as WILSON, Randall (DOB 11/13/57). The report stated that Randy was found on the side of the road, with his hands bound behind his back, a white bag over his head, and a belt around his neck. On 6/28/17, Sheriff Shayne Heap received a message via Facebook from an individual identified as PESCH, Daniel (DOB 06/10/83), Through a series of four interviews, that Dan had volunteered to come to the sheriff's office to speak with investigators, conducted on 7/10/17, 8/1/17, 8/9/17, and 12/8/17, During each interview, Dan was advised he was talking on his own free will, he was not in custody, and was free to leave whenever he would like. Dan voluntarily left every interview that was conducted.

Over the course of these several months, Dan had continued to contact myself, Investigator Chris Dennis, of the Elbert County Sheriff's Office, vext message in relation to the interviews.
On 12/15/17 Dan was evicted from his place of residence located in Littleton.
I received a series of text messages on 12/15/17 from Dan's phone
On 12/18/17, Dan voluntarily made his way from the Georgetown area to Elizabeth. Personnel from the sheriff's office that were following Dan's car while en route to the sheriff's office ultimately made containing outstoning. At the sheriff's office, Dan was placed in the interview room, not restrained, and was advised of his Miranda Rights. Dan acknowledged he understood his rights and signed a Miranda waiver in front of myself and Sheriff Heap. Dan waived his Miranda Rights, and agreed to answer questions.
After advising Dan he was under arrest Sheriff Heap and I began escorting Dan across the parking lot. Dan was not in handcuffs at this time. Dan stopped and attempted to move backwards as he was looking at the jail entrance. Myself and Sheriff Heap each grabbed an arm of Dan and told his to relax. Dan pulled away from both of our grips and attempted to run north through the parking lot of the sheriff's office. Sheriff Heap and I caught up with Dan. Sheriff Heap put Dan in a bear hug, and I grabbed Dan's left wrist, placing him in a wrist lock as we went the ground. Dan was actively resisting once on the ground. After several clear verbal commands, Dan was rolled onto his stomach and began to comply with verbal commands. Dan was placed into handcuffs behind his back. I was unable to double lock the cuffs, due to the position we were would become tighter because I had not had a chance to lock them yet. Dan's body began tensing up once more as I conducted a search of Dan's was attempting to push against us from him walking. I placed Dan into an arm bar and proceeded to escort him to the jail. Dan was still tense and actively resisting. Dan was placed into holding cell I, where the handcuffs were removed and he was left.
