

Hunger is an LGBT Issue

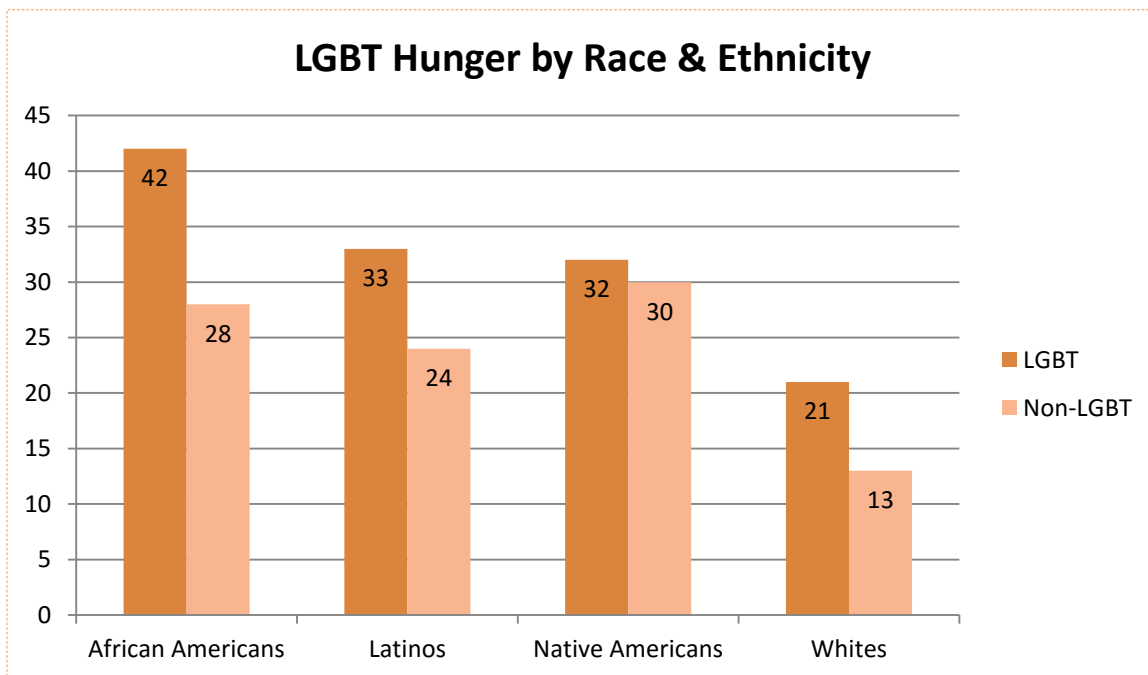
According to a new study by researchers at The Williams Institute at UCLA School of Law, LGBT adults face a higher risk of hunger and food insecurity than other Americans.

The Facts About LGBT Hunger

- Nationwide, **2.4 million** LGBT adults experienced a time in the last year when they did not have enough money to feed themselves or their family
- LGBT adults in the US are **1.6 times** more likely than other US adults to report that they did not have enough money for food for themselves or their families
- **1 in 3** US LGBT women reported not having enough money for food in the past year
- Nearly **1 in 5 LGBT** adults in the US reported that they or someone in their family went without food for an entire day in the last month

The Problem Is Even Worse for LGBT People of Color

Hunger and food insecurity is not evenly distributed across the LGBT community in America. Certain racial and ethnic minorities are particularly vulnerable.
