He launched the website "Mars Effect" in April 2012. After that, he landed at 0x10c. He has participated in a variety of games-making contests, including the "Ludum Dare" Stuff

'Meta gun,' 'Prelude of the Chambered,' and 'Minecraft' also were developed by him. He also developed the video game 'Wurm Online.' Persson has appeared in the film 'Minecraft: The Story of Mojang' that is not connected to gaming.

Markus Persson Achievements & Awards

Markus Persson won the Game Developers Choice Award for 'Minecraft' in 2011. He also received the BAFTA Games Award in 2012. Time magazine named Persson one of the 100 Most Influential People. Minecraft won the Seumas McNally Grand Prize as well as the Golden Joystick Award. Minecraft was awarded the Audience Award at the 2011 Independent Games Festival.
