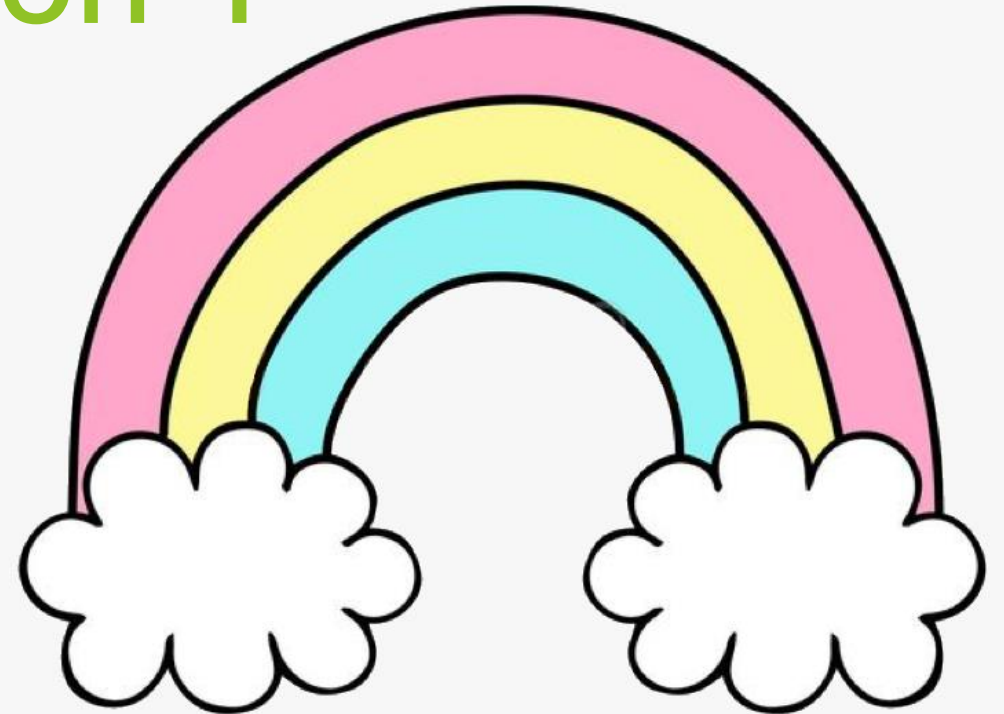

becomes bigger

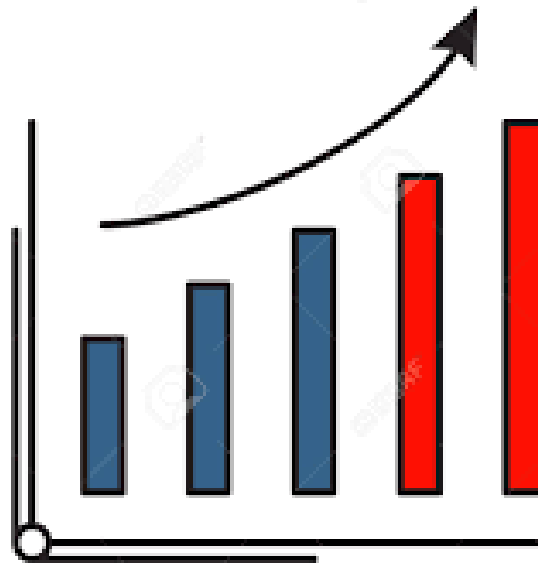
OPP decrease, reduce
