Where only one figure is given this applies to all sizes.

### ABBREVIATIONS

K. — Knit; P. — Purl; st(s). — stitch(es); st.st. — stocking stitch; rept. — repeat; alt. — alternate; tog. — together; inc. — increase; dec. — decrease; sl.1 — slip one; p.s.s.o. — pass slip stitch over; y.fwd. — yarn forward; y.r.n. — yarn round needle; sl. — slip; beg. — beginning;

t.b.l. — through back of loop; pw. — purlwise; m.1 — make one, pick up loop before next st. and K. it t.b.l.; 0. — No stitches or rows to be worked in that particular size; ch. — chain; d.c. — double crochet; patt. — pattern; cm. — centimetres; ins. — inches.

## Success will be assured if you . . .

Use ONLY the Wendy or Peter Pan yarn specified. (We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used.) Follow our instructions exactly, make certain you have the right tension. Measure (without stretching) to see you're knitting the right number of stitches as stated. Too many? — use larger needles. Too few? — use finer needles. Once the tension is right, the size will be right.

## TENSION

12 sts. and 16 rows to 5 cm. (2 ins.) over st.st. on 4 mm. Needles.

## SWEATER

### BACK

Using  $3\frac{1}{4}$  mm. Needles, cast on 61 (67, 73) sts.

**1st Row** — K.1, \* P.1, K.1, rept. from \* to end.

**2nd Row** — P.1, \* K.1, P.1, rept. from \* to end.

Rept. the last 2 rows 5 (6, 7) times more.

Change to 4 mm. Needles and st.st. (1 row knit, 1 row purl).

Work 2 (2, 4) rows.

\*\*Change to  $3\frac{1}{4}$  mm. Needles.

### Commence Patt.

**1st Row** (Right Side) — K.2, \* y.fwd., K.2tog., rept. from \* to last st., K.1.

**2nd Row** — Purl.

**3rd Row** — K.1, \* K.2tog., y.fwd., rept. from \* to last 2 sts., K.2.

**4th Row** — Purl.

These 4 rows form the patt.

Rept. the last 4 rows once more.

Change to 4 mm. Needles. Work 6 rows in st.st.\*\*

Rept. from \*\* to \*\* once more.

Change to  $3\frac{1}{4}$  mm. Needles. Rept. the 4 rows of patt. twice more.

Change to 4 mm. Needles. Work 0 (2, 2) rows in st.st.

### Shape Armholes

Cast off 4 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows.

**Next Row** — K.1, K.2tog., K. to last 3 sts.,

sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1.

**Next Row** — Purl.

Rept. the last 2 rows until 27 (29, 31) sts. remain, finishing on a P. row.

**Next Row** — K.1, K.2tog., K. to last 3 sts., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1.

**Next Row** — P.1, P.2tog. t.b.l., P. to last 3 sts., P.2tog., P.1.

Rept. the last 2 rows once more. 19 (21, 23) sts.

Sl. sts. onto a st. holder. Break off yarn.

## FRONT

Work exactly as instructions given for Back until 33 (35, 37) sts. remain, finishing on a right side row.

### Shape Neck

**Next Row** — P.20 (22, 24), sl. the last 7 (9, 11) sts. just worked onto a safety pin, P. to end.

Continue on the last set of sts. as follows:—

**Next Row** — K.1, K.2tog., K. to last 2 sts., K.2tog.

**Next Row** — P.2tog., P. to end.

**Next Row** — K.1, K.2tog., K. to last 2 sts., K.2tog.

**Next Row** — Purl.

Rept. the last 2 rows once more. 6 sts.

**Next Row** — K.1, K.2tog., K.3.

**Next Row** — P.2, P.2tog., P.1.

**Next Row** — K.1, K.2tog., K.1.

**Next Row** — P.2tog., P.1.

K.2tog. Fasten off.

With right side facing, rejoin yarn at neck edge.

**Next Row** — K.2tog., K. to last 3 sts. sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1.

**Next Row** — P. to last 2 sts., P.2tog.

**Next Row** — K.2tog., K. to last 3 sts. sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1.

**Next Row** — Purl.

Rept. the last 2 rows once more. 6 sts.

**Next Row** — K.3, sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1.

**Next Row** — P.1, P.2tog. t.b.l., P.2.

**Next Row** — K.1, sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1.

**Next Row** — P.1, P.2tog. t.b.l.

K.2tog. Fasten off.

## SLEEVES (Both Alike)

Using  $3\frac{1}{4}$  mm. Needles, cast on 33 (35, 37) sts.

Work 11 (13, 15) rows in rib as given for Back.

**Next Row** (Inc. Row) — Rib 4 (5, 6), inc. in next st., \* rib 7, inc. in next st., rept. from \* to last 4 (5, 6) sts., rib 4 (5, 6). 37 (39, 41) sts. Change to 4 mm. Needles and st.st.

Work 2 (6, 8) rows.

### **(56) cm. (22) inch size only**

**Next Row** — Inc. in first st., K. to last st., inc. in last st. (43) sts.

Work 7 rows.

## **ALL SIZES**

\*\*\*Change to 3¼ mm Needles.

### **Commence Patt.**

**1st Row** — Inc. in first st., K.1, \* y.fwd., K.2tog., rept. from \* to last st., inc. in last st.

**2nd and Alt. Rows** — Purl.

**3rd Row** — K.2, \* y.fwd., K.2tog., rept. from \* to last st., K.1.

**5th and 7th Rows** — \* K.2tog., y.fwd., rept. from \* to last st., K.1.

**8th Row** — Purl.

These 8 rows form the patt.

Change to 4 mm. Needles.

**Next Row** — Inc. in first st., K. to last st., inc. in last st.

Work 5 rows in st.st \*\*\*

Rept. from \*\*\* to \*\*\* once more. 45 (47, 51) sts.

Change to 3¼ mm. Needles. Rept. 8 rows of patt. once more. 47 (49, 53) sts.

Change to 4 mm. Needles. Work 0 (2, 2) rows in st.st.

## **Shape Top**

Cast off 4 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows.

**(51, 56) cm. (20, 22) inch sizes only**

**Next Row** — K.1, K.2tog., K. to last 3 sts., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1.

Work 3 rows.

## **ALL SIZES**

**Next Row** — K.1, K.2tog., K. to last 3 sts., sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1.

**Next Row** — Purl.

Rept. the last 2 rows until 9 sts. remain, finishing on a P. row.

Sl. sts. onto a st. holder. Break off yarn.

## **PANTS**

Worked in one piece commencing at back waist edge.

Using 3¼ mm. Needles, cast on 59 (65, 71) sts.

Work 4 rows in rib as given for Back of Sweater.

**Next Row** (Make Holes) — Rib 3 (1, 3), \* y.fwd., K.2tog., rib 2, rept. from \* to end.

Work 3 rows in rib.

Change to 4 mm. Needles and st.st.

Work 2 rows.

## **Shape Back**

**Next Row** — K.35 (39, 43), turn.

**Next Row** — Sl.1, P.10 (12, 14), turn.

**Next Row** — Sl.1, K.16 (18, 20), turn.

**Next Row** — Sl.1, P.22 (24, 26), turn.

**Next Row** — Sl.1, K.28 (30, 32), turn.

**Next Row** — Sl.1, P.34 (36, 38), turn.

**Next Row** — Sl.1, K.40 (42, 44), turn.

**Next Row** — Sl.1, P.46 (48, 50), turn.

**Next Row** — Sl.1, K. to end of row.

**Next Row** — P. across all sts.

Inc. 1 st. at each end of the needle on the next and every following 6th (8th, 8th) row until 65 (71, 77) sts. are on the needle.

Work 7 (5, 7) rows.

## **Shape Leg Openings**

Dec. 1 st. at each end of the needle on the next and every following alt. row until 53 (59, 65) sts. remain, then at each end of every row until 19 (21, 23) sts. remain.

Work 8 (10, 12) rows.

Inc. 1 st. at each end of the needle on the next and every following alt. row until 31 (33, 35) sts. are on needle, then at each end of every row until 45 (47, 49) sts. are on needle.

Cast on 10 (12, 14) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. 65 (71, 77) sts.

Work 6 (4, 6) rows.

Dec. 1 st. at each end of the needle on the next and every following 6th (8th, 8th) row until 59 (65, 71) sts. remain.

Work 5 rows.

Change to 3¼ mm. Needles.

Work 3 rows in rib as given for Back of Sweater.

**Next Row** (Make Holes) — Rib 3 (1, 3), \* y.r.n., P.2tog. t.b.l., rib 2, rept. from \* to end.

Work 4 rows more in rib.

Cast off in rib.

## **SOCKS (Make 2)**

Using 3¼ mm. Needles, cast on 33 (35, 37) sts.

Work 4 rows in rib as given for Back of Sweater.

Change to 4 mm. Needles and st.st.

Work 4 rows.

Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Back of Sweater once.

## Shape Heel

**Next Row** – K.7, turn, sl.1 pw., P.6.

**Next Row** – K.6, turn, sl.1 pw., P.5.

**Next Row** – K.5, turn, sl.1 pw., P.4.

**Next Row** – K.4, turn, sl.1 pw., P.3.

**Next Row** – K.4, m.1, and K.tog. t.b.l. with next st. to avoid a hole, turn, sl.1 pw., P.4.

**Next Row** – K.5, m.1, and K.tog. t.b.l. with next st., turn, sl.1 pw., P.5.

**Next Row** – K.6, m.1, and K.tog. t.b.l. with next st., turn, sl.1 pw., P.6.

**Next Row** – K.7, m.1, and K.tog. t.b.l. with next st., turn, sl.1 pw., P.7.

**Next Row** – K. across all sts.

**Next Row** – P.7, turn, sl.1, K.6.

**Next Row** – P.6, turn, sl.1, K.5.

**Next Row** – P.5, turn, sl.1, K.4.

**Next Row** – P.4, turn, sl.1, K.3.

**Next Row** – P.4, m.1, and P.tog. t.b.l. with next st., turn, sl.1, K.4.

**Next Row** – P.5, m.1, and P.tog. t.b.l. with next st., turn, sl.1, K.5.

**Next Row** – P.6, m.1, and P.tog. t.b.l. with next st. turn, sl.1, K.6.

**Next Row** – P.7, m.1, and P.tog. t.b.l. with next st., turn, sl.1, K.7.

**Next Row** – P. across all sts.

Place a marker in last row.

Continue in st.st. until work measures 5 (5.5, 6) cm. 2 ( $2\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ) ins. from marker, finishing on a P. row.

## Shape Toe

**Next Row** – K.6 (6, 7), sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, K.2tog., K.11 (13, 13), sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, K.2tog., K.6 (6, 7). 29 (31, 33) sts.

**Next and Alt. Row** – Purl.

**Next Row** – K.5 (5, 6), sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, K.2tog., K.9 (11, 11), sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, K.2tog., K.5 (5, 6). 25 (27, 29) sts.

**Next Row** – K.4 (4, 5), sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, K.2tog., K.7 (9, 9), sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, K.2tog., K.4 (4, 5). 21 (23, 25) sts.

Cast off pw.

## PRESSING

With wrong side facing, pin out all pieces to measurements given. Press as instructions.

## MAKING UP

### SWEATER

Pin sleeves into position leaving left back raglan open, sew in by backstitching.

### Neckband

With right side of work facing, using  $3\frac{1}{4}$  mm. Needles, K.9 sts. from left sleeve top, pick up and K.10 sts. down left front neck, K.7 (9, 11) sts. from front neck, pick up and K.9 sts. up right front neck, K.9 sts. from right sleeve top and 19 (21, 23) sts. from back neck. 63 (67, 71) sts.

Commencing on a 2nd Row, work 11 rows in rib as given for back. Cast off loosely in rib. Fold neckband in half onto wrong side and sl.st. in position. Join left back raglan by backstitching leaving 7.5 cm. (3 ins.) open at top.

### Raglan Opening Edging

With right side of work facing, using 3 mm. Hook, work 18 d.c. evenly along first side of opening, working through double thickness of neckband, then 18 d.c. evenly along second side of opening, 2 ch. to turn.

Mark positions for 3 buttonloops along first side of opening, the first 1 at top of neckband and 2 more evenly spaced and each 1 covering 2 d.c.

**Next Row** – 1 d.c. in 2nd d.c., 1 d.c. in each d.c. to first buttonloop marker, \* 2 ch., miss 2 d.c., 1 d.c. in each d.c. to next buttonloop marker, rept. from \* once more, 2 ch., miss 2 d.c., 1 d.c. in each remaining d.c. Break off yarn and fasten off.

Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonloops.

Join side and sleeve seams by backstitching, omitting rib, join rib by top sewing.

### PANTS

#### Leg Bands (Both Alike)

With right side of work facing, using  $3\frac{1}{4}$  mm. Needles, pick up and K.63 (69, 75) sts. evenly round leg opening.

Commencing on 2nd Row, work 11 rows in rib as given for back of sweater. Cast off loosely in rib.

Join side seams by backstitching, omitting rib, join rib by top sewing.

Thread elastic through holes in waist ribbing.  
Fold leg bands in half onto wrong side and  
sl.st. loosely in position.

## SOCKS

Join seams by top sewing.  
Press seams.
