Next Row (Make Holes) - Rib 3 (1, 3), \*

y.fwd., K.2tog., rib 2, rept. from \* to end.

Change to 4 mm. Needles and st.st.

# **Next Row** – Sl.1, K.16 (18, 20), turn.

Shape Back

Work 3 rows in rib.

Work 2 rows.

**Next Row** – Sl.1, P.22 (24, 26), turn. **Next Row** – Sl.1, K.28 (30, 32), turn. **Next Row** - Sl.1, P.34 (36, 38), turn. Next Row - Sl.1, K.40 (42, 44), turn.

**Next Row** – P. across all sts.

Inc. 1 st. at each end of the needle on the next

## **Next Row** – Sl.1, P.46 (48, 50), turn. **Next Row** — Sl.1, K. to end of row.

#### and every following 6th (8th, 8th) row until 65 (71, 77) sts. are on the needle. Work 7 (5, 7) rows.

# Shape Leg Openings

Dec. 1 st. at each end of the needle on the next and every following alt. row until 53 (59, 65)

#### sts. remain, then at each end of every row until 19 (21, 23) sts. remain.

Work 8 (10, 12) rows. Inc. 1 st. at each end of the needle on the next and every following alt. row until 31 (33, 35)

sts. are on needle, then at each end of every row until 45 (47, 49) sts. are on needle. Cast on 10 (12, 14) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows.

65 (71, 77) sts. Work 6 (4, 6) rows.

Dec. 1 st. at each end of the needle on the next and every following 6th (8th, 8th) row until 59 (65, 71) sts. remain.

Work 5 rows. Change to  $3\frac{1}{4}$  mm. Needles.

Work 3 rows in rib as given for Back of Sweater. Next Row (Make Holes) - Rib 3 (1, 3), \*

y.r.n., P.2tog. t.b.l., rib 2, rept. from \* to end.

Work 4 rows more in rib. Cast off in rib.

**SOCKS** (Make 2)

Using  $3\frac{1}{4}$  mm. Needles, cast on 33 (35, 37) sts. Work 4 rows in rib as given for Back of Sweater. Change to 4 mm. Needles and st.st. Work 4 rows.

Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Back of Sweater once.

## **Next Row** — K.7, turn, sl.1 pw., P.6.

Shape Heel

**Next Row** – K.6, turn, sl.1 pw., P.5. **Next Row** – K.5, turn, sl.1 pw., P.4. **Next Row** – K.4, turn, sl.1 pw., P.3.

**Next Row** – K.4, m.1, and K.tog. t.b.l. with next st. to avoid a hole, turn, sl.1 pw., P.4. **Next Row** – K.5, m.1, and K.tog. t.b.l. with

next st., turn, sl.1 pw., P.5. Next Row - K.6, m.1, and K.tog. t.b.l. with

next st., turn, sl.1 pw., P.6. **Next Row** – K.7, m.1, and K.tog. t.b.l. with next st., turn, sl.1 pw., P.7. Next Row - K. across all sts.

**Next Row** – P.7, turn, sl.1, K.6. **Next Row** – P.6, turn, sl.1, K.5. **Next Row** – P.5, turn, sl.1, K.4. **Next Row** – P.4, turn, sl.1, K.3.

**Next Row** – P.4, m.1, and P.tog. t.b.l. with next st., turn. sl.1, K.4. Next Row - P.5, m.1, and P.tog. t.b.l., with next st., turn, sl.1, K.5.

**Next Row** – P.6, m.1, and P.tog. t.b.l. with next st. turn, sl.1, K.6. **Next Row** – P.7, m.1, and P.tog. t.b.l. with next st., turn, sl.1, K.7. **Next Row** – P. across all sts.

Place a marker in last row. Continue in st.st. until work measures 5 (5.5, 6) cm. 2  $(2\frac{1}{4}, 2\frac{1}{2})$  ins. from marker, finishing on a P. row.

## Shape Toe **Next Row** - K.6 (6, 7), sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1,

K.2tog., K.11 (13, 13), sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, K.2tog., K.6 (6, 7). 29 (31, 33) sts. Next and Alt. Row — Purl.

**Next Row** – K.5 (5, 6), sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, K.2tog., K.9 (11, 11), sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, K.2tog., K.5 (5, 6). 25 (27, 29) sts. **Next Row** - K.4 (4, 5), sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1,

K.2tog., K.7 (9, 9), sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, K.2tog., K.4 (4, 5). 21 (23, 25) sts.

# Raglan Opening Edging

With right side of work facing, using 3 mm. Hook, work 18 d.c. evenly along first side of opening, working through double thickness of neckband, then 18 d.c. evenly along second side of opening, 2 ch. to turn. Mark positions for 3 buttonloops along first side of opening, the first 1 at top of neckband

**MAKING UP** 

Pin sleeves into position leaving left back

With right side of work facing, using 31 mm.

Needles, K.9 sts. from left sleeve top, pick up

raglan open, sew in by backstitching.

and 2 more evenly spaced and each 1 covering 2 d.c. Next Row – 1 d.c. in 2nd d.c., 1 d.c. in each d.c. to first buttonloop marker, \* 2 ch., miss 2 d.c., 1 d.c. in each d.c. to next buttonloop marker, rept. from \* once more, 2 ch., miss 2 d.c., 1 d.c. in each remaining d.c. Break off yarn and fasten off.

Sew on buttons to correspond with button-

Join side and sleeve seams by backstitching,

# Leg Bands (Both Alike)

With right side of work facing, using  $3\frac{1}{4}$  mm.

Needles, pick up and K.63 (69, 75) sts. evenly round leg opening.

join rib by top sewing.

Commencing on 2nd Row, work 11 rows in rib as given for back of sweater. Cast off loosely

Join side seams by backstitching, omitting rib,

measurements given. Press as instructions.

Thread elastic through holes in waist ribbing.
Fold leg bands in half onto wrong side and sl.st. loosely in position.

SOCKS

Join seams by top sewing. Press seams.
