Hours

This job requires 8-12 hours per week, depending on the ministry season. The Director of Worship is required to be at all Sunday morning activities and a weekly staff training at a date and time to be determined that will work for the whole Ministry Staff. They will also receive 30 minutes per week of direct staff coaching from the Lead Pastor at a day and time to be determined. They are responsible to make sure their whole department is set up on time and cleaned up immediately after all Sunday morning and midweek activities. If and when a midweek worship program exists, the Director of Worship is required to be there as well.

Compensation

This job will be unpaid for the first 3 months. After a 3-month (or longer) evaluation as detailed in the FBC Staff Policy Manual, if both FBC and the employee wish to continue, compensation may begin at \$50/week.

Overview

The FBC Worship Department currently has 4 teams: Music, Tech, Connection Corner, and Ushers, along with Greeter and Parking teams to be developed. FBC is seeking a Director of Worship who would oversee the health of the whole department with a specific emphasis on developing the Sunday morning Music Team as a primary outreach tool to the unchurched in the community. We currently have a pianist and two other singers on our music team and use a combination of piano and video music on Sunday mornings. We have an average of 70-90 people on a given Sunday morning.

Responsibilities

Directly oversee and grow Sunday morning Music Team

Oversee, coach, and train all other team leaders in their department

Receive weekly coaching directly from the Lead Pastor

Train all team leaders in their department to coach and train their teams using the 4x4x4 process (to be taught)

In conjunction with Lead Pastor and team leaders, write or re-write job descriptions for all team leaders and volunteer positions in their department

Recommend potential team leaders to the Lead Pastor when positions open up in their department Work in conjunction with the entire Ministry Staff to create and improve Sunday morning outreach experiences

Discover and develop musicians from the church

Discover and develop ministry workers for their department from the church

Meet weekly with the Lead Pastor and others to plan out Sunday services at a day and time to be determined

Must be able to lead music with both voice and guitar (either acoustic or electric) both solo and with a team Must be able to learn and play both well-known and new, fresh songs
