

# Do You Play Minecraft?

Do you play Minecraft? Be a part of our Minecraft server.

At present we're on model 1.18.1.

Our Minecraft server runs Minecraft Java Edition for computers. Different variations (including Minecraft for Windows 10) will not be suitable with our server. If you don't have already got a Minecraft Java Edition account, you will want to buy this model and register earlier than joining our server.

To entry the FVRL server:

1. Electronic mail your Minecraft user identify to [minecraft@fvrl.org](mailto:minecraft@fvrl.org) to be granted entry to our server. \*This will likely take as much as 48 hours.
2. Open and log into the sport.
3. Choose "Multiplayer."
4. Liberty is not free join click on "Add Server."
5. Underneath "Server Title" enter any identify you want.
6. Under "Server Address" enter: [minecraft.fvrl.org](http://minecraft.fvrl.org) and then click on "Performed."
7. Select the server by the Server Name you simply entered and click "Be a part of Server."

You only have to take these steps as soon as. After you've added the server will probably be there every time you log into "multiplayer".

Please word: you can't access the server when taking part in in demo mode. You will need to have beforehand bought the game.

## FVRL's Server Guidelines

- Be respectful of other gamers.
- Don't destroy different folks's work.
- Do not steal other individuals's objects.
- PVP is disabled.
- FVRL's guidelines of conduct apply while players are connected to the FVRL hosted server.

Watch this YouTube video from GamerGramps to learn the way to make use of and handle your claim(s).

Use these commands:

- /AbandonClaim: deletes the claim you are standing in.
- /Trust: offers one other player permission to edit in your claim.
- /UnTrust: revokes any permissions granted to a player in your claim.
- /AccessTrust: offers a player permission to make use of your buttons, levers, and beds.
- /ContainerTrust: gives a participant permission to make use of your buttons, levers, beds, crafting gear, containers, and animals.
- /TrustList: lists the permissions for the claim you're standing in.
- /SubdivideClaims: switches your shovel to subdivision mode, so you possibly can subdivide your claims.
- /BasicClaims: places your shovel again in basic claims mode.
- /PermissionTrust: grants a player permission to share his permission stage with others.
- /UntrustAll: removes all permissions for all gamers in your declare.
- /AbandonAllClaims: deletes your whole claims.
