Introduction: Radiant biography of Maximillian Kolbe at Auschwitz

Key Question: Why should we believe in a grace so preposterous that it makes radiant the face of Kolbe and also the Concentration Camp Commandant.

- I. God's law does not change just because we break it
 - a. Moses broke the Law
 - b. The people broke the Law
 - c. God keeps the Law the same (v1)
- II. God's love does not change just because we betray it. How does God respond to betrayal?
 - a. God drives home His name (v5)
 - b. God drives home His nature (v6+7)
- III. God's covenant shines through, even if we don't.
 - a. God renews His covenant with rebels (v 10,27)
 - b. God grants His glory to the repentant (v30-32)

Conclusion: Nuremberg chaplain to Nazi war criminals
