

## Syrian destruction [edit]

Main article: Destruction of Syria's chemical weapons

Syria, which had long been suspected of possessing chemical weapons, acknowledged them in September 2013 and agreed to put them under international supervision. [38] On 14 September Syria deposited its instrument of accession to the CWC with the United Nations as the depositary and agreed to its provisional application pending entry into force effective 14 October. [39][40] An accelerated destruction schedule was devised by Russia and the United States on 14 September, [41] and was endorsed by United Nations Security Council Resolution 2118[42] and the OPCW Executive Council Decision EC-M-33/DEC.1. [43] Their deadline for destruction was the first half of 2014. [43] Syria gave the OPCW an inventory of its chemical weapons arsenal [44] and started its destruction in October 2013, 2 weeks before its formal entry into force, while applying the convention provisionally. [45][46] All Category 1 materials were destroyed by August 2014. [26]
