How Do I Update My World?

The day has finally arrived: Minecraft's Caves & Cliffs Half II replace has come to each Java and Bedrock Editions of the sport, bringing new world generation and a few quite lovely new caves.

We've covered the best way the new terrain technology works already when we bought our mitts on the Snapshot earlier this year, however after a number of extra tweaks, patches, fixes and updates, the official launch of Caves & Cliffs Part II is a way more stable expertise.

To obtain the new replace on your Change, go to the Minecraft icon on your home display, press the + button to open the Choices, go to "Software program Replace" and select "Via the Internet". I'm Just Here To Blog can examine for the replace, although it might have downloaded it automatically already.

As for updating your existing worlds, Mojang have provided directions:

How do I replace my world?

On Bedrock Edition, after you have up to date to 1.18 and go to load up an existing world, you may be proven a prompt and requested in case you would like to make a backup copy of that world. If you happen to do want to make a backup, be sure you hit the prompt after which click via to update your world and start enjoying.

Sadly, among the features initially planned for Caves & Cliffs Part II - just like the Deep Dark biome, the Warden, and archaeology - have been pushed back to the subsequent replace, 1.19, known as "The Wild Replace".

Here's the changelog for Bedrock Edition (that's the one on Change):

- Elevated the world height and depth, including 50% extra vertical house to build and explore
- New cave era to explore under your existing worlds
- New cave and mountain biomes like Lush Caves and Jagged Peaks
- Drastically updated and improved biome, cave, and ore technology
- Added several new music tracks to take pleasure in during gameplay
- Mounted over 70 bugs, points, and parity changes
