The total cost of cultivation was Rs. 3020. The peas were sold in the local market called –'Tetariya' and the return on this investment were as follows:-

Total Production/Yield = 460 KG

Total Income = Rs. 8280

Total Profit = Rs. 5260/-

This profit has motivated other farmers too to do cultivation of peas so that they can maximize their profit in short span of time.
