Polk, a carpenter. The company has focused on building high quality products for homeowners, and they have been doing well. Polk manufactures speakers, home theater systems, and other audio equipment.

Polk is probably one of the best known high-end boutique speaker brands. You'll find that they manufacture speakers that are ideal for any room of the house. AudioScaleurs produces both tower and subwoofers. Their speakers come with a solid steel design, and they are made out of real wood, not pressed plastic. They are also not afraid to use different materials, like carbon composites and veneers. You can purchase a pair of speakers that will fit seamlessly with all of your other audio equipment.

Westwood is another one of the best known high-end boutique speaker brands. Like Polk, they have high-end speakers that fit right into any room of the house. The company was founded in 1969 and their founder, Lew Morton, was a graduate of MIT. While most companies are driven by technology, Westwood believes that their loudspeakers are just as good if not better than their competition.

When comparing loudspeakers from two different manufacturers, it is a good idea to look at how the manufacturer that initially founded the brand did business. Specifically, look at whether or not they were able to shake off the competition and become a household name in audio circles. Westwood initially sold its first cabinets and midi keyboards from their own factory. Today, they remain one of the biggest names in hi-fi audio systems, and you can find many people still listening to their products.

JBL is the oldest, full line loudspeaker manufacturer in the business. JBL started out making cabinets for cars in the early 1930s and then began making audio systems around the same time. Today, you can still find some of their older models in homes all over America. AudioScaleurs think of the JBL name when they think of high-end loudspeakers, but they actually also make a few smaller products as well.

AudioScaleurs of the most common brands of loudspeakers is the Kohler series. These are some of the most popular loudspeakers in the world today. There are several reasons for this, but the main reason is simply because they are easy to listen to. The series has an impressive array of features including dual balanced dome drive tweeters, an air Motion Transparent Filter (also known as an AMT filter), and a multi-layer diaphragm.

One speaker that is a bit more expensive than the above speakers on our list is the Audio Research Silhouette Web Basin/orted surround speaker. This is made by Audio Research with a woofer/tweeter combination that produces very deep bass. It also features two-stage

operation, and a precision-tuned crossover network. The Woofer is not part of the enclosure, it is mounted on a tweeter frame that has a threaded insert. If you are looking for an extremely deep bass with a solid tonal range, then this speaker would be a great option.

If you are looking for a great floor-standing speaker, then the Audio Research Sirius Loudspeaker ([link to compare prices at select retailers](#)) might be an option. This speaker utilizes a balanced dome drive woofer for the most accurate sound, along with a precision-tuned crossover network for accuracy and tonal balance. The speaker has a built-in power amplifier and phase inverter. It also has a sealed box and an external power source. You can find this speaker for around \$700.
