Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

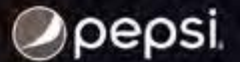

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#4 TORRIN HANOVER has only picked up a couple of minor shares since the shutdown but has been racing against much tougher than he will go postward against tonight. He is just two starts removed from the Preferred and now plunged down two levels off his last two. This 20-time winner has not raced this low down the class ladder since May of 2019 and he was a winner on that occasion. The connections will certainly want hm to maximize this opportunity tonight and he should be tough to beat against this group.

#1 MR KELLY drops down a notch in his fourth start back off the bench and had no chance in his latest when he got away ninth off the gate from the nine-hole. He came his back-half in 54.1 and his final quarter in 27.2. This gelding finished fifth in the Preferred-3 at Georgian Downs against a solid group prior to that and was a rock-solid second to Undrthsouthrnsun in his first start off the bench. He gets to work from the pole position tonight and this group should be much more to his liking. Using underneath.

#5 MENLO PARK dropped down to this level three starts ago and had his best finish in his most recent effort when he finished third under the wire. He sat in the three-hole for most of the mile and then moved out second-over on the final turn before diving back to the cones. He was nowhere near the winner at the finish, as Mikey Camden paced his mile in 1:50.2 but this gelding did well to hang on for the show spot which was virtually his own race six lengths off that winner. He can hit the ticket again.

#3 CHAMPAGNE PHIL has hit the board in his last three and has a pair of third place finishes since racing returned to Ontario. One of those came here at Mohawk Park in the bottom condition two starts ago and the other against a group of Preferred pacers at Grand River. He might be able to grab a share.

#1 ONLY FOR JUSTICE drops down a notch on the class ladder and will make his second start back over the surface here after racing south of the border during the stoppage. He closed well to finish fourth in his latest and needed a flat line in that effort because he came into the race off two breaks in his previous two outings. This gelding trotted his back-half in 56.3 with a final quarter of 28 seconds flat. His latest was also his first start in over a month and he was impressive in a qualifier on the morning of June 11th in preparation for that effort. He took support to the tune of 7/2 last time and has found a group he can get the better of.

#4 ON THE ROPES got away fifth off the gate and stayed on the pylons last week in this class. He ended up getting shuffled back to last on the final turn and appeared to have trot in the stretch but was mired in traffic. This 19-time winner was trotting strongly under the wire and still managed to come home in 27.4 to grab fourth under the line. He was a winner two starts back in the class below this and should be breathing fire off his latest.

#3 HP BRUXELLES was the runner-up to a strong winner in Southwind Avenger last week at this level. She went out to the early lead and then released that rival before chasing him gamely to the wire. Her program line is incorrect, as she was never fifth in the stretch but rather maintained her position in second. She has raced well in two of her three tries since racing has returned to Ontario and had no chance in her other effort when she got away eighth off the gate from the nine-hole. She is a logical play on the ticket.

#2 DANCER HALL picked up a minor award in the class above this in his latest and now drops back down the level where he enjoyed back-to-back third place finishes prior to that. He trotted his back-half in 56.2 last time with a final quarter in 27.3. This 21-time winner draws inside and should be able to get a piece of it.

#8 SECOND BRUISER was the OSS Grassroots champion last season as a rookie and now makes the transition to the OSS Gold level. His four wins at two were of the easiest kind and then his sophomore debut was one of the best performances you will ever see by a horse who had not raced in over eight months. He was facing older horses in NW3 and moved first-over against the favorite to look like a horse that might finish somewhere on the ticket, but he surged past that rival in the stretch to win in 1:50.4 with final quarter speed of 26.3. Giving this son of Believeinbruiser the nod in what should be a barnburner of a race to kick off the OSS Gold season for the glamour boys of the sport.

#2 LAWLESS SHADOW struck gold once last season but was also victorious in the Nassagaweya. He was the runner-up in the OSS Super final to Bulldog Hanover and claimed the show spot in the Metro. This son of Shadow Play has been no worse than second in four starts as a sophomore and turned heads last week against older foes in NW16000L5 when he cruised away from his rivals to score by five lengths in 1:50.2. He has only missed the board once in his career and boasts one of the best resumes in the field. The likely favorite and deservedly so but we will take a shot on the one above.

#1 P L OZZY did not race at two but has certainly come into his own recently by winning his last three starts with his two most recent victories coming over this surface. He was the easiest kind of winner in both of those efforts but that was in NW2 and now he takes a serious step upward in competition to this OSS Gold event. We have not seen this one's ceiling yet, but it will have to be high, if he wants to best this group.

#10 BULLDOG HANOVER won two OSS Gold divisions at two before devastating his rivals by nine lengths in the OSS Super Final to take down the championship. He stalled first-over in his sophomore debut in NW5 but still managed to finish fourth, pacing his final quarter in 26.2. This son of Shadow Play must leave from the outermost post, but the new slanted starting gate might help him get away well. He is one of many with a chance in a field brimming with talent.

#1 MAJESTIC VIRGIN stepped up to the F&M-Preferred last week and likely bit off more than she could chew. She now returns to the level where she was only beaten three quarters of a length on June 19th in finishing second to Mary Kat. This mare got a perfect trip in that contest, but she gamely chased the winner to the wire and not this does not hook the toughest group for this class. Four of her rivals are moving up to this level, while the other have mostly been toiling in the class. It was a tough choice between our top two, but we opted to give the one above the edge.

#8 BORN A DRAGON has no chance last time when she got away ninth off the gate and then sat last throughout in 10th after leaving out from the eight-hole. She hit the board in this class in each of her two starts prior to that and only missed by half a length to Snow Shark on June 11th. You can cross her latest line off the page, but it might make her go off at an inflated price. She merits respect and can hit the ticket.

#3 ITTY BITTY sat a perfect two-hole trip in this class last week in the sloppy going but faded to finish fifth in the stretch. It was certainly a tougher version of the class on that occasion, but she still could have performed better given the circumstances. Drury opts to stick with our second choice and this mare picks up Doug McNair.

He got away fifth from the nine-hole and then moved first-over against Matticulous through a middle-half of 56.4. This gelding fought gamely in the stretch and was only beaten by a length on the wire, after pacing his last panel in 26.4. He was the OSS Grassroots champion last season and has hit the board three times in his first six starts of his four-year-old campaign. A stablemate of the one who beat him last time might be the main danger but that one is taking a big leap upwards in class. Leaving from the center of the gate should help his chances and we expect him to find the winner's circle this evening.

#4 MIKEY CAMDEN has won two in a row in lower condition classes, but both were in sizzling fashion, lowering his lifetime mark in consecutive weeks. He was the easiest kind of winner in NW5000L5 last week, stopping the clock in 1:50.2 but now will have to overcome a double bump in class. This gelding is razor sharp and should be brimming with confidence, but we will elect to slot him underneath.

#5 TALBOT ROMEO did not have much of chance in his return to the racetrack on June 19th when he got away eighth off the gate and was still eight lengths out of it at the halfway point when the leader tripped that marker in only 57 seconds flat. This seven-year-old came his back-half in 53.2 with final quarter speed of 26.1. He now makes his second start off the bench and might take a big step forward.

#2 REAL WILLEY finished second at this level on June 12th and draws inside for the first time since returning to the races three starts ago. He gets reunited with a familiar face in Sylvain Filion and should not be taken lightly.

#1 CAPTAIN VIDEO drops down to the bottom condition after finishing seventh in NW5 in his first start back in nearly a month after returning to Mohawk Park from five-race spell stateside. He did not have any success south of the border but was a dominant winner of the Valedictory Series final here on April 2nd and was a winner at 95 cents to the dollar in NW5 in the effort before that. This Moreau pupil gets to face the softest competition he has seen for an awfully long time and is hard to look past.

#9 P L JACKSON drops down two notches on the class ladder and had no chance in his latest when he got away last off the gate from the 10-hole in NW8000L5. He did not improve a position but did pace his back-half in 54.1 with a final quarter of 27.2. This 23-time winner finished third but was placed fourth at that level on June 12th and should relish the class relief this evening. He will have to overcome the outside draw but has a class edge on many of his rivals.

#4 DRACHAN HANOVER did well to be third in this class two starts back and then got locked in to be shuffled out of it last week. He never saw an inch of daylight until the stretch and was pacing well under the wire. This free-legged pacer can land on the ticket with a clean trip but faces a pair of tough customers in the two above.

#8 ARUKIDINME CABBIE was the runner-up at this level last time to Big Bully, after doing a lot of work from the first-over position. The winner slipped up the cones in the stretch drive and this gelding's performance was a decent one. He retains the services of Doug McNair and can pick up another share.

This gelding went a long way on the front-end at this level last time and only gave way late to be third beaten half a length. He produced a gritty effort first-over to dead heat with Nickle Bag two starts back and is logical one to utilize underneath.

He has picked up minor awards in each of his last two at the level and can get another share tonight but would benefit from a softer trip.

#6 REVOLT has picked up one cheque in three starts since returning from the lockdown and might be able to find his best stride in this spot. He gets reunited with a familiar face in Trevor Henry and they have teamed up for three of his eight lifetime wins. A smaller share is expected.

- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the supervision of racing officials. All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

HOW TO BET

Please call your bets to a teller in the following manner: Amount of base bet, type of bet, horse numbers.

Examples: \$3.00 to Win, number 7; \$5.00 Daily Doubles, 6 and 4, 7 and 5.

The minimum amount for a single bet in any pool other than Superfect, Pick 3 and Pick 4 is \$1.00.

TYPES OF BETS

The following types of bets may be made on each race:

WIN - You must select the winner of the race.

PLACE - Your horse must finish first, second.

SHOW - Your horse must finish first, second or third.

The following "feature" bets are available on one or more races as indicated in the program:

DAILY DOUBLE - Select the winner of two consecutive races for the races designated as the Daily Double events. This bet must be placed before the first race.

EXACTOR - Select the first two horses in exact order of finish.

TRIACTOR - Select the first three horses in exact order of finish.

SUPERFECTA - Select the first four horses in exact order of finish.

PICK 3 - Select the winner of three consecutive races for the races designated as Pick 3 events.

PICK 4 - Select the winners of four consecutive races for the races designated as Pick 4 events.

BOXES AND WHEELS

By "boxing" or "wheeling", you can combine several bets on one ticket, as follows:

DAILY DOUBLE

Wheel one "key" horse in the 1st race with several horses in the 2nd race or several horses in the 1st race with one horse in the second race - your ticket is cashable if the key horse and one of your choices in the other race are both winners.

Example \$1.00 Daily Double Wheel, number 3 "on top" with a nine horse field, cost is \$9.00 (9 combinations)

EXACTOR BOXES & WHEELS

Box two, three or more horses - your ticket is cashable if two of the boxed horses finish first and second.

Examples: \$2.00 Exactor Box, 3 and 5 - cost is \$4.00 (2 combinations)
\$3.00 Exactor Box, 2, 4, 6 - cost is \$18.00 (6 combinations)

\$1.00 Exactor Box, 1, 3, 5, 8 - cost is \$12.00 (12 combinations)

Wheel one horse to the rest of the field - your ticket is cashable if that horse finishes in the selected position, -- either first (on top) or second (on bottom).

Example: \$1.00 Exactor Wheel, 3 "on top" - with a 9-horse field, cost is \$8.00.

TRIACTOR BOXES AND WHEELS

Box three, four or more horses - your ticket is cashable if three of the boxed horses finish 1st, 2nd and 3rd, in any order.

Examples: \$1.00 Triactor Box, 2, 3, 5 - cost is \$6.00

\$1.00 Triactor Box, 2, 3, 4, 5 - cost is \$24.00

\$1.00 Triactor Box, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 - cost is \$60.00

\$1.00 Triactor Box, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 - cost is \$120.00

SUPERFECTA BOXES AND WHEELS

Box four or more horses - your ticket is cashable if four of the boxed horses finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th in any order.

Examples: \$1.00 Superfecta Box, 2, 3, 4, 5 - cost is \$24.00

\$1.00 Superfecta Box, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 - cost is \$120.00

\$1.00 Superfecta Box, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 - cost is \$360.00

Key Horse Bet also available - Example: \$1.00 Triactor Key, number 4 with numbers, 5, 6 and 9 - cost is \$6.00 (6 combinations). The ticket is cashable if number 4 (the "Key" horse) wins and two of the numbers, 5, 6 and 9 finish second and third.

Key horse plus 2 horses = 2 combinations;

Key horse plus 4 horses = 12 combinations;

Key horse plus 5 horses = 20 combinations; etc.

Wheel two horses to the rest of the field - your ticket is cashable if the two specified horses finished in the selected positions.

Example: \$1.00 Triactor Wheel 2 - 6 - "all" - with a 9-horse field, cost is \$7.00 (7 combinations). Variations: all - 2 - 6, 2 - all - 6.

Wheel one horse to the rest of the field - your ticket is cashable if that horse finishes in the selected position:

Examples: \$1.00 Triactor Wheel, 5 - all - all - with a 9-horse field, cost is \$56.00 (56 combinations).

\$2.00 Triactor Wheel, all - 8 - all - with an 8-horse field, cost is \$84.00 (42 combinations).

PARTIAL WHEELS

If you don't want to include all horses in a wheel bet, specify "Part Wheel" and call the horses's numbers individually.

Examples: \$1.00 Exactor Part Wheel, 7 with 1, 2, 4 and 9 - cost is \$4.00 (4 combinations) and the ticket is cashable if number 7 wins and any of numbers 1, 2, 4 or 9 finishes second.

\$2.00 Triactor Part Wheel, 3 with 8 with 1, 2, 4 and 9 - cost is \$8.00 (4 combinations) and the ticket is cashable if number 3 wins and number 8 finishes second and any of numbers, 1, 2, 4 or 9 finishes 3rd.

PLEASE NOTE

When calling **Box** or **Wheel** bets to a teller, specify the amount of the base bet - **for example:** \$1.00 Triactor Box, \$2.00 Exactor Wheel - and not the total cost of the wager.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
