ANOUCHKA SOFT**

PULLOVER

To fit: 51 (53, 58, 64)cms 20 (21, 23, 25)ins Chest (see size charts)

MATERIALS

2 (3, 3, 4) balls Pronostic in Blanc

1 ball Anouchka Soft in each Eglantine and Myosotis for all sizes

2 Buttons

3.00mm Crochet Hook

Suggested needle size: Pair 2mm and 3mm needles (see note on Tension)

TENSION

25sts and 34 rows to 10cms measured over st st on 3mm needles.

Important — Use larger or smaller needles if necessary to obtain correct tension.

BACK

With 2mm needles and Blanc cast on 70 (74, 84, 88)sts.

Work 4cms in k1/p1 rib ending with a right side row.

Next row: Rib 5 (7, 12, 14) * inc 1 in next st, rib 19, rep from * to last 5 (7, 12, 14)sts, inc 1, rib to end. 74 (78, 88, 92)sts.

Change to 3mm needles and cont in st st (1 row k, 1 row p) until work measures 16 (17, 18.5, 22)cms ending with a wrong side row.

Place col marker at each end of last row to position armholes.

Cont straight until work measures 23 (25, 28, 33)cms ending with a wrong side row.

DIVIDE FOR OPENING

Next row: K37 (39, 44, 46)sts, turn and leave rem sts on a spare needle.

Cont on sts for right side of Back.

Cont straight until work measures 27 (29, 32, 37)cms ending at centre edge.

SHAPE NECK

Next row: Cast off 6sts, p to end.

Next row: K to end.

Next row: Cast off 10 (12, 12, 12)sts, p to end.

Next row: Cast off rem 21 (21, 26, 28)sts for shoulder.

Rejoin yarn at centre of work and complete other side to match reversing neck shaping.

FRONT

Work as given for Back until Front measures 23 (24, 26, 31)cms ending with a wrong side row.

SHAPE NECK

Next row: K33 (35, 40, 42), cast off 8sts, k33 (35, 40, 42).

Work each side of neck separately.

Cast off at neck edge on alt rows 3 (4, 4, 4)sts once, 2 (3, 3, 3)sts once, 2sts once, and 1 st 5 times.

Cont until work measures 28 (30, 33, 38)cms ending with a wrong side row.

Cast off rem 21 (21, 26, 28)sts for shoulder.

Rejoin yarn at neck edge and complete other side of neck to match reversing shaping.

SLEEVES

With 2mm needles and Blanc cast on 38 (40, 42, 48)sts.

Work 3cms in k1/p1 rib ending with a right side row.

Next row: Rib 1 (2, 3, 1) * inc 1 in next st, rib 3 (3, 3, 4), rep from * to last 1 (2, 3, 2)sts, inc 1, rib to end. 48 (50, 52, 58)sts.

Change to 3mm needles and work 8 (8, 6, 6) rows in st st ending with a wrong side row.

Next row: K2, Make 1 (pick up thread before next st, place on left needle and k into back of loop to make st), k to last 2sts, Make 1, k2.

Inc 2sts thus every foll 8th (8th, 6th, 6th) row 2 (1, 6, 11) times more then every foll 6th (6th, 4th, 0) row 4 (7, 4, 0) times. 62 (68, 74, 82)sts.

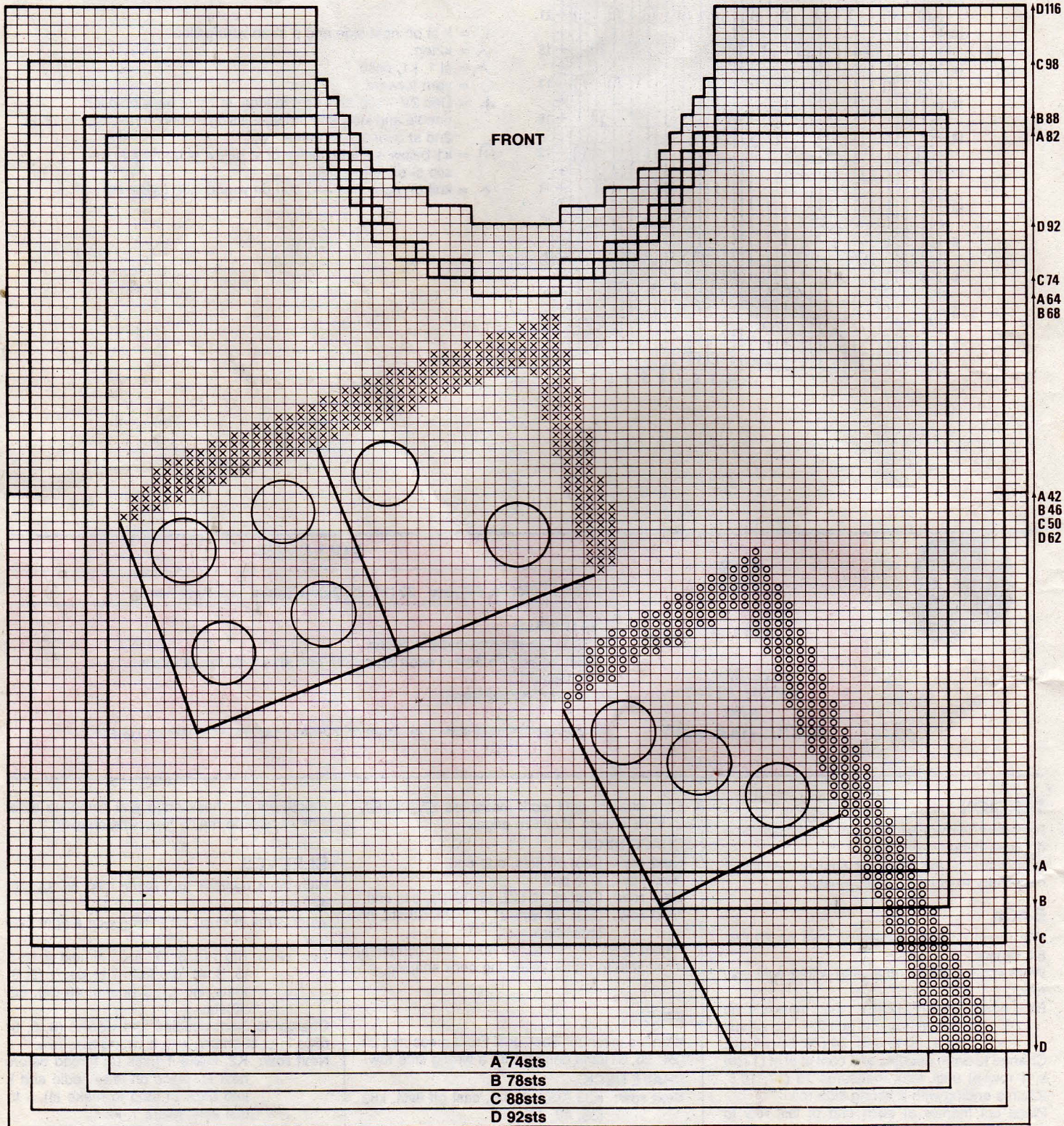
Cont until work measures 19 (22, 22, 26)cms ending with a wrong side row.

Work 2 rows in st st with spare yarn. (This will be unpicked when sts are sewn into place.)

NECKBAND

With 2mm needles and Blanc cast on 94 (98, 98, 98)sts.

Work 2cms in k1/p1 rib ending with a wrong side row. Knit 1 row.

Work 2 rows in st st with spare yarn.

TO MAKE UP

Using Swiss embroidery and Stem Stitch work patt on Front following Chart.

Make 6 small pompoms in Myosotis and 3 in Eglantine and sew in place on dice.

If preferred, spots on dice may be worked in Satin Stitch, working spots approx 2cms in diameter.

Join shoulder seams. Sew top of sleeve between markers, st by st with back stitch on right side of work unpicking spare yarn as sts are sewn into place.

Sew neckband in place in the same way. Join side and sleeve seams.

With 3.00mm crochet hook work 2 rows in double crochet around back opening and make 2 buttonholes of 2ch on one side on 2nd row.

Sew on buttons.
