PROJECT OF A TECHNOLOGICAL RURAL CITY

OBJECTIVE

To create and develop a technological rural city where agricultural training is provided among other activities, and to the extent of the financial support received, replicate the project in other parts of Mexico and Latin America. Promoting family development and integration, thus avoiding migration to the United States.

VISION

Build a technological rural city, not too far from the big cities, provided with schools, health, cultural, sports and recreation areas where family integration is promoted; through the hiring of qualified personnel previously selected in the different required areas, and to develop a center where training is promoted and technological innovation projects also, in the areas of: traditional, green house and hydroponic crops, crops conservation renewable energies and soil and water analysis among others.

DESCRIPTION

Land will be purchased from private individuals and donated land will be requested, as well as the corresponding permits for the extraction of water from local governments for the establishment of the first rural city humanitarian project in the El Arenal, Jalisco area. This area has adequate means of communication and the nearest city is Guadalajara, Jalisco.

Qualified personnel as well as public and private universities will be selected in the different required areas to carry out the project planning. In the initial phase, national and or foreign personnel will be hired in order to achieve efficient planning.

During the construction process, preference employment will be given to local people.

HUMANITARIAN PROJECTS

In the construction of the facilities and houses, the ecosystem will be respected and the services of light and water heating will be predominantly generated by wind and solar devices.

The project contemplates the establishment of experimental fields of traditional, green houses and hydroponic crops where regional farmers will be trained, both in the cultivation process, in the use of the agricultural equipment and crop storage to optimize the results, ensuring that water consumption is low. Also, technological innovation projects such as ecological detergents and soap production among others.

The fundamental part of this project is to promote the family integration and that the participants realize that their effort and dedication gives results, achieving excellent harvests and thus promote membership in the region avoiding migration to the United States.

REQUIRED INVESTMENT

US\$600'000,000.00 (Six hundred million US dollars).
