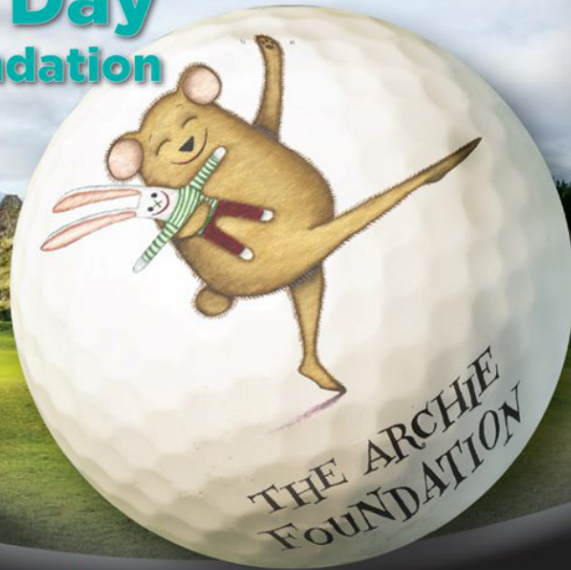

LADBROKES CHAMPIONSHIP

**Inverness Caledonian Thistle made it four wins in a row in all competitions as they beat Queen of the South 2-0, thanks to first-half strikes from Sean Welsh and Tom Walsh.**

John Robertson made one change to the side which beat Dunfermline 1-0 at East End Park last week, as Sean Welsh came into the side for David Carson. The game was Welsh's first league start of the season, after coming on against Dunfermline last week to score the crucial winner from the penalty spot.

It was Welsh who opened the scoring after 16 minutes on the clock, White laid back a cross from Walsh on the right-hand side and the midfielder fired the ball low past McCrorie from 20 yards. A strike with real conviction to mark his first league start.

Queens showed their threat after 18 minutes as Fassial El Bakhtaoui broke clear but he put his effort wide of the post.

Only a minute later it was 2-0 to the Caley Jags, Tom Walsh was the scorer this time around, It was superb play from Rooney down the right as his cross found its way to Tom Walsh and finished superbly first time to make it 2-0 after 19 minutes.

After 31 minutes, Tom Walsh put a fantastic free-kick into the box as Donaldson was inches away from connecting with it. The resulting corner was worked to Aaron Doran and his cross found White in the middle but it was turned just over.

Miles Storey cut inside and shot from the edge of the box after 37 minutes but McCrorie collected it.

Walsh called McCrorie into action again a minute later, Doran's corner caused problems in the Queens box and it came back out to Walsh, who hit it on the volley, but his effort was palmed clear by the Rangers loanee.

The final chance of the first-half was a free-kick by Sean Welsh which had to be parried behind by McCrorie for a corner.

Caley Thistle started the second-half quickly, as Walsh saw his effort blocked by Kilday straight after the re-start. The ball then broke to Welsh but he fired his effort wide from range.

After 48 minutes, The Caley Jags had the crossbar shaking as Walsh's corner was met by McCart in the middle but his header hit the top of the bar and was behind for a corner.

Jordan White could've made it 3-0 after 53 minutes, Sean Welsh's effort from range was parried by McCrorie. The ball then broke to White from about 6 yards out but he couldn't convert his effort.

After 65 minutes, Miles Storey was replaced by Nikolay Todorov

White was inches away from making it 3-0 with 13 minutes left of the match as Todorov played Walsh in down the right hand side, his cross was just missed by the Caley Thistle number nine in the box.

McCrorie was called into action a minute later as he tipped Doran's effort over the bar and behind for corner.

## **Mark Ridgers joined Caley Thistle back in 2017 as John Robertson began to rebuild the squad following the club's relegation to the Championship.**

All being well, Ridgers will make his 100th appearance for the Caley Jags today and it is a record he is proud of.

Ridgers said: "On a personal note it is something which I am proud of, hopefully at the end of this season we'll be looking forward to games in the Premiership for this football club."

"It was brought to my attention last weekend, it's nice to play 100 games for the club considering where my career went after I left Hearts. The stability has been brilliant, this season we've started well and fingers crossed we can keep things going."

Ridgers has had some memorable moments since signing, most notably the Scottish Cup win against Ross County last season and the IRN-BRU Cup final in his first season. He is also proud of his development during his time at the club.

He said: "The Cup match against Ross County was one of the most memorable moments, the way the season went, we were struggling to beat them in the league last season. The IRN-BRU Cup final was also the first cup final that I had played in too. It's been good on a personal note, for my development and getting consecutive games. That amount of games played for myself to develop and learn the game, I feel comfortable playing now."

Ridgers has also reflected on the way the squad has changed since he signed and he is optimistic about the Caley Jags' chances this term.

He said: "I think you've seen it since I've signed, the club has gone through a transition with players coming and going, on and off the field stuff. Now, I think everything is heading the right direction, last year was a disappointment to lose out in the play-offs but this year we've started well, we've got a good squad and everyone knows what is needed to be done."

He added: "So far, apart from the Dundee United game, we've done what's been needed so far. We know ourselves what we are capable of, fingers crossed at the end of the season we're up there and looking forward to Premiership football"

"They say the older you get it's easier to become a goalkeeper and that's the way I feel. I feel at the moment we've worked the back four solid and we've got plenty of clean sheets too, it's been very good and enjoyable."

Looking towards today's match, Ridgers wants the Caley Jags to continue their excellent run by focusing on themselves but know Partick Thistle will get a lift from the appointment of a new manager.

Ridgers said: "Partick Thistle have brought in a new manager, with Ian McCall coming in and bringing back Alan Archibald so they will have a wee lift. The game against Celtic was always going to be a tricky game for them and I think they knew that as well so we have to be wary of that."

"We have to continue to do what we've been doing. This year we have just been focusing on ourselves now, we know what we have now in the dressing room. We need to continue to produce the results, especially at home. If we can keep the home form up, especially with away form last year which we've continued so far, we just have to keep doing what we're doing "

He added: "Our issue last year was draws and this year, I feel we've got two wins from games which we would possibly would have drawn last season. That's the big change, we have to take each game as it comes, it's an old cliché but it really is that at the moment."

Today will be McCall's first league match in charge of Thistle in his second stint as the club's boss. He was in charge on Wednesday as they lost 5-0 to Celtic in the Betfred Cup Quarter Final.

Thistle are still looking for their first league victory of the season, they have however been impressive in the cup tournaments. They beat Ross County in Betfred Cup at Firhill this season as they qualified ahead of Hamilton in the Group Stages. They will also face Connah's Quay in the next round of the Challenge Cup, after being Montrose in the third round.

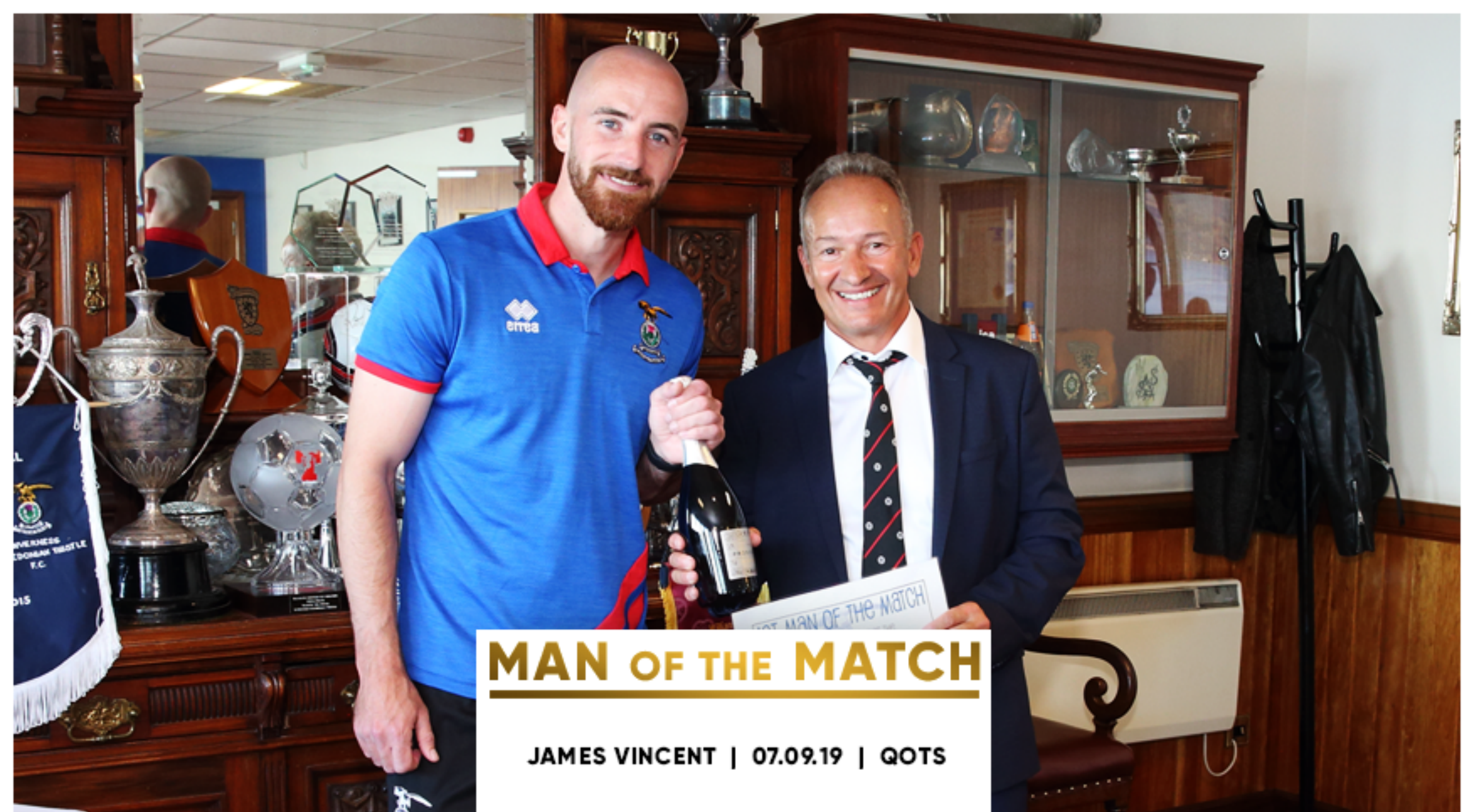

# ICTFC CODE OF CONDUCT

**Inverness Caledonian Thistle FC will not tolerate unacceptable conduct at the Caledonian Stadium or any away football stadia.**

**Unacceptable conduct is conduct which is deemed violent or disorderly.**

**Violent conduct is any actual, attempted or threatened physical violence against any person, or intentional damage to property.**

**Disorderly conduct includes:**

**Conduct which stirs up or sustains or is likely to or is designed to stir up or sustain hatred or ill will towards people or groups of people based on their membership of the following categories:**

- **Gender, Race, Nationality (including citizenship) or ethnic or national origin.**
- **Membership or presumed membership of a religious group or a social or cultural group with perceived religious affiliation.**
- **Sexual orientation**
- **Transgender Identity**
- **Disability**
- **Or against an individual who is perceived to be a part of such group**
- **Using threatening, abusive or insulting words or conduct**
- **Displaying or writing anything which is abusive or insulting**
- **Using words or conduct or displaying any writing or other thing which indicated the support or affiliation to, or the celebrating of, or opposition to an organisation or group proscribed in the terms of the terrorism act of 2000**

**All persons entering The Caledonian Stadium on a matchday are subject to these rules, including employees and volunteers of ICTFC whilst discharging their duties.**

**Any person who engages in unacceptable conduct will be liable for sanctions imposed by the club, which may involve possible criminal proceedings, ejection from the stadium, withdrawal of a season ticket and/or exclusion from future matches at the club.**
