



01. Common Rules & Regulations.

- **1.1** Competitors should be able to produce the SLSBA ID Card.
- **1.2** Entries are accepted from the schools and the schools played in the previous year
- 1.3 The Championship will be conducted for Boys & Girls on semi league basis in Five Divisions A, B, C, D, & E.
- **1.4** The teams should be present at the time allocated in the programme to avoid giving a walk over to the opponents. However, a maximum period of 10 minutes grace period may be allowed. Postponements will not be entertained under any circumstances.
- **1.5** All matches will be played according to the Rules and Regulations of Badminton Approved by the BWF, SLBA & SLSBA.
- 1.6 All Teams / Players should be present 30 minutes before the Scheduled Time
- **1.7** Any dispute with regard to the championship shall be referred to the Tournament Committee. All complaints should be made in writing within half an hours' time after the matches. *(The protests charge will be Rs.500.00).* The decisions taken by the tournament committee on all matters connected with the tournament shall be final and binding on all participants.
- **1.8** Competitors are expected to officiate as Umpires and linesmen and assist the Tournament Committee in conducting the championships.

02. Under 11 Doubles Badminton Team Championships.

- 2.1 Competitors should be Under 11 as at 31st December on the current year.
- 2.2 The Championship will be conducted for Boys & Girls on semi league basis in Five Divisions A, B, C, D, & E. 'A' & 'B' Division Schools are allowed to enter maximum of Two Teams.
 - 2.2.1 But Best players must be in "A" Team. Each team can declare number of players Minimum 8 & Maximum 12
 - **2.2.2** A Schools playing in other Divisions are allowed to enter only One Team.

2.3 A tie shall consist of 5 Doubles.

- 2.3.1 Matches order will be : 1st Double, 2nd Double, 3rd Double, 4th Double, 5th Double.
- **2.3.2** For B, C, D & E Divisions 3 Doubles up to Quarter Finals.
 - **3.3.2.1** Matches order will be : 1st Double, 2nd Double, 3rd Double

- 03. Under 13 Doubles Badminton Team Championships.
 - 3.1 Competitors should be Under 13 as at 31st of December on the current year.
 - 3.2 The Championship will be conducted for Boys & Girls on semi league basis in Five Divisions A, B, C, D, & E.
 - 'A' & 'B' Division are allowed to enter maximum of Two Teams.
 - 3.2.1 But Best Players must be in "A" Team each team can declare number of players Minimum 8 & Maximum 12
 - **3.2.2** Schools playing in Other Divisions are allowed to enter Only One Team.
 - **3.3** A tie shall consist of 5 Doubles.
 - 3.3.1 Matches order will be : 1st Double, 2nd Double, 3rd Double, 4th Double, 5th Double.
 - **3.3.2** For B, C, D & E Divisions 3 Doubles up to Quarter Finals.
 - **3.3.2.1** Matches order will be : 1st Double, 2nd Double, 3rd Double
 - 3.4 Shuttles Cocks
 - **3.4.1** Feather shuttle cocks will be used for "A" Division. (Approved By BWF)
 - 3.4.2 Nylon Shuttles will be used for All Other Divisions
 - 3.5 Entry Fees
 - 3.5.1 See Rule No. 1.15

04. Under 15 Badminton Team Championships.

- 4.1 Competitors should be Under 15 as at 31st of December on the current year.
- 4.2 The Championship will be conducted for Boys & Girls on semi league basis in Five Divisions Supper A / A, B, C, D, & E. 'A' Division & 'B' Division are allowed to enter maximum of Two Teams.
 - 4.2.1 But Best Players must be in "A" Team each team can declare number of players Minimum 5 & Maximum 10
 - 4.2.2 Schools playing in other Divisions are allowed to enter only One Team.
- 4.3 A tie shall consist of 3 Singles & 2 Doubles.
 - 4.3.1 Singles players cannot play Doubles
 - 4.3.2 Matches order will be : 1st Single, 1st Double, 2nd Single, 2nd Double, 3rd Single
 - 4.3.3 C, D & E Divisions 2 Singles & 1 Double up to Quarter Finals.
 - 4.3.3.1 Matches order will be : 1st Single, 1st Double, 2nd Single
- 4.4 Shuttles Cocks
 - **3.4.1** Feather shuttle cocks will be used for "A" Division.
 - 3.4.2 Nylon Shuttles will be used for All Other Divisions
- 2.5 Entry Fees
 - 2.5.1 See Rule No. 1.15

05. Under 17 Badminton Team Championships.

- 5.1 Competitors should be Under 17 as at 31st of December on the current year.
- 5.2 The Championship will be conducted for Boys & Girls on semi league basis in Five Divisions Supper A / A, B, C, D, & E. "Supper A" Division & "B" Division are allowed to enter maximum of Two Teams.
 - 5.2.1 But Best Players must be in "A" Team each team can declare number of players Minimum 5 & Maximum 10
 5.2.2 Schools playing in other Divisions are allowed to enter Only One Team.
- 5.3 A tie shall consist of 3 Singles & 2 Doubles.
 - 4.3.1 Singles players cannot play Doubles
 - 4.3.2 Matches order will be : 1st Single, 1st Double, 2nd Single, 2nd Double, 3rd Single
 - 4.3.3 C, D & E Divisions 2 Singles & 1 Double up to Quarter Finals.
 - 4.3.3.1 Matches order will be : 1st Single, 1st Double, 2nd Single





- 5.4 Shuttles Cocks
 - **3.4.1** Feather shuttle cocks will be used for "A" Division.
 - **3.4.2** Nylon Shuttles will be used for All Other Divisions
- 2.5 Entry Fees

06. Under 19 Badminton Team Championships.

- 6.1 Competitors should be Under 19 as at 31st of December on the current year.
- 6.2 The Championship will be conducted for Boys & Girls on semi league basis in Five Divisions Supper A / A, B, C, D, & E. "Supper A" Division & "B" Division are allowed to enter maximum of Two Teams.
 - 6.2.1 But Best Players must be in "A" Team each team can declare number of players Minimum 5 & Maximum 10
 - 6.2.2 Schools playing in other Divisions are allowed to enter only One Team.
- 6.3 A tie shall consist of 3 Singles & 2 Doubles.
 - 4.3.1 Singles players cannot play Doubles
 - 4.3.2 Matches order will be : 1st Single, 1st Double, 2nd Single, 2nd Double, 3rd Single
 - 4.3.3 C, D & E Divisions 2 Singles & 1 Double up to Quarter Finals.
 - 4.3.3.1 Matches order will be : 1st Single, 1st Double, 2nd Single

6.4 Shuttles Cocks

- **3.4.1** Feather shuttle cocks will be used for "A" Division.
- 3.4.2 Nylon Shuttles will be used for All Other Divisions
- 2.5 Entry Fees
 - 2.5.1 See Rule No. 1.15
- 2.6 How to Selected Knockout Draw, after playing Group Matches 2.6.1 See Rule No 1.16

07. Junior Nationals Badminton Championship

- 7.1 Zonal Competitions
 - 7.1.1 Need to be organized by the zonal coordinators with their respective TIC's.

7.2 Final competitions

- 7.2.1 Will be organized by Tournament Committee of SLSBA Collaborate with SLBA.
- 7.3 The following events will be worked out.

7.3.1	Boys / Girls	Under	11	Singles
7.3.2	Boys / Girls	Under	13	Singles / Doubles
7.3.3	Boys / Girls	Under	15	Singles / Doubles
7.3.4	Boys / Girls	Under	17	Singles / Doubles
7.3.5	Boys / Girls	Under	19	Singles / Doubles

- 7.4 Competitors could take part in one age group. However those who are playing under 11 singles will be permitted to play in the under 13 doubles event.
- 7.5 There will be an Open Mixed Doubles event too.
 - 7.5.1 But only eight pairs will be selected to compete in this event. Preference will be given to those who perform well in the under 17 & 19 events.
 - **7.5.2 Entries for the Mixed Doubles will be accepted from those whom qualify during the final rounds.** *(Notice will be given)*

7.6 The entry fees are as follows *(See Rule No. 1.15)*

- 7.6.1 Singles : Rs. 250.00 (Per player)
- 7.6.2 Doubles : Rs. 400.00 (Per pair)
- 7.6.3 Registration fees : Nil





- 7.7 Seeded players will be exempted from the zonal competitions. However the players who have been seeded for the singles not for doubles may have to play the doubles event at the zonal competition.
- 7.8 Competitors shall be allowed to play only with the doubles partners nominated by them in the entry form. Partners name should necessarily be indicated on the entry form.
- 7.9 A competitor will be allowed to substitute a partner if his / her original nominated partner is prevented from playing through illness, injury or other unavoidable hindrance. Such proposed substitute shall be notified to the tournament referee or an appointed official in writing before the commencement of that particular event.

Such substitution should not be of a higher rank that the original nominated players and the new combination should be of a lower standard than the original combination.

- 7.10 Girls & Boys entries must be on different entry forms. (This applies to mixed doubles too)
- 7.11 The final rounds of Under 11 & 13 events will be worked out with Nylon Shuttles & Under 15,17 & 19 events will be worked out with feather Shuttles. Nylon Shuttles will be used for zonal rounds in all age groups.
- 7.12 Participants produce their SLSBA ID Card during the zonal rounds & the final rounds.
- 7.13 Winners, Runners-up & Second Runners-up will receive Certificates, Medals etc.
- 7.14 The overall championship shield will be awarded to the school which gets highest number of points scored according to the performances of the final rounds.
 - **7.14.1 Mixed Doubles event will not be considered.** (Overall championship points system will be circulated along with the final round draw)
- 7.15 This tournament will run on Knock out basis & all matches will be held according to the rules & regulations of BWF and adapted by the SLBA & SLSBA.
- 7.16 If a player conceded a walk-over in any event due to injury / illness or absence, he/she will not be allowed to participate in the other events of the tournament on the same day. Any exceptional circumstance will be referred to the Referee or appointed official for the decision.
- 7.17 Players are subject to a minimum of 20 minutes rest period between any two matches.
- 7.18 The decision of the umpire on all matters connected with the actual play in the match of which he/she is umpiring shall be final.
- 7.19 Players must be punctual and any player who does not turn up for his / her match at the time allocated will be liable to have a walk over given against him / her. Ten (10) minutes grace period will be allowed. No postponements shall be allowed under any circumstances.
- 7.20 The participants will be required to keep lines and umpire matches when called upon to do so by the tournament committee / appointed officials.
- 7.21 All disputes with regard to the championships shall be referred to the Referee & SLSBA Tournament Committee. The decision or the Referee & SLSBA Tournament Committee on all matters connected with the tournament and any matter not provided for shall be final and binding on all participants.
- 7.22 Before the closing date Entries should be send to General Secretary, Sri Lanka Schools Badminton Association, Entries should be send by "Registered Post" along with the entry fees.
 - 7.22.1 Cheques should be drawn in favor of "SRI LANKA SCHOOLS BADMINTON ASSOCIATION" & be crossed.
 - 7.22.2 Money orders will not be accepted.
