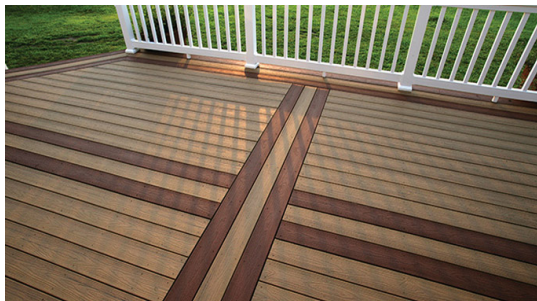


One of the most essential things to remember about your deck is that it's outdoors and most decks are built utilizing wood and wood over time can end up being damaged if not preserved correctly.
