We will need to replenish a lot of supplies this year, as well as purchase close to 300 backpacks. In June we will be passing a backpack each Sunday during services to collect donations to help fund this major community outreach.

Registration starts at 7:45 a.m. Parking and the start of the race is off East Drive at the Hinckley Spillway.

Registration will close at 8:20 a.m. on the day of the race and will cost \$25 for the 5K Run and \$15.00 for the 1 Mile Walk or \$25.00 for a Family of three or more. Cash or check only on the day of the race.

Medals will be awarded for the top three overall male and female runners in the 5K Run.
