Can I edit a PDF in Google Drive?

It can be difficult to share documents between offices located in different areas of the country, or the world. This problem can affect anyone working on the same floor or in the same building. Google Sheets and Google Docs allow you to collaborate in real-time, provide you with a document authoring tool, and store your files online. Multiple users can edit the same document simultaneously and view any changes instantly. Google is widely used for word processing and online file storage. You can also store and use a PDF editor in this framework.

How can I compress PDF?

It is not difficult to understand that PDF files can become large and cumbersome, making it difficult to upload or send to the internet. The file's size and data can quickly grow depending on how it was saved. If you need to send a PDF to a printer for commercial purposes and have 5,000 copies to hand at a trade show, then saving it as "high-quality print" is the best option. You don't have to save the file this large if you are sending it to someone to proofread.

A robust PDF editor tool makes it easy to reduce the file size. Apple's Preview app is included on Macs. It can do almost everything when it comes PDF editing.

Here are some ways to reduce the size of your PDF on a Mac

- 1. The Preview app will open the PDF.
- 2. Click on "Export as PDF" under the "File" menu.

3. Click "Show details" and select "Reduce file size" from the dropdown menu.

4. You can save the smaller PDF version.

How to reduce PDF size using Acrobat DC (pdf editor on Mac & Windows)

- 1. Adobe Acrobat will open your file.
- 2. Click on "File" and then "Save as Another."
- 3. From the drop-down menu, select "Reduce Size PDF ..."".
- 4. It is best to determine your compatibility. You can change it to an older version of Adobe Acrobat if you have a very small file.
- 5. Select "OK."
- 6. If you wish to create a smaller file of the original, rename it. You can keep the original large file. You can overwrite the original file if you keep the file name and location the same.
- 7. Select "Save".
- 8. Acrobat will ask you if you want to overwrite the original file. If you're happy to replace the file, click "Replace."
