Dear participants of the First Health Partnership Conference Ukraine/Germany,

the Ukrainian health system is suffering heavy losses due to the war. To this day, more than 1.000 health structures have been hit and destroyed. Many health professionals are killed, injured, traumatized, or find themselves refugees.

While the health system and service provision are weakened, the needs of a war-torn population are higher than ever: mental and physical trauma, rehabilitation, epidemic control, mother and child healthcare under conditions of mass displacement - the challenges are overwhelming.

From a public health perspective, investing in early response will be decisive to protect human productivity for generations to come. While service provision is the top priority, health system reconstruction is of imminent necessity as well and presents an opportunity with regard to the European Integration.

Against this grim background, the Federal Ministry of Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) started early on to support and amplify hospital partnerships between Ukraine and Germany. Within the last year a dense cooperation network of more than 50 Ukrainian and German health care institutions has been established providing a unique platform for promoting Ukrainian. Together with activities from the German Ministry of Health and in close and permanent cooperation with Ukrainian governmental institutions, the network of hospital partnerships provides a unique opportunity for transforming the Ukrainian health care system towards more resilience for the time of war and importantly- beyond. This is a long-term endeavor, and this conference is the first step on a path with a clearly defined goal. We are more than honored that so many colleagues and acteurs from political, non-governmental, and health institutions have agreed to participate. We are especially thankful that our Ukrainian partners and friends agreed to come to Berlin to give us the urgently needed insights into the current situation.

The overall objective of the conference is to deepen partnerships, exchange experiences, find new synergies, and raise ambitions!
