

Snip & Sketch keyboard shortcuts

1. **Alt + M**: Choose a snipping mode
2. **Alt + N**: Create a new snip in the same mode as the last one
3. **Shift + Arrow keys**: Move the cursor to select from different types of snips
4. **Alt + D**: Delay capture by 1 - 5 seconds
5. **Alt + R**: Crop snip
6. **Alt + I**: Select pen tool
7. **Alt + I then Alt + I**: Select pen color
8. **Alt + H**: - This shortcut enables the highlighter tool,
9. **Alt + H then Alt + H**: Select highlighter color
10. **Alt + E**: This shortcut activates the eraser tool,
11. **Alt + E then Alt + E**: Open drop-down menu with 'Select all ink'
12. **Alt + T** - This shortcut enables touch typing mode,
13. **Alt + Z**: - Pressing this combination activates the zoom tool,
14. **Ctrl + C or Alt + C**: These shortcuts allow you to copy the captured snip to the clipboard
14. **Ctrl + S**: This shortcut is used to save the snip.
15. **Alt + A**: This shortcut is used to share the snip
16. **Alt + M**: This shortcut is used to open the '...' menu. Pressing Alt + M opens a drop-down menu with additional options such as copying the snip to clipboard, printing, etc
17. **Ctrl + O**: Open a file

18. Ctrl + P: Used to print the snip

19. Ctrl + Z or Alt + U: These shortcuts are used to undo an action.

20. Ctrl + Y or Alt + D: These shortcuts are used to redo an action.

21. Alt + F4: This shortcut is used to exit Snip & Sketch

22. Mouse scroller : You can use the mouse scroller to pan the snip area.

23. Ctrl + Mouse Scroller: Zoom in or out while capturing a snip
