

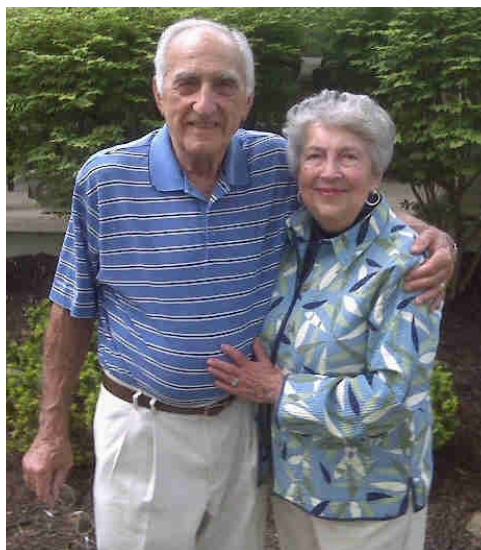
JUSTIN AND MARYAN DANTONIO MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This is the 2nd year for scholarships and the goal of the Justin and Maryan Dantonio Memorial Scholarship is to award \$1,000 scholarships to a female and male Senior student graduating from Zanesville High School in 2020 who will continue their education as a part-time or full-time student at an accredited school (college, university, community college, trade school, vocational school, technical school, or etc.).

Frank stated, "We have devoted a lot of thought to make sure we developed the appropriate requirements for the Justin and Maryan Dantonio Memorial Scholarship to reward two graduating Zanesville High School Senior students for their past academic, community, athletic, and extracurricular activities."

Mark added, "Because of my long- time relationships with Coach Ron Apperson and other ZHS coaches while playing football, their involvement and guidance have played important roles to award these scholarships to help ZHS students and honor our parents."

- B. Applicant must be in good standing with high ethical standards at Zanesville High School and in the larger Zanesville community area.
- C. Applicant must plan to enroll as a part-time or full-time student at an accredited school (college, university, community college, trade school, vocational school, and etc.) to continue their education in 2020.
- D. If awarded a scholarship, applicant agrees the scholarship will be exclusively used to pay for expenses directly related to their 2020 / 2021 continued education (tuition, room, meals, books, fees, transportation, and etc.).
- E. By signing this scholarship application, applicant and applicant's parent(s) or guardian(s) agree to:
 - a. Provide and unconditionally release any confidential and / or privileged information to members of the Justin and Maryan Dantonio Memorial Scholarship organization.
 - b. Permit applicant's name, picture, and personal information to be released to the public and used for various publicity purposes.

4. Letter of Character / Recommendation from one Zanesville community individual (non-relative).
5. On one page of paper with maximum of 400 words: Describe significant school, extracurricular, community, religious, athletic, academic, honors, awards, and other activities during past four years.
6. On one page of paper with maximum of 400 words: Describe most difficult issue(s) faced in your life and how you addressed this issue(s).
7. On one page of paper with maximum of 400 words: Describe what you do for fun and enjoyment, why this scholarship is important to you, and what are your future career goals.
