
Good evening and a warm welcome to you all.

I want to make my Disco 300tdi as secure as possible as far too many Land Rovers go missing and I am also looking at keeping it away from my house at my mums as it will fit in the top of her garden. Her garage has been broken into before, so security is an issue.

So far I have fitted a âSafe T Pedalâ lock that makes it pretty much immobile and is well worth the £70 as it comes fitted with a decent high security lock. I managed to get a £15 discount on the website price of £95 and this is still open to club members if they wish to buy one.

Still wanting more security I have done some research and found a Kent based company <a href="www.retainagroup.com">www.retainagroup.com</a> They for £35.25 will register your vehicle on their database (for life) and supply you with warning labels plus unique stencils and UV marking labels and self-etching labels, so you can mark all the panels, plastic parts and windows on your vehicle.

After contacting them they sent me an article showing they did an offer in aland Rover Internationala magazine a couple of years back and this is the kit that is still on offer as they donat normally deal with individuals. All the labels are laser cut and very good quality.

I was worried about all the accessories, so I am going to tack weld all the bolts and label all the parts with the self-etching labels.

Now I feel a bit happier and safer.

I will put both offers up on the club website.
