Used Japanese automobiles are thought to be excellent motor cars with a long life. They are used Japanese cars are viewed as solid and durable, making them widely used in the auto market of Bangladesh. Around 80% of cars in Bangladesh come from Japan. Car Import to Bangladesh should be done in right-hand-drive because the vehicles travel on the left-hand side of the road.

Conditions of Import

Importation of cars used in Bangladesh including jeeps micro-buses and many more vehicles is only permitted under the conditions mentioned below:

Vehicle imports are permitted only from the country of origin. importation is not allowed by any third entity.

The vehicle's age must not exceed four years old.

The import date for an vehicle will be determined by the first day of manufacturing through the end of the year.

The car must be integrated with the left-hand drive.

The JAAI certificate should contain the model number, age and the chassis number of the vehicle. That certificate should be given to the customs department.

Ports for shipping

The import of vehicles are done through ports like Chittagong or Dhaka. RORO (roll on rolling off) is the most common shipping method. However, other methods of shipment can also be arranged on the customer's requirements.

Documents required:

The following documents are required to clear port

Original passport and copy of work permit

Certificate of Title and Registration

Invoice, registration to establish the age

Country of Origin Certificate

Original Bill of Lading (BoL)

Condition Report on the Vehicle

Authorization Letter

The Chief Controller for Foreigners requires an import permit.

Inspection

Imported vehicles imported from Japan must be able to pass the JAAI (Japan Auto Appraisal Institute), inspection.

Taxes on imports

Import tax 0-40 percent

15 percent value-added tax (VAT)

Imports subject to 2.5 per cent infrastructure development surcharge

Nationals who return to Bangladesh who has been residing abroad for ten years or greater will be considered "returning nationals", and are qualified for the obligation-free importation of one vehicle, provided that the vehicle was maintained for at least two years. The specific conditions of returning citizens as well as their potential contribution to state-building will be considered.
