Caldy Cricket Club aim to provide an opportunity to boys and girls to learn and participate in the game of cricket in a friendly and enjoyable environment, with the emphasis on enjoyment and participation within the spirit of cricket. The Club offers training to all age groups on Friday evenings.

The Club enter teams into the Wirral Junior Cricket League and Cheshire County Cricket League Juniors (for U15s only) and their respective cup competitions with games played mainly on Sunday mornings with some additional fixtures and cup competitions held on weekday evenings. Caldy's player selection policy is based on trying to give all members the opportunity for match experience throughout the season, particularly for the younger players (U9s and U11s) and, with the older players (U13s upwards), with final selection based on ability and performance in training.

We would like to point out that we are not insured for unregistered children. Therefore anyone that is not registered will not be allowed to play in matches and we will not be able to accept responsibility for them at training sessions.

The Club have fully qualified ECB coaches headed by Keith Beggs. Chris Edwards is a current England international. Keith also offers cricket schools within the holiday periods.
