Grandfathered Transfer: [Student Transfer Options](#)

A **Grandfathered Transfer** is available

- a) only for a student who has been rezoned by OCPS two or more times during a school level (K-5, 6-8, 9-12) at the current address or
- b) who has been rezoned from an established school to another established school. In this case, the student may remain at the existing school instead of being assigned to the rezoned school or
- c) rezoned for the 5th or 8th grade year.

The following shall apply to **Grandfathered Transfers**:

- Transportation is not provided by OCPS;
- There is no transfer eligibility for siblings who do not meet the same criteria for a Grandfathered Transfer

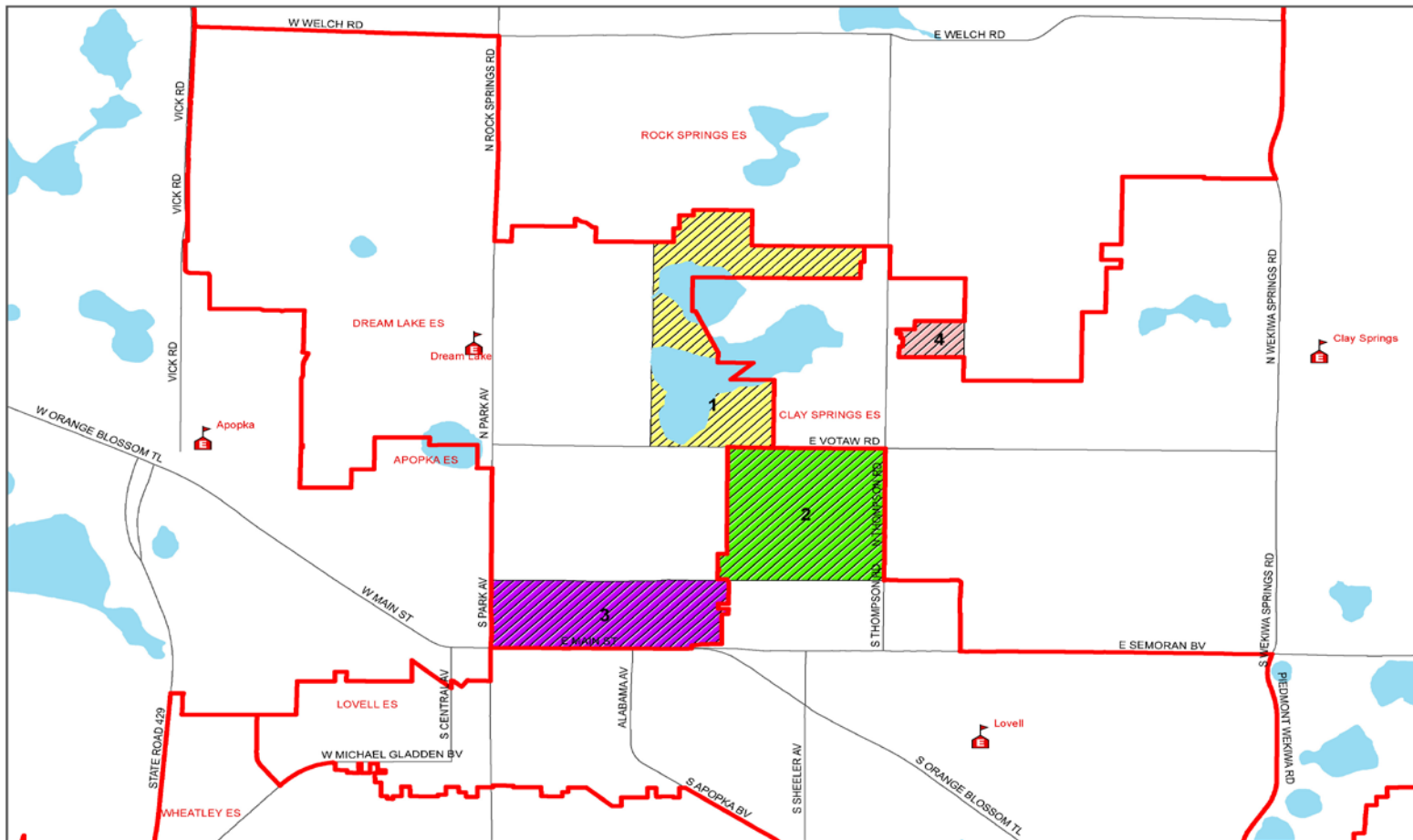

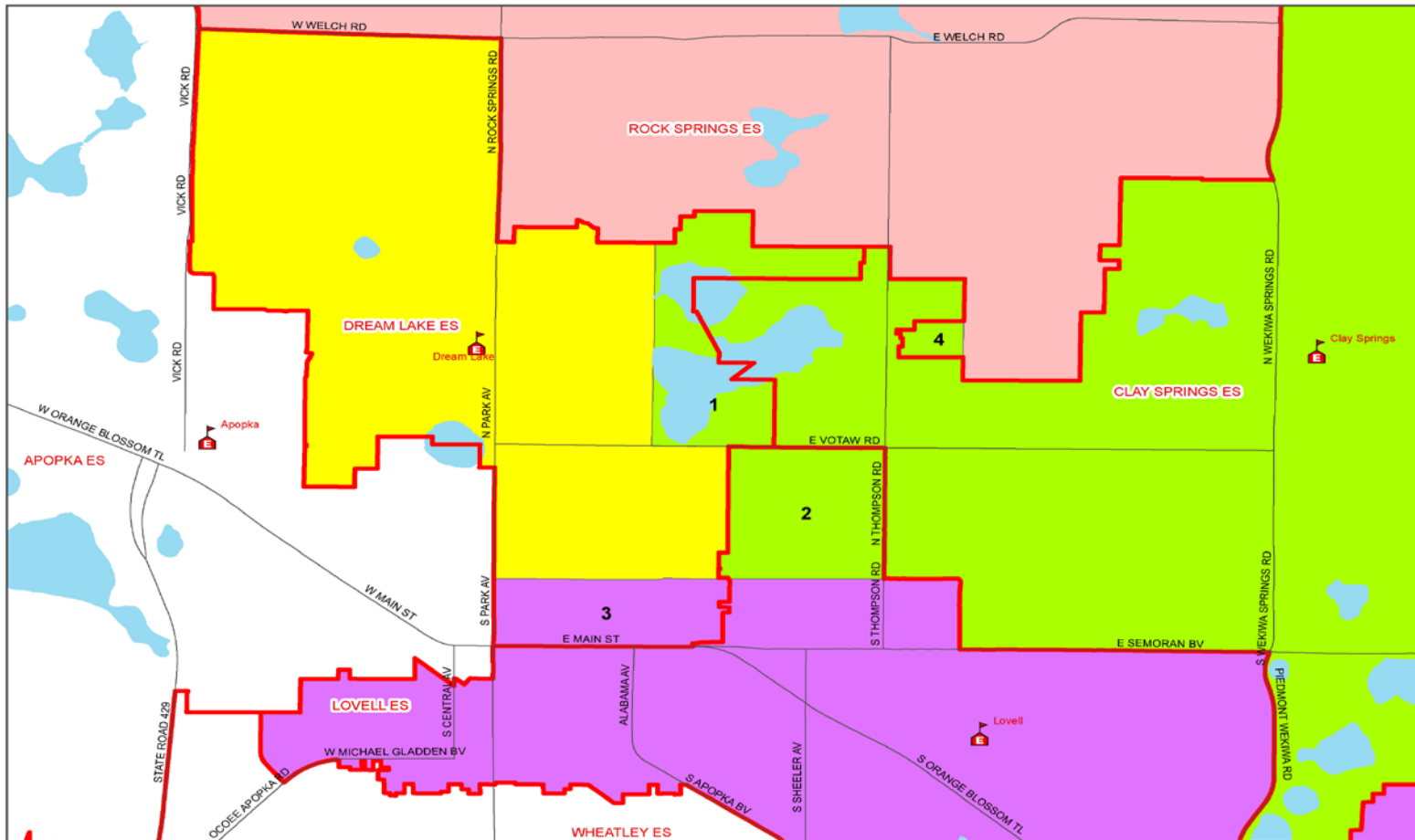
