

"We have a series of incidents in the country that are being felt mainly due to bad weather," an ANCP spokesperson told Lusa, adding that between 40 and 479 cases were registered this Sunday from 12:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. .

According to the ANPC, among the numerous situations of falling trees and floods, "the most affected district is Viana do Castelo, where 160 incidents occurred."

On Saturday, Civil Protection strongly warned about the possibility of flooding in urban areas, particularly in the north and center of the country, and recommended reducing travel on New Year's Eve. **[Follow Us To Find Out More Calisto News](#)**

According to the national commander of ANEPC, André Fernandez, the river basins with "greatest risk of urban flooding as well as flooding" are "the Minho, Lima, Cavado, Eau, Douro, Voga, Mondego and Tagus rivers."

A source from the National Emergency and Civil Protection Authority (ANEPC) revealed this morning that a wall had collapsed in Cervera, but there were no fatalities.

"It is possible that some properties have been damaged, but luckily nothing else. But they don't have hands to measure, no," said the source, contacting Lusa at the ANEPC headquarters, due to the difficulty of establishing direct contact with the District Command in Vienna. or Castle.
