## Know more about Citing Sources in APA and Harvard Style - 2021

Mostly the academicians instruct students to use APA or Harvard referencing style for citations. If you are asked to do any of these formatting styles and you don't have a clear understanding of the referencing rules then you are at the right place. Today <u>college paper writing service</u> will take you to the details of APA and Harvard referencing style. So follow me to have a deeper understanding of both referencing styles.

The common referencing styles that are Harvard, Oxford, APA style, MLA style, and Chicago style are used in academic writings. But we will be only talking about APA and Harvard **citation styles** in today's discussion. A short discussion and guidelines will be given to you about these styles. The similarity is in the in-text citation for author and date and full citations in the reference list. Have a review of both styles by <u>essay writer service</u>.

#### **APA Style**

APA style includes a reference list and an in-text citation. In APA style, a reference list is attached at the end of the paper. In the in-text citation, you cite sources within your text when you use someone's quotes or any piece of information as evidence.

**In-text citation.** For in-text citation, while using APA style, you have to give a reference where you have given any outside source. For this, you will give the author surname along with the date in the text. Remember to add a page number for a direct quote but there is no need to use a page number when you rephrase someone's work. For example

For rephrasing: Richards (2016) suggests that one should take exercise at least for 2 hours a day (p.4).

**For a direct quote:** "for younger individuals thinking patterns can vary based on the situation "(Richardson, 2018, p. 77).

# List of references

For making a complete reference you will add the complete name of the author along with the date of publication. Then you will write the name of the topics and volume number and page number of the journal. Also add the publisher name, and publication city. For example,

William, S. T. (2020). Theories of motivation. *Journal of individual differences*, 35(1), 15-45, New York, USA.

### **Harvard Style**

Harvard style is also called author-date style. In Harvard style, a bibliography is attached. When using Harvard style brackets are used for in-text citations when used within text or in the footnotes. Complete references are listed in the bibliography. Let's discuss the in-text citation style and bibliographic list style for Harvard formatting.

**In-text citation:** text citation will be given within the text where you refer to some source. Here you will use the name of the author and the year in which the work is published. Same as APA, you will use page numbers only when quoting someone's words without rephrasing them. These are very simple tips. Rephrasing: Stanley1990) argues that self-driving cars can help reduce air pollution.

Quotation: "self-driving cars can help to reduce air pollution" (Stanley, 1990, p.44)

**Bibliographic list.** When you are interested in making your sources in Harvard style you have to produce a bibliographic list at the end of the paper. For example, the book will be referred to as Harry, D. and Simmons, M. (2016) *The business tactics: to have your name.* Berkeley: Guilford Press
