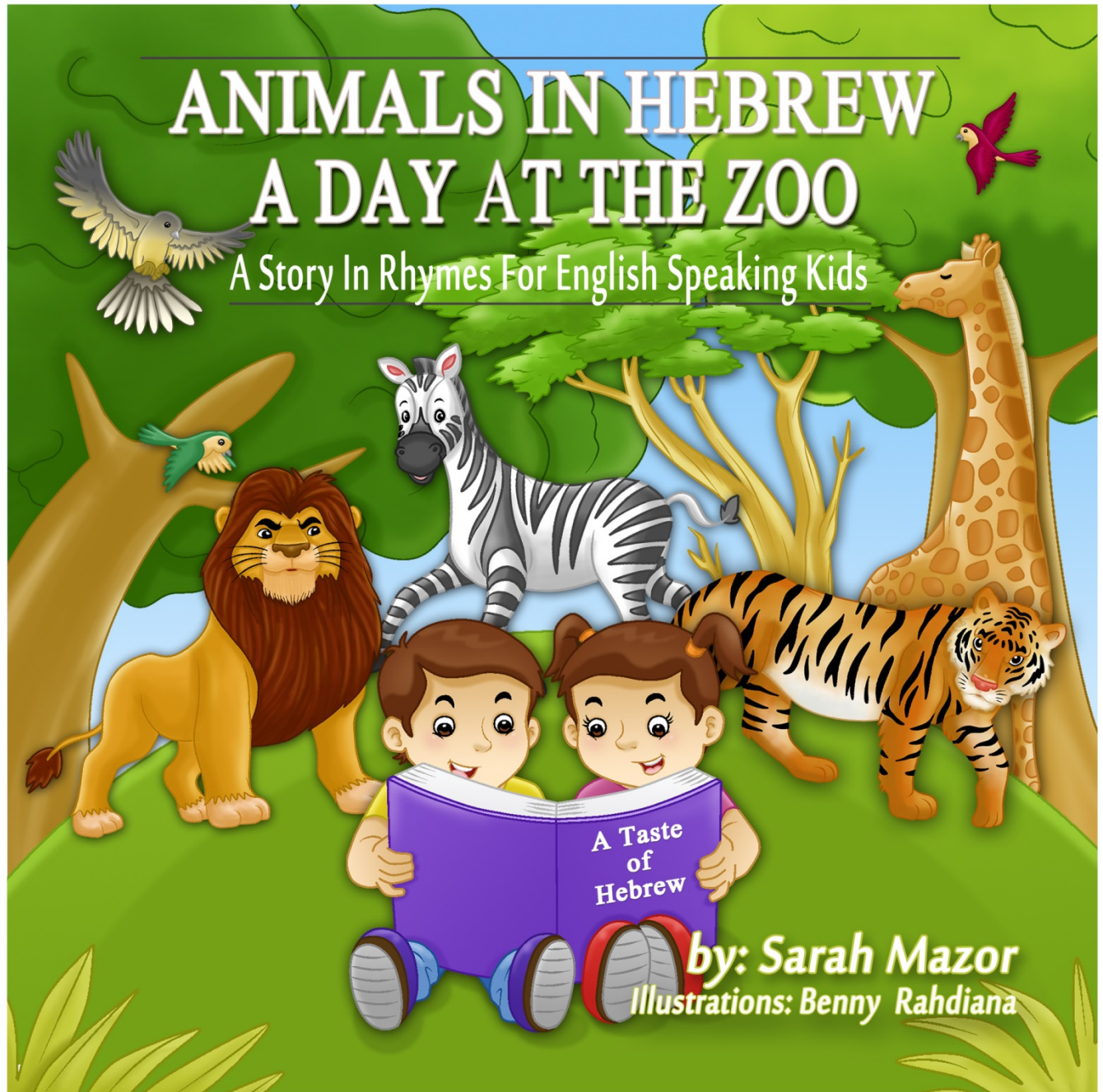
A Taste of Hebrew - Colors

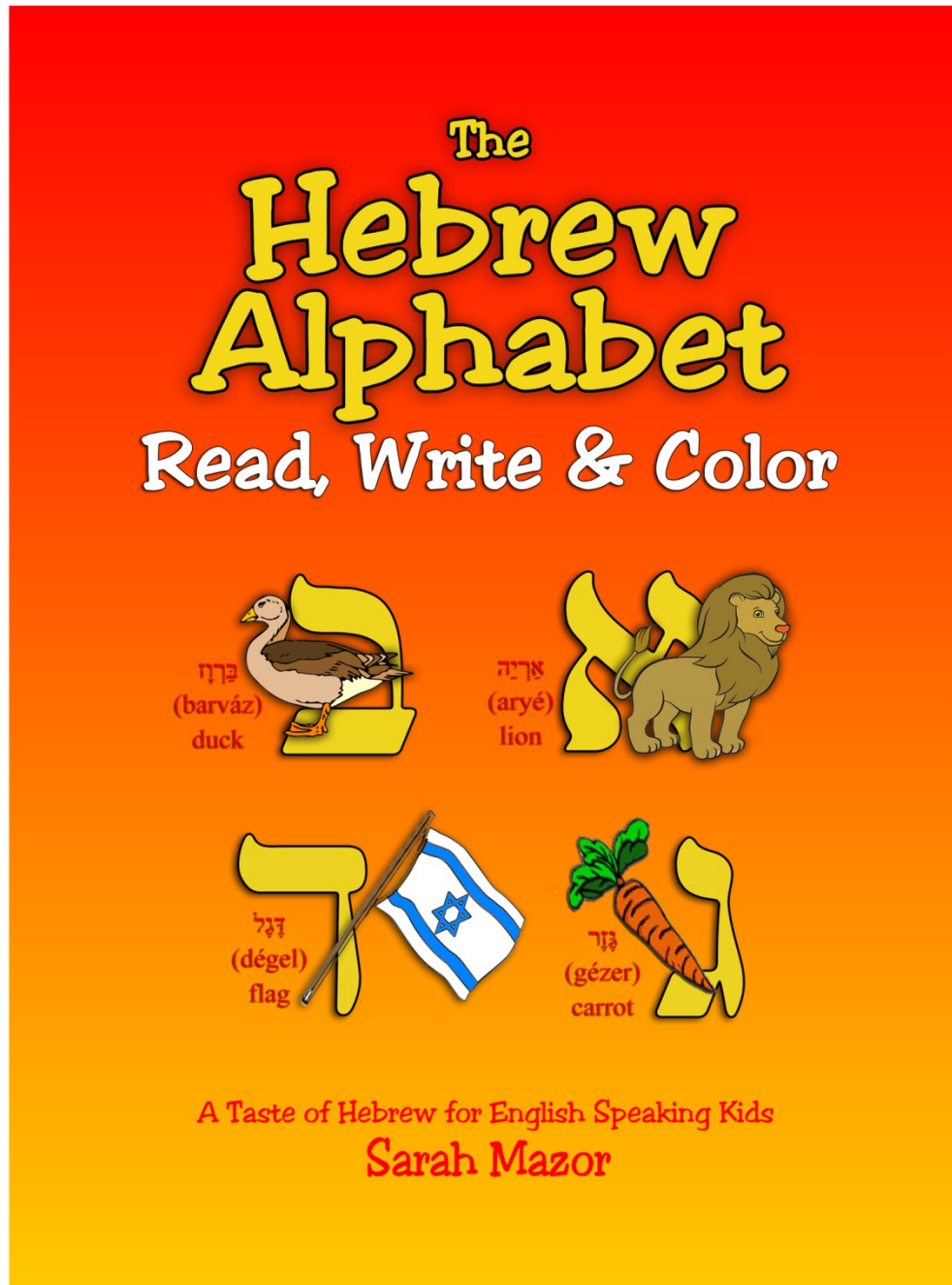
A Taste of Hebrew - Fruits

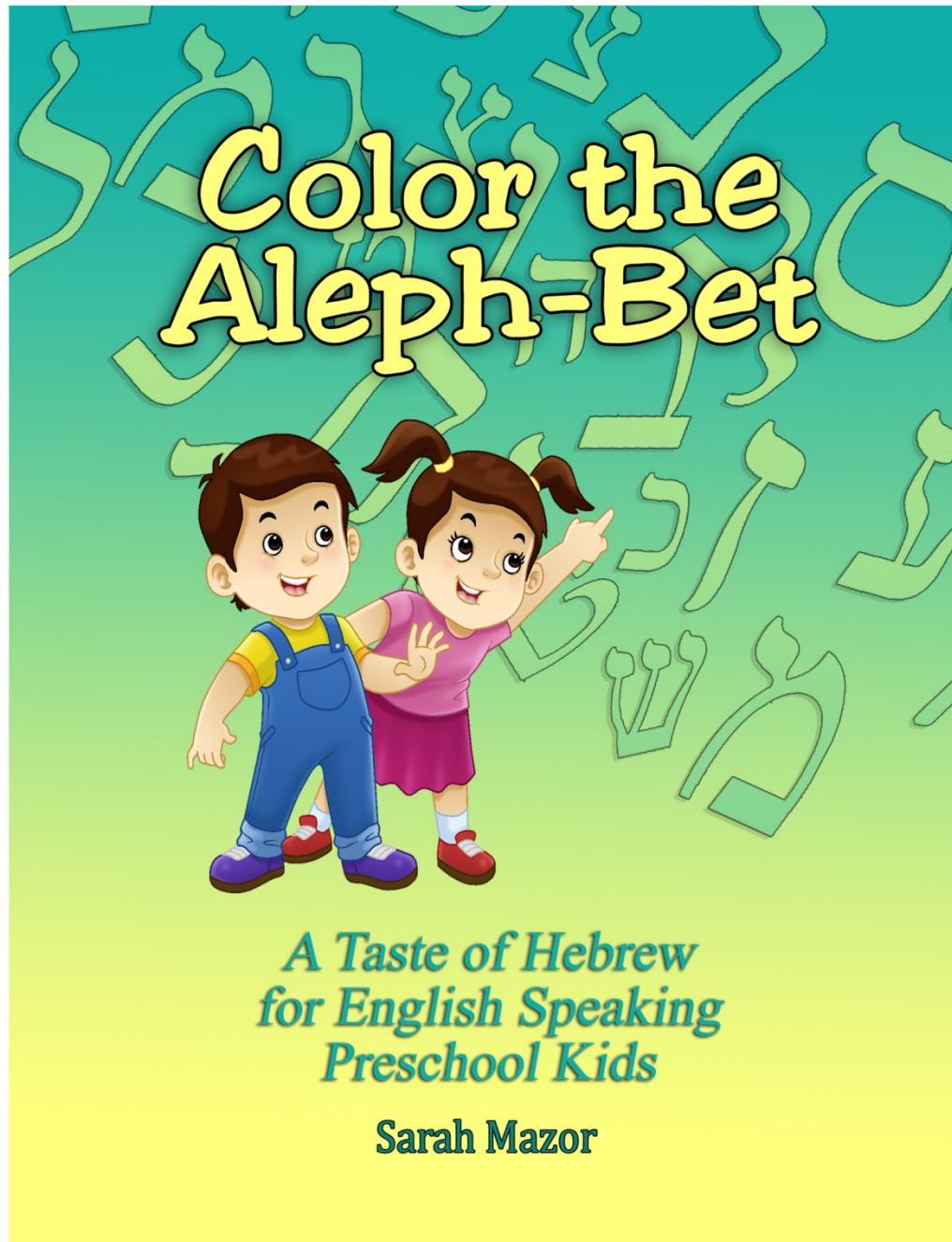
Interactive Learning

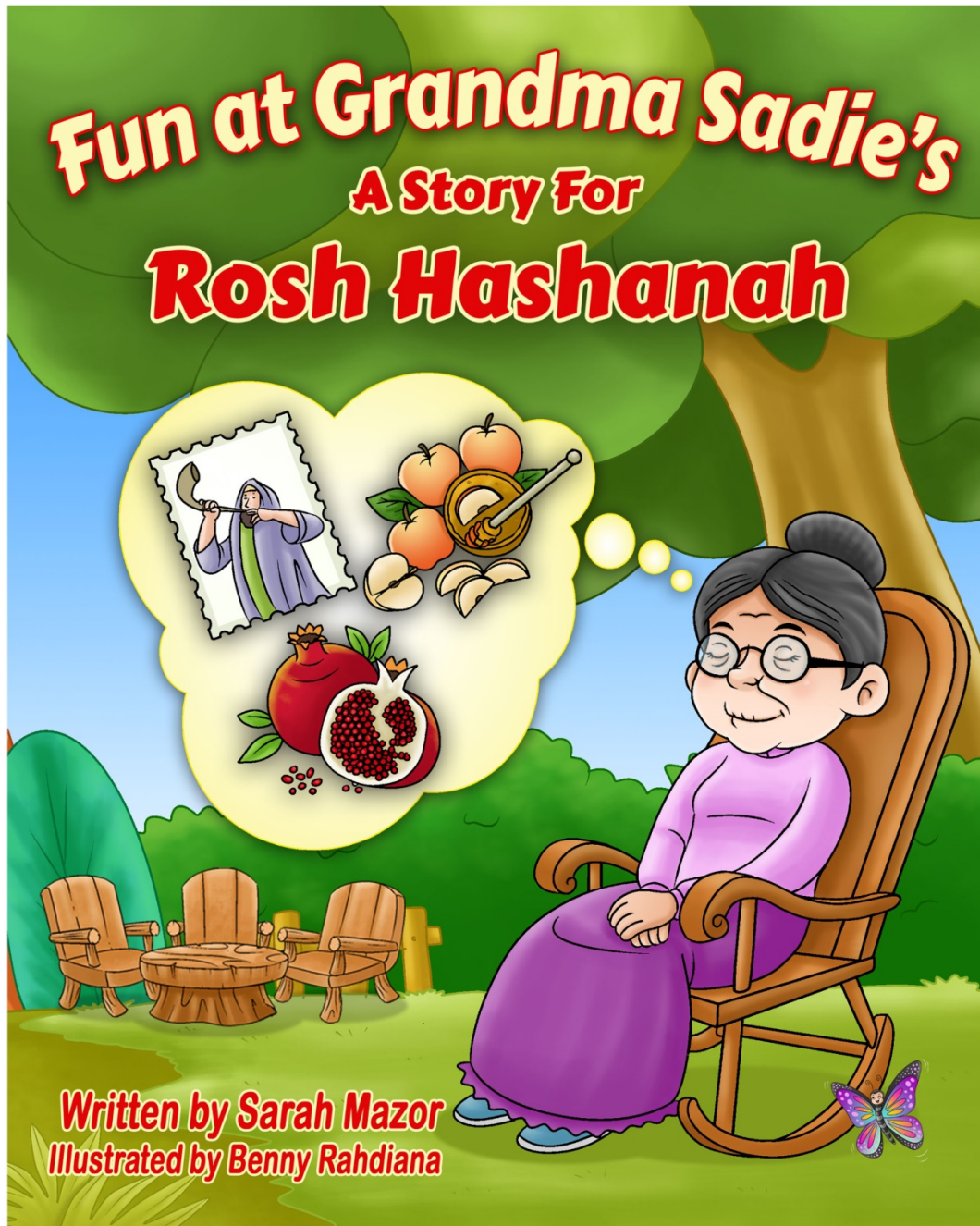
Interactive Learning

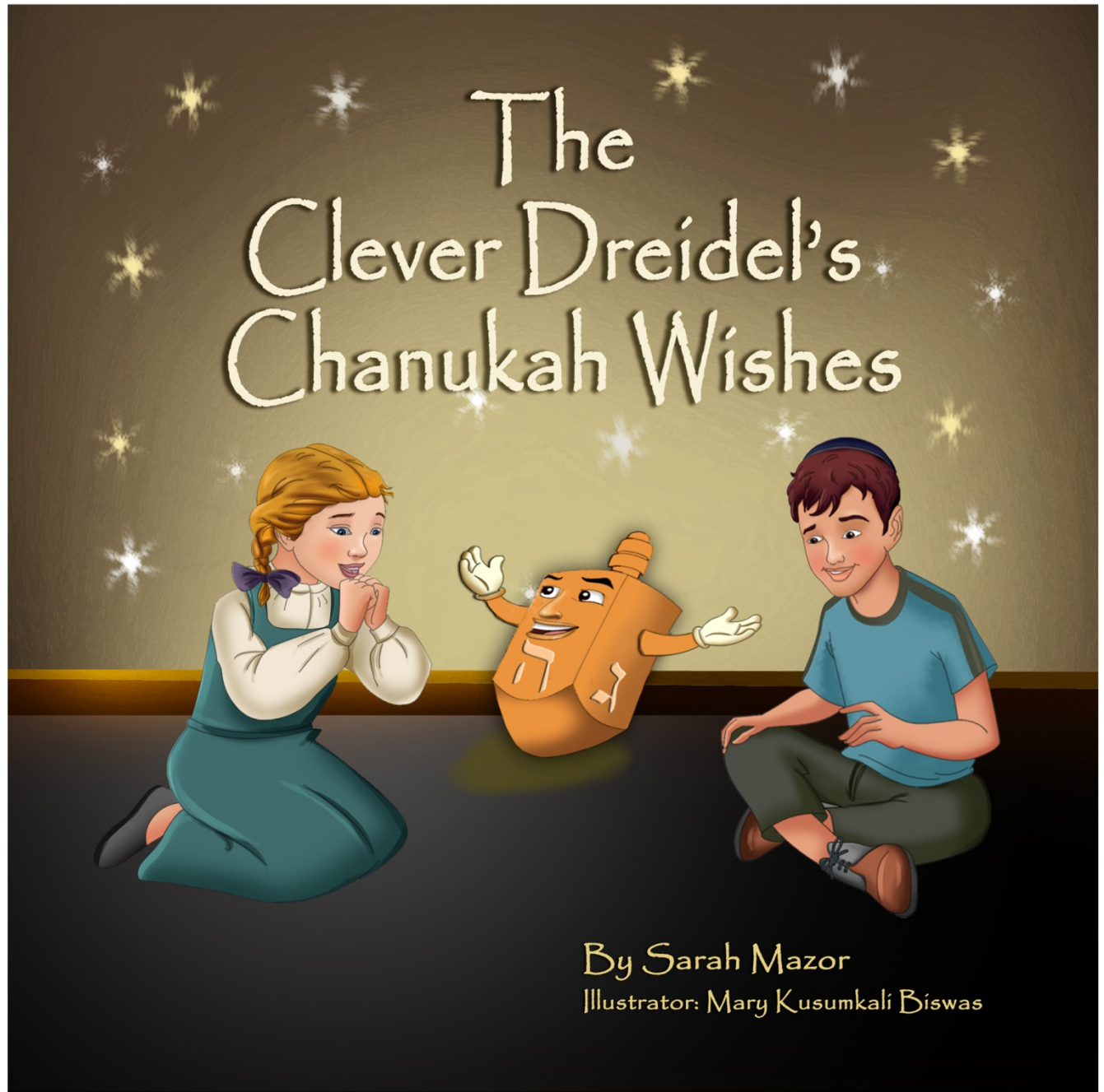
A Special Sukkah

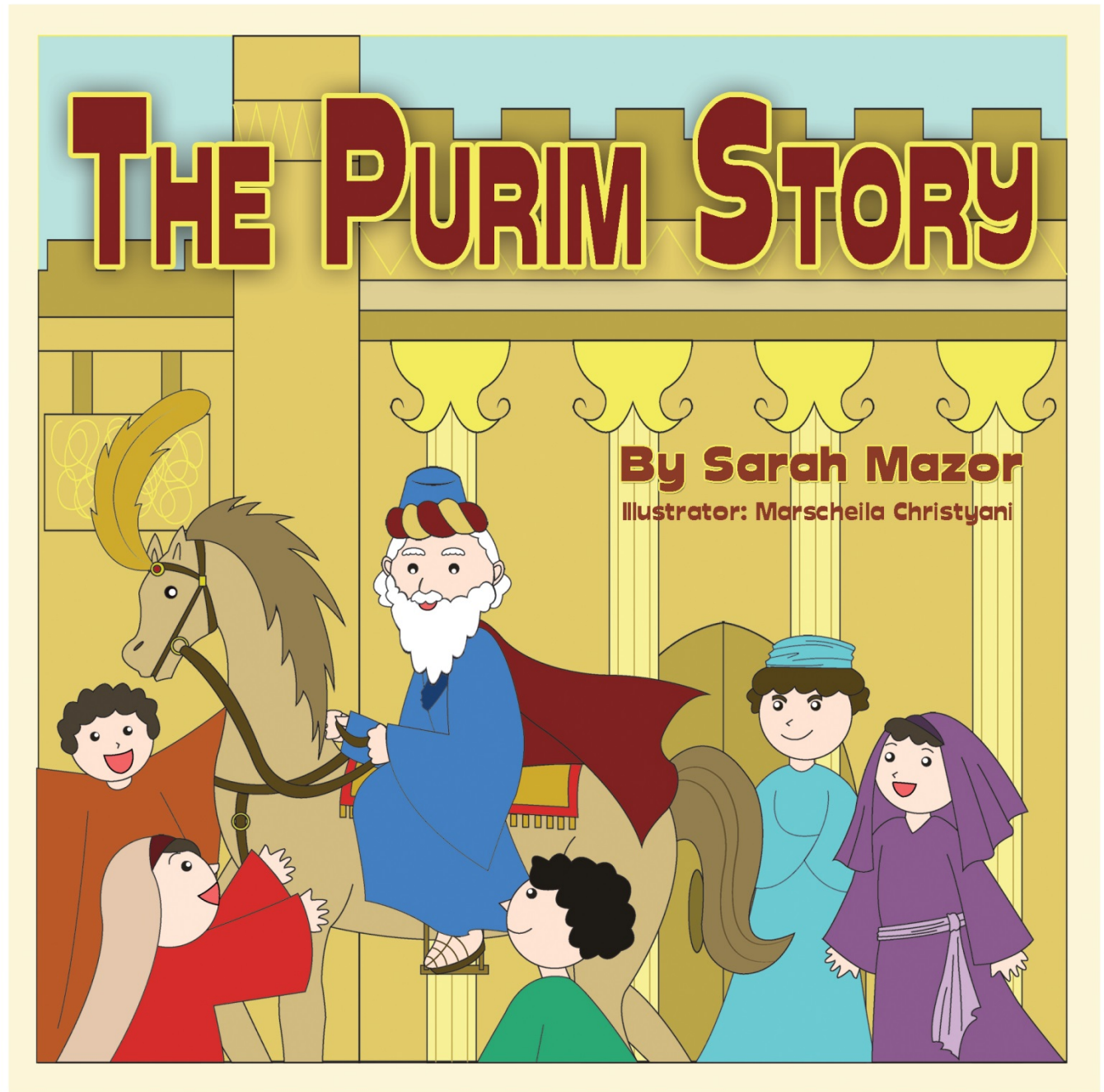
There was a Little Dreidel...

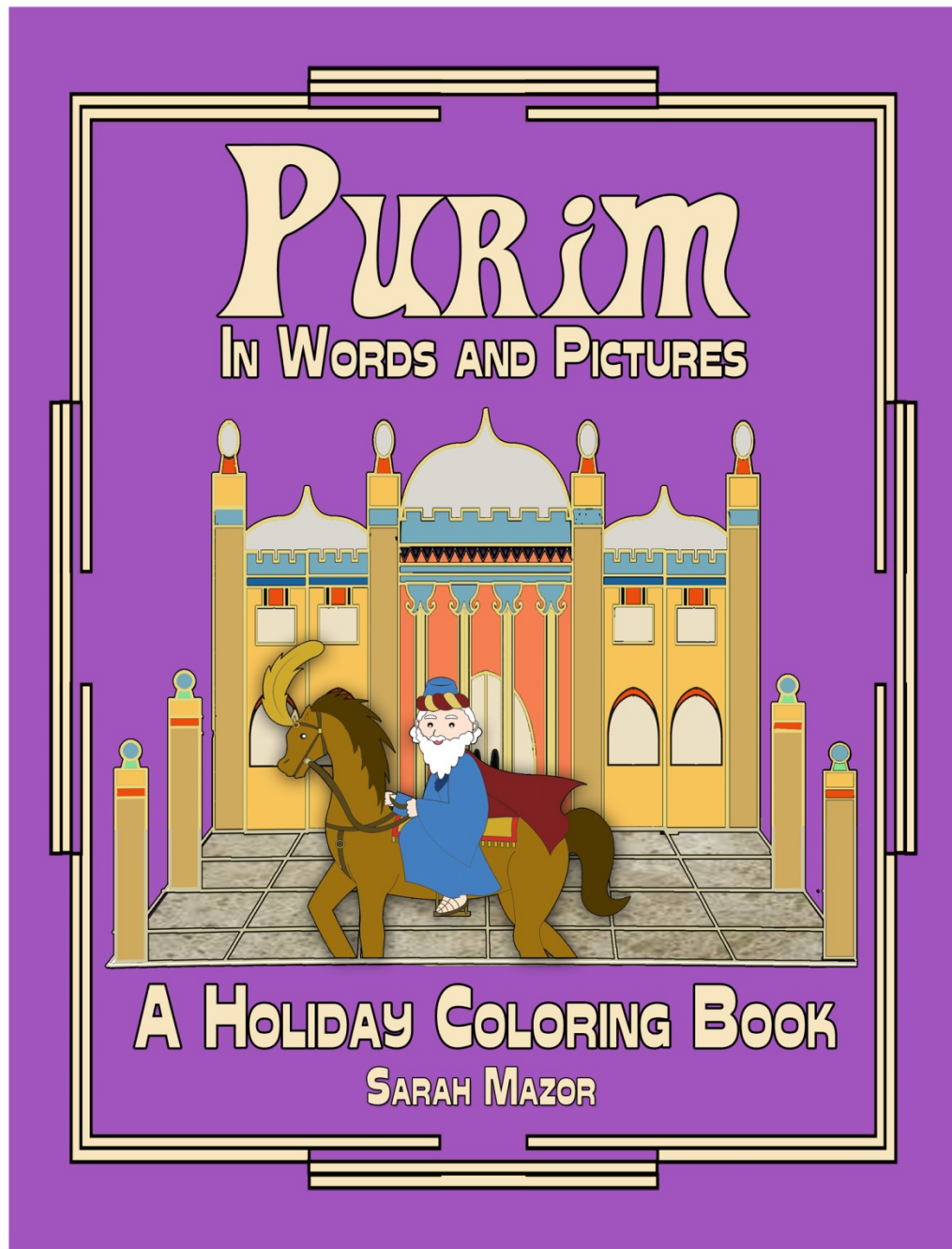
A Purim Miracle

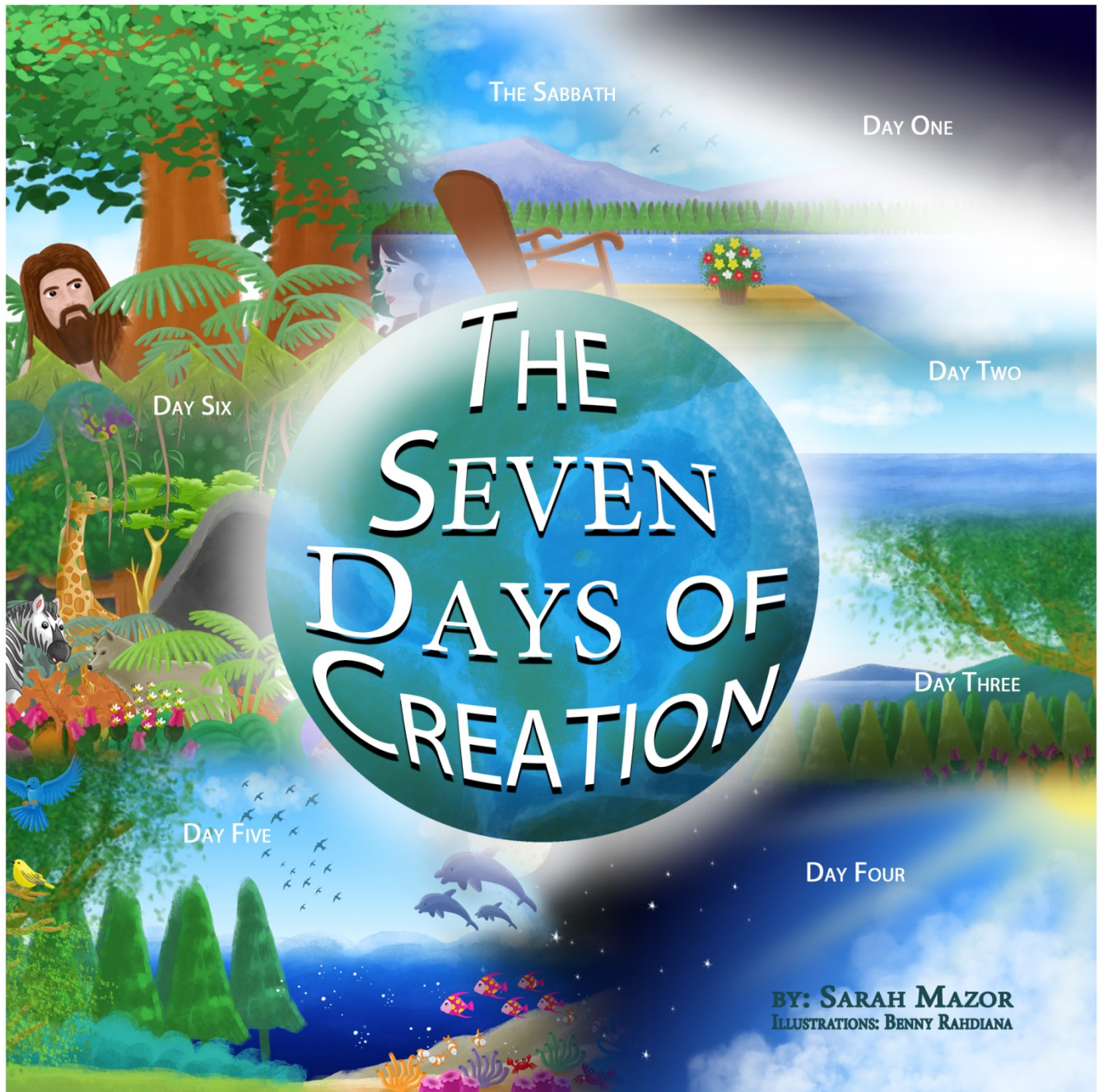

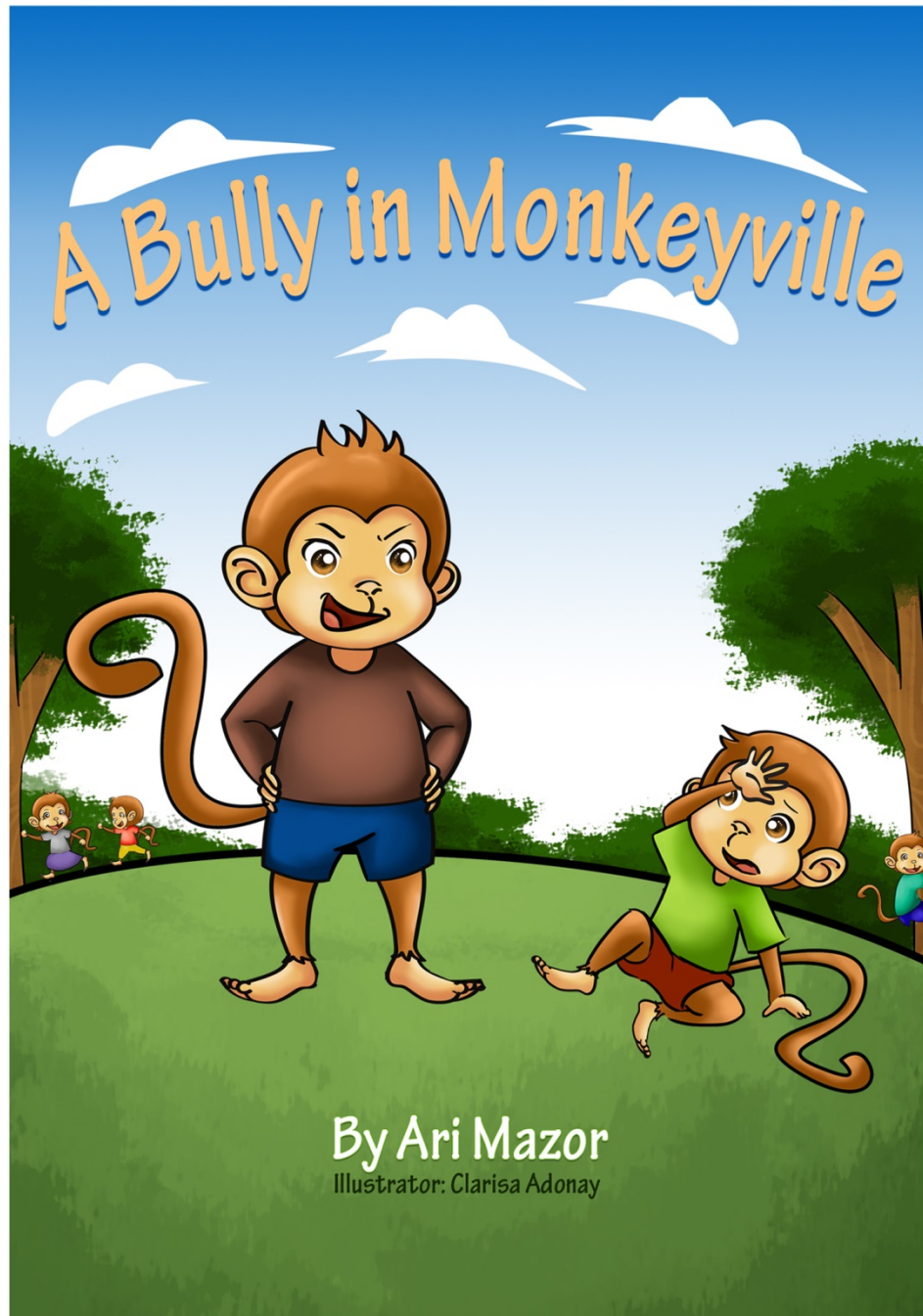

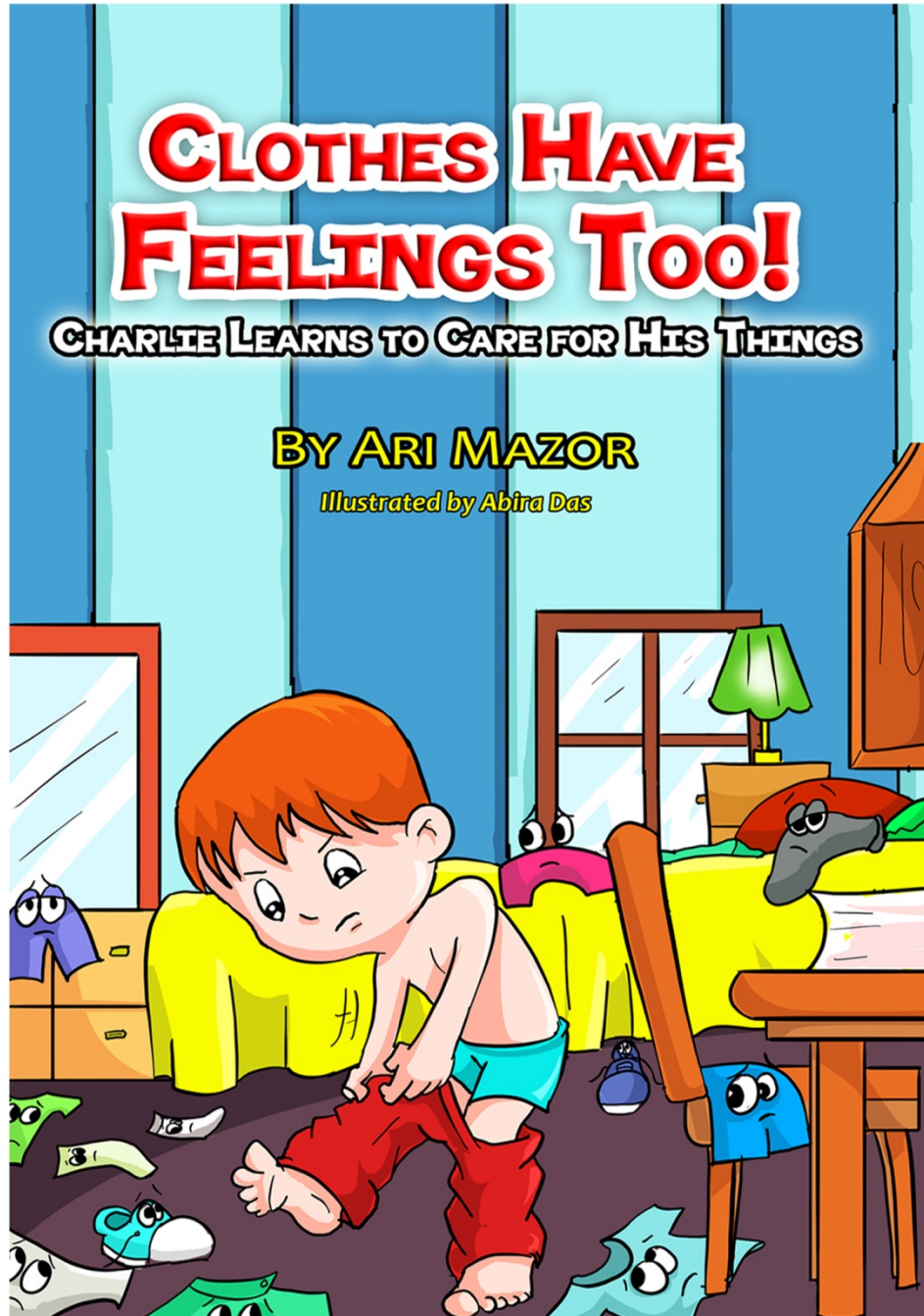
Anti-Bullying

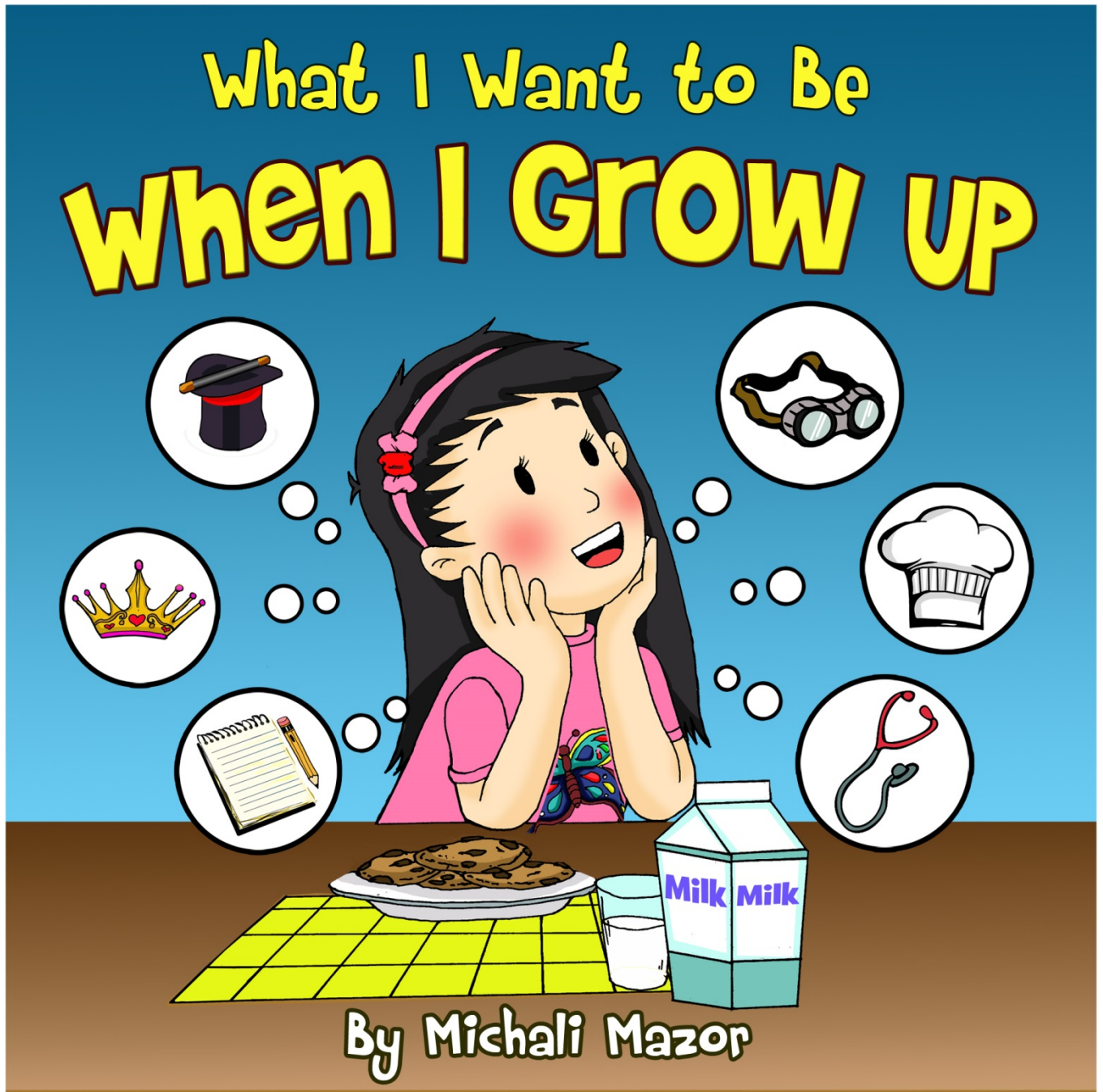

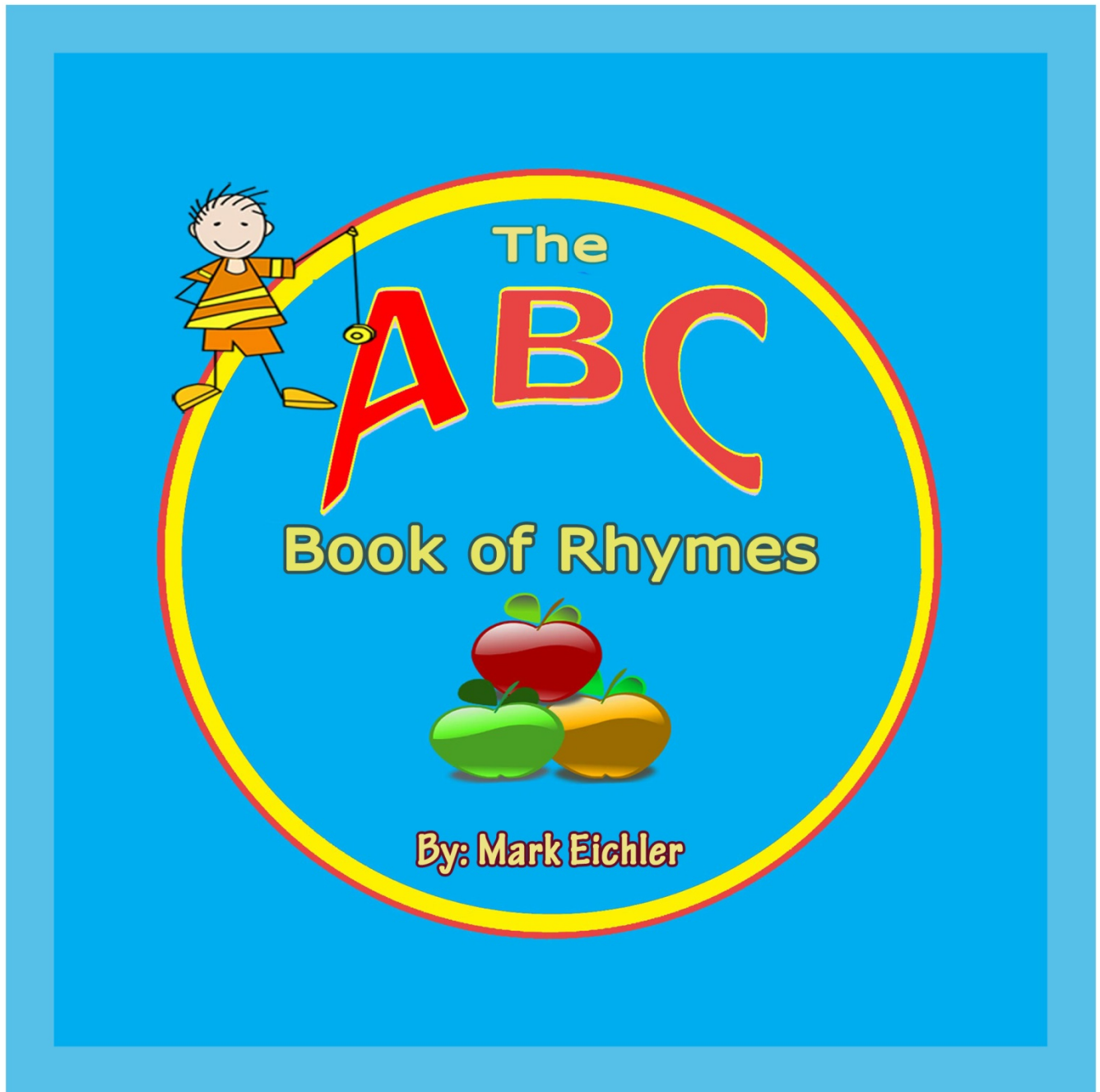

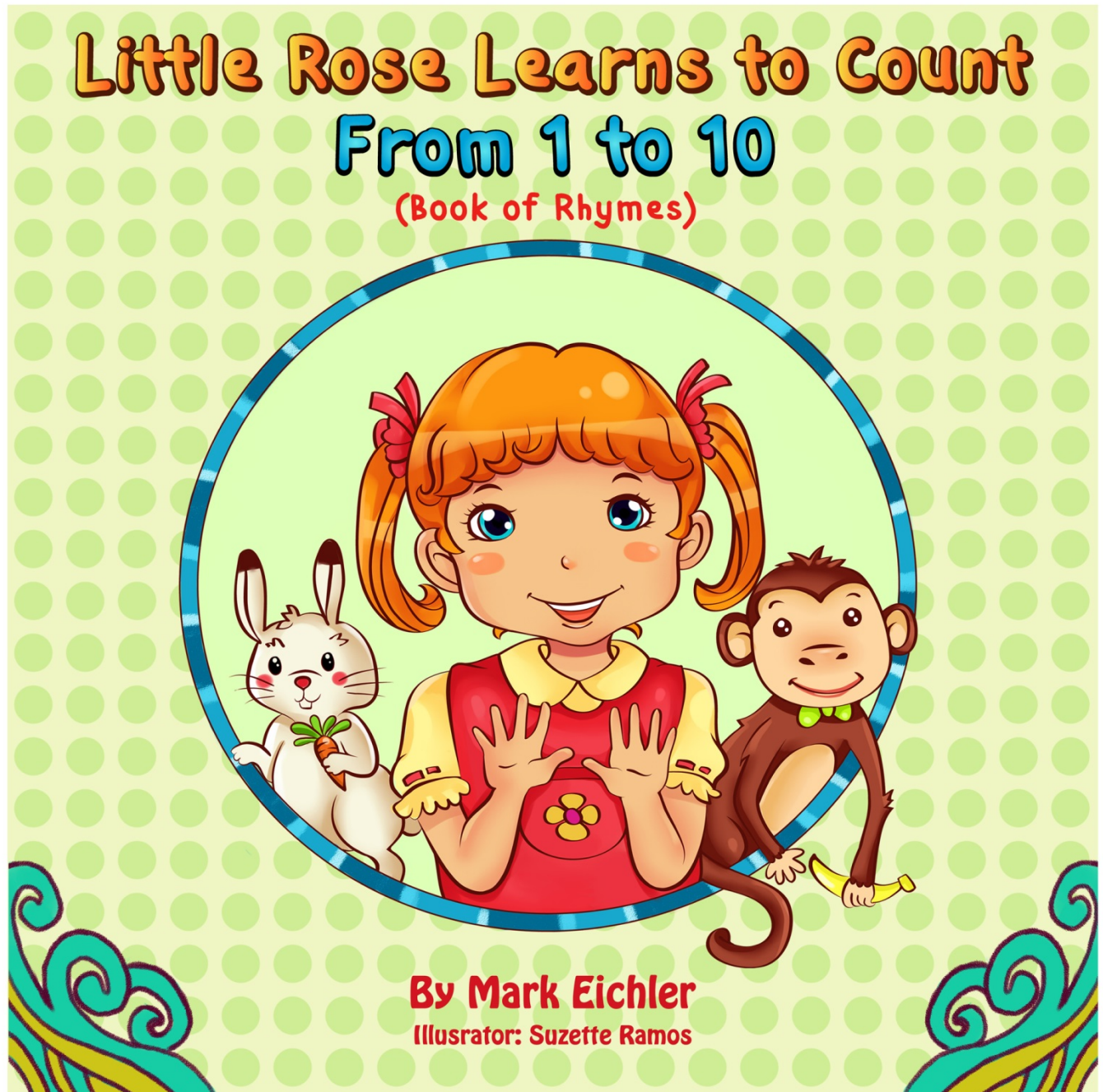
Learning the ABCs

Goodbye Monsters!

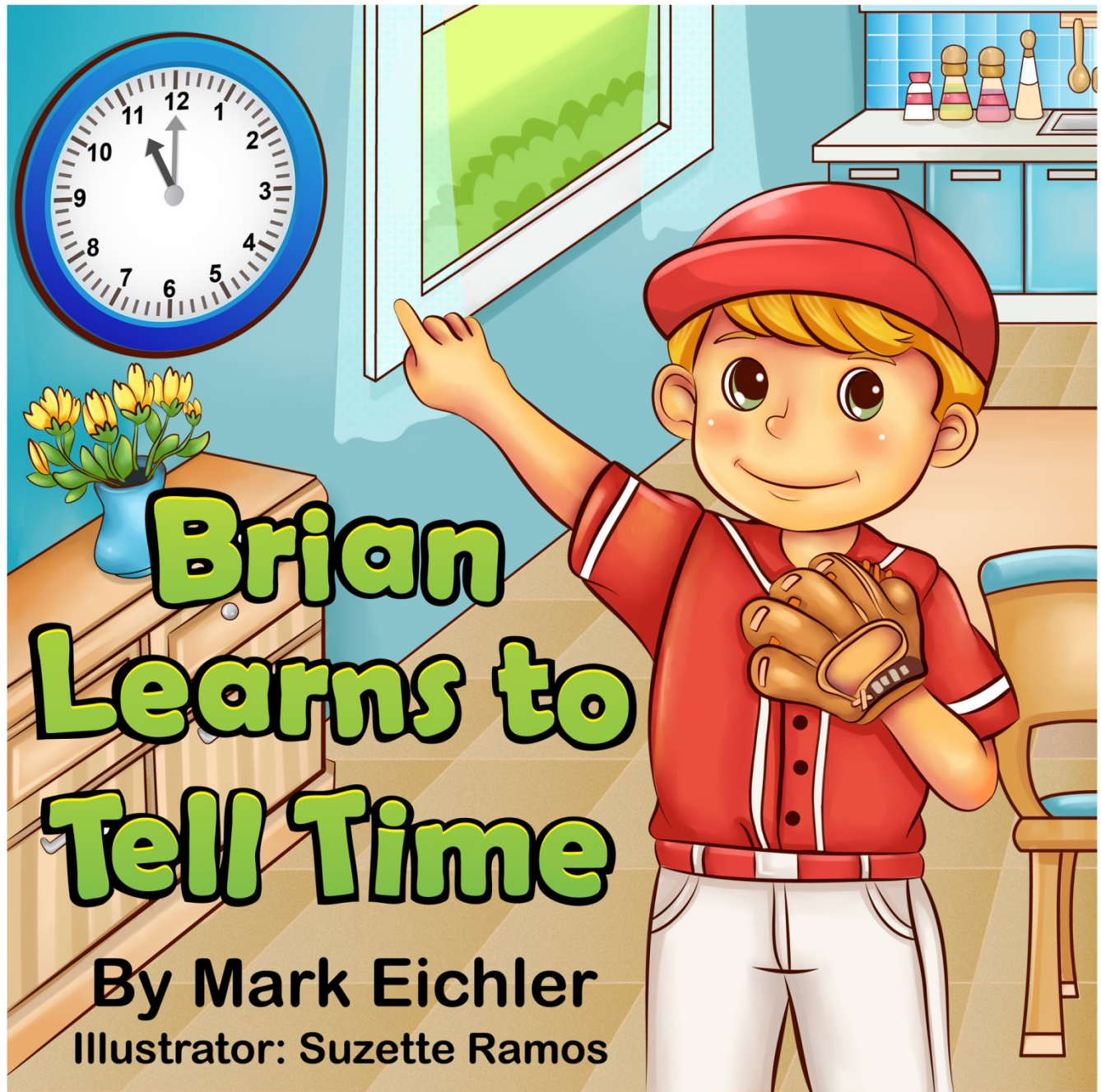

This lovely book will help your kids chase away those pesky monsters and afford all of you a good night's sleep!

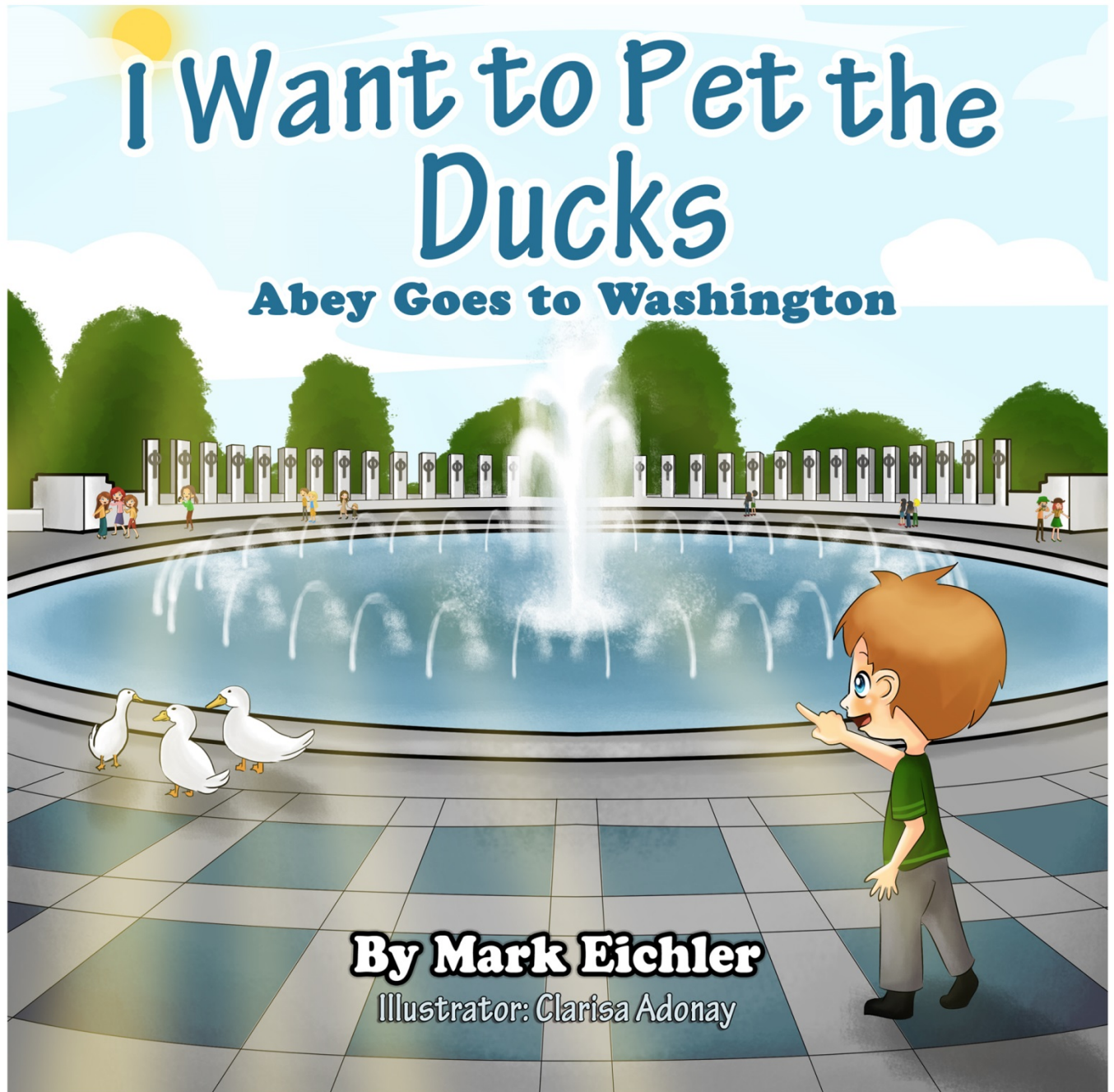
Telling Time

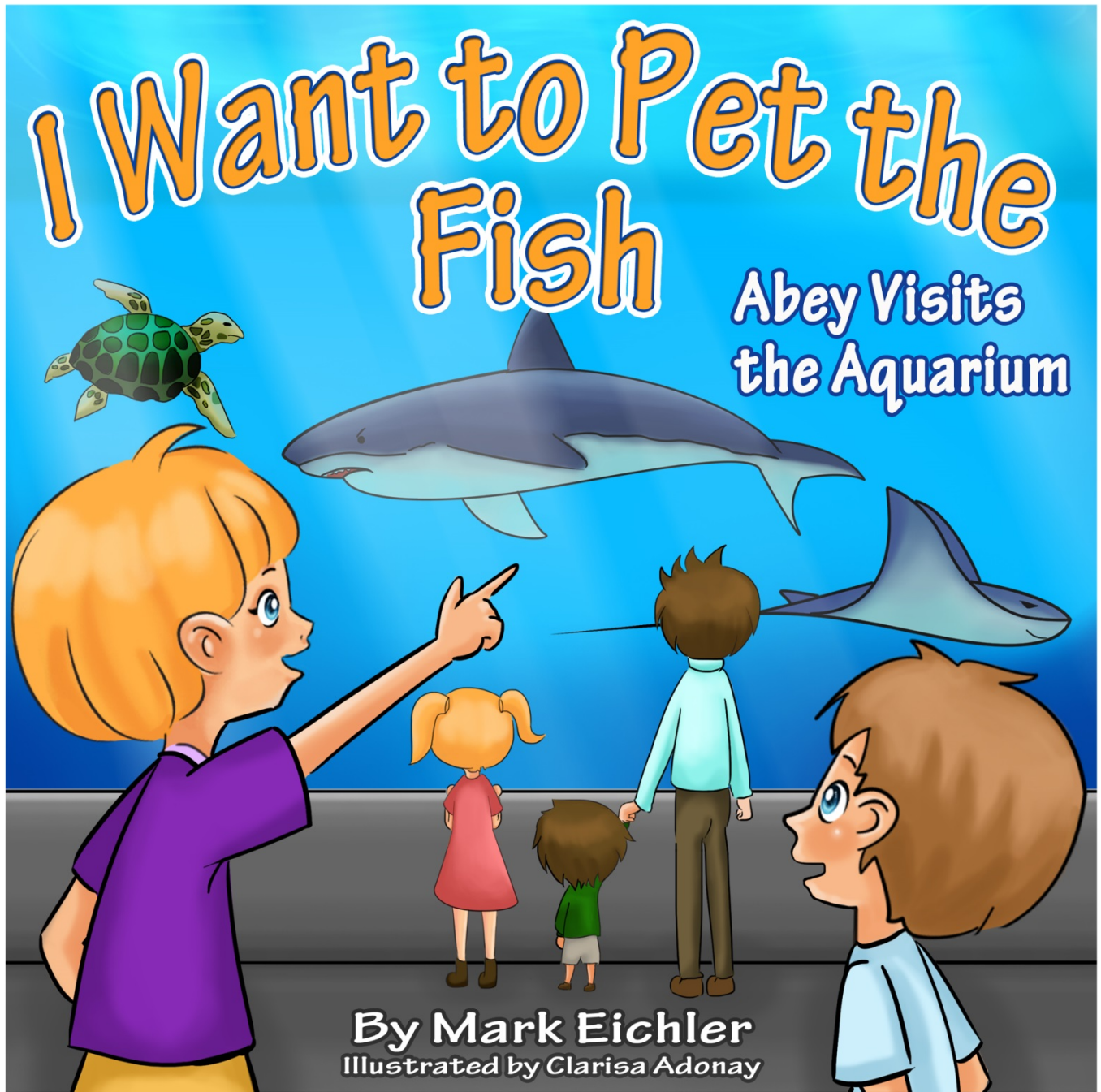
National Monuments in D.C.

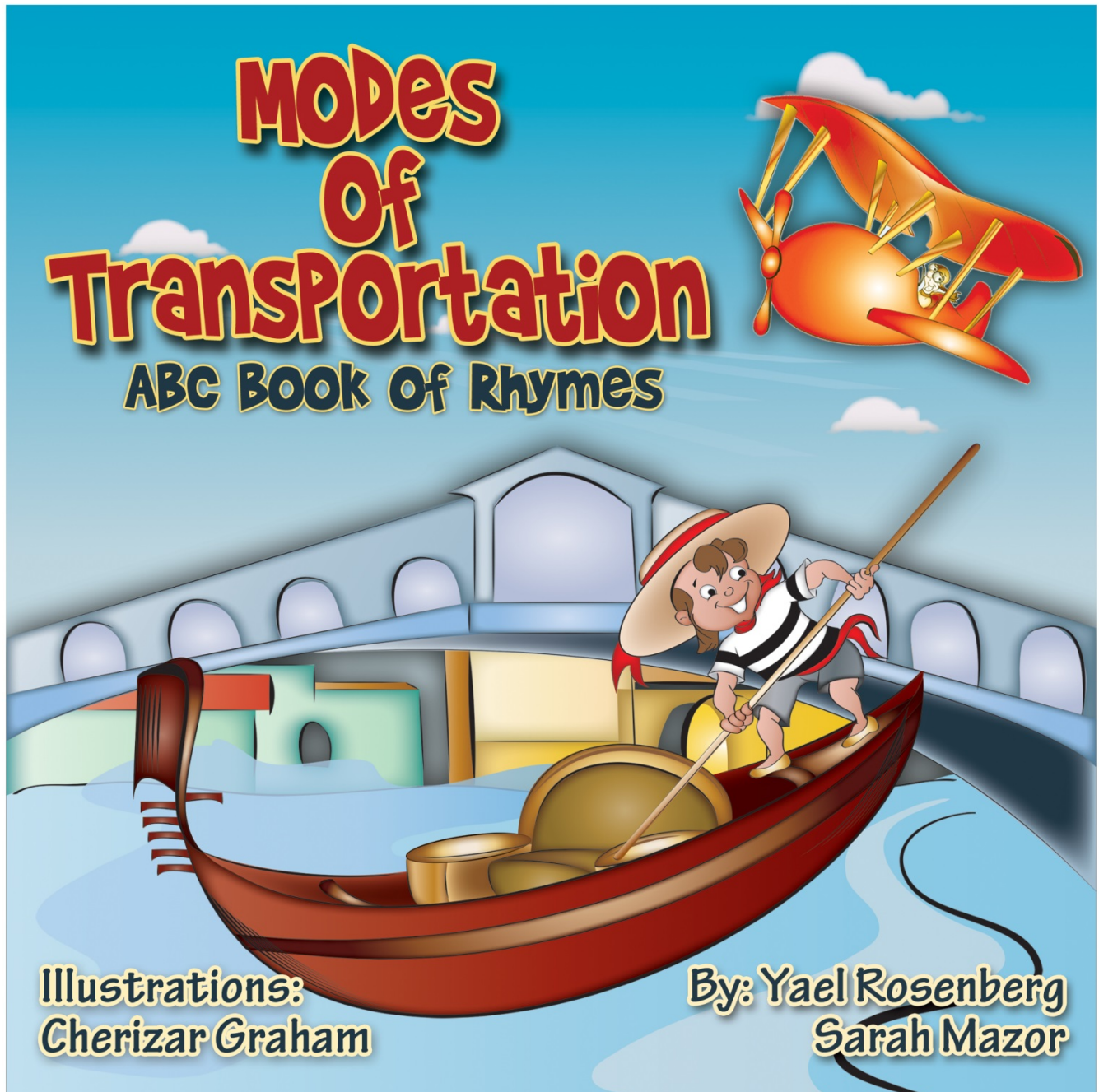
Learning About Marine Life

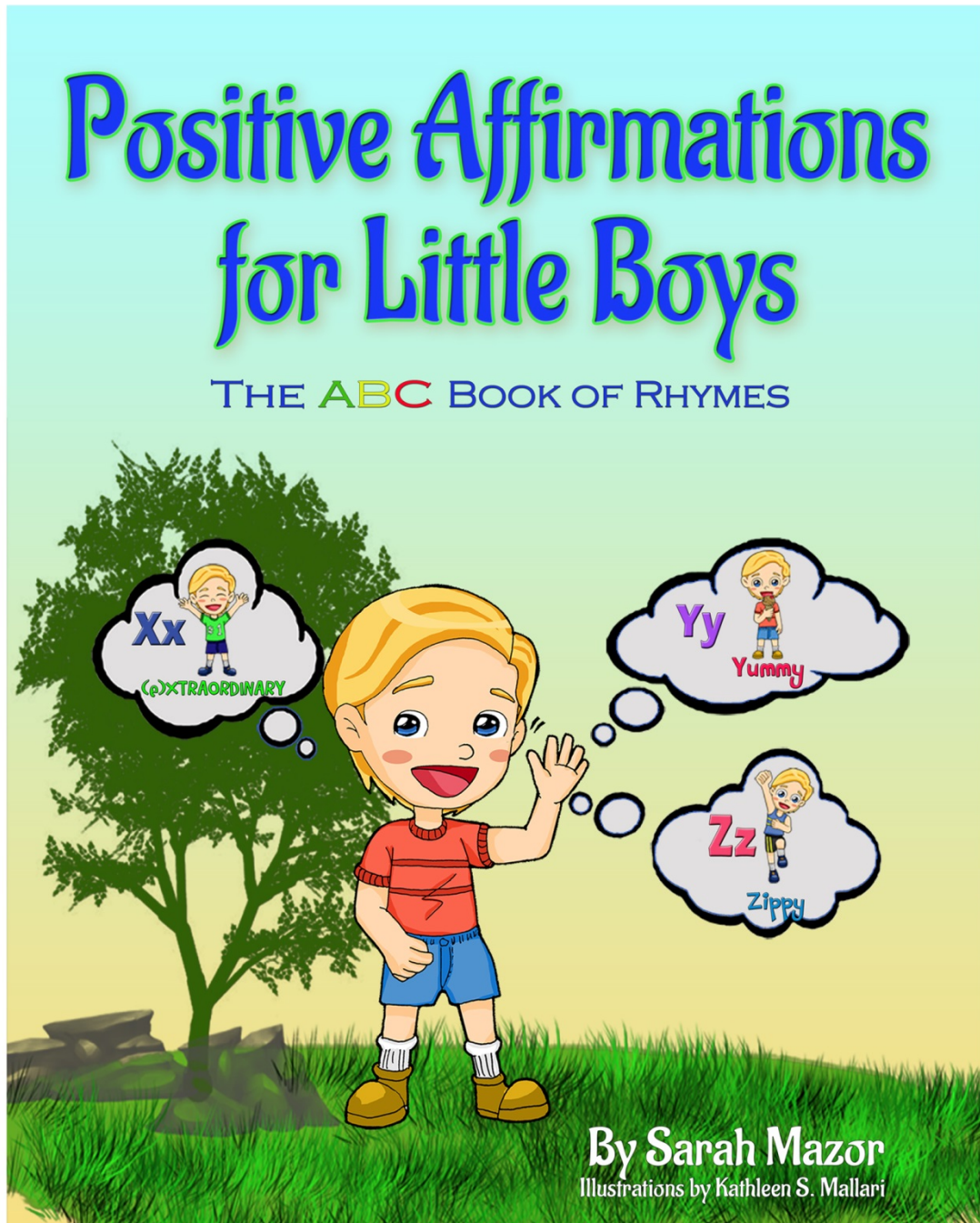
Happiness is a Mind Thing

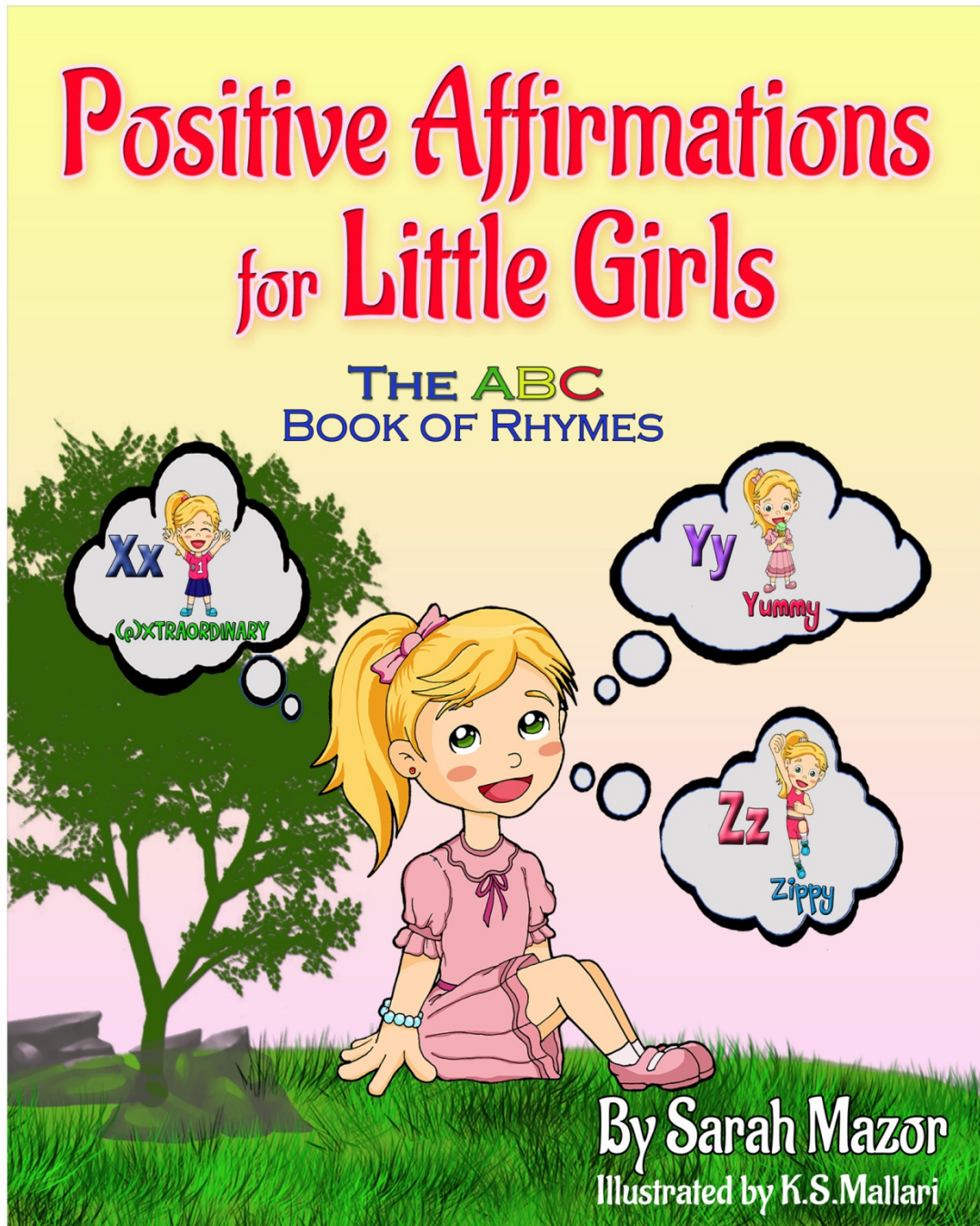

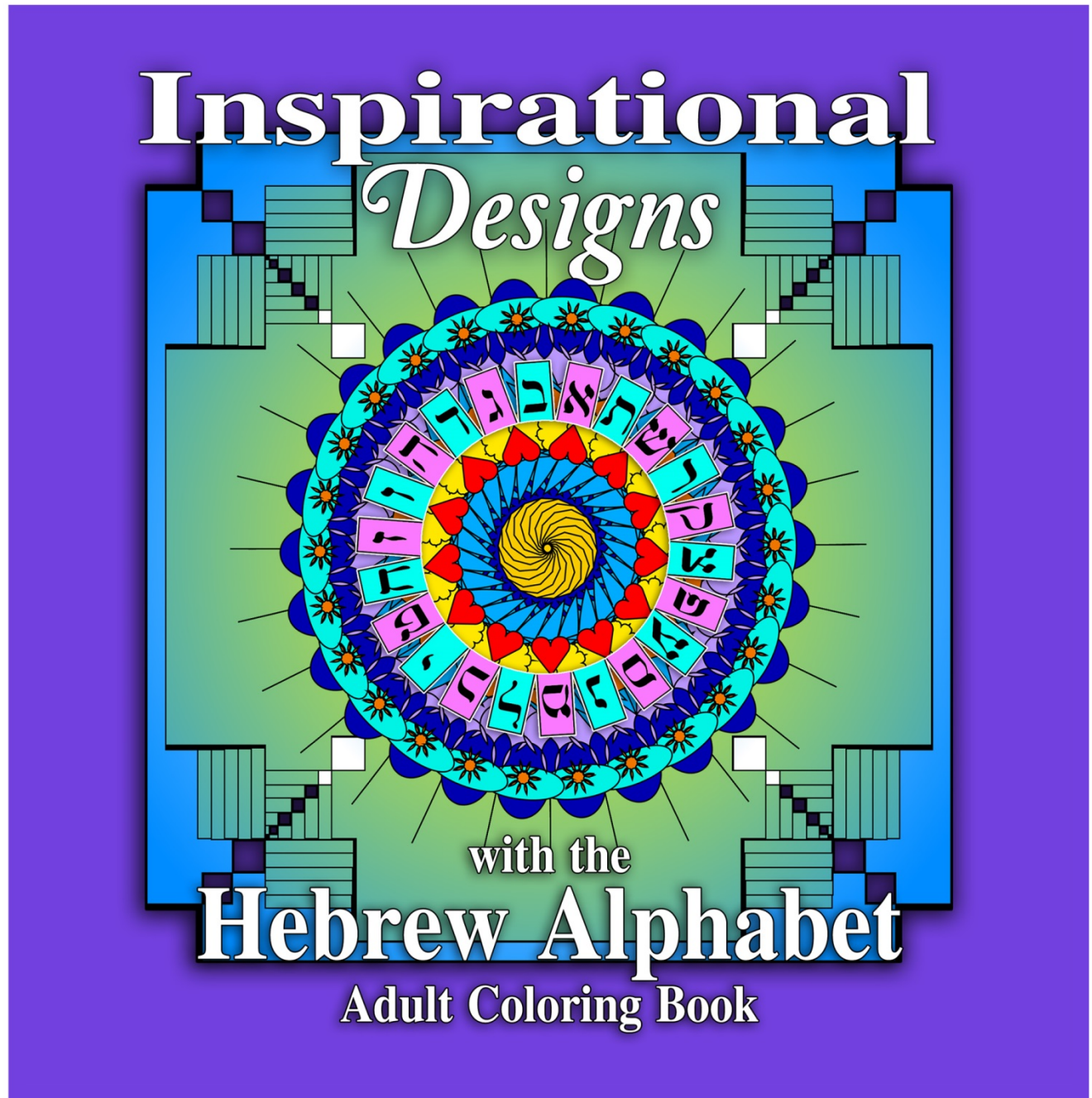
