NOTE: Vendors provide their own tables & displays. Setup is from 7:00am-9:00am, event is 9:00am-5:00pm. Vendors check in at registration booth before setting up to receive your space assignment.

REGISTRATION:

ONE AFRICA! ONE NATION! MARKETS RESERVES THE RIGHT TO EXCLUDE ANY VENDOR THAT DOES NOT COMPLY WITH THE BELOW POLICIES:

- CHECK-IN is from 7:00am to 9:00 am at VENDOR REGISTRATION BOOTH.**
ALL VENDORS MUST CHECK-IN BY 9:00am at the latest. IF YOU HAVE NOT CHECKED IN OR SPOKEN TO THE FLEA COORDINATOR BY 9:00am, AND UNLOADED INTO YOUR SPACE BY 9:30am YOUR SPACE CAN BE REASSIGNED AND YOU WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.
Please have helpers or a dolly to unload your vehicle quickly and move your vehicle when double-parked. Please respect the neighborhood by keeping noise levels to acceptable levels at all times. Event is open to the public 9:00am to 5:00pm. **Vendors provide their own tables and displays.**
- SPACE ASSIGNMENTS:** Space assignment numbers will be given at the registration check-in booth after 7:00am and volunteers will assist everyone in locating their space.
****Note: No generators are permitted.**
****Note:** If you bring a tent to use in a 14ft X 14ft space, it cannot be larger than 10ft. X 10ft. Your tent & all your items **MUST FIT** within your 14ft. X 14ft. space. **The 6ft. x 6ft spaces are not large enough for an 8ft. umbrella or any tent, you will be in your in neighbor's space.****
- ABSOLUTELY NO DRIVING IN THE PARK at any time, penalties are \$50.00 plus damages.** (payable to Parks and Recreation Department.)
- UNLOADING:** OAON Markets put up NO PARKING signs for vendors to use to unload on the Chester Ave and on 43rd St. between Chester & Regent. **FOOD TRUST WILL TOW IF YOU PARK ON CHESTER AVE NORTH SIDE CLOSE TO THE FARMER'S MARKET.**
Unloading is on a first-come, first-serve basis. We ask vendors to use these spaces to UNLOAD ONLY. Please **unload all your items onto the sidewalk** rapidly and then park your car, **before** setting up your space, so other vendors can unload.
There is NO double-parking on Chester Ave due to trolleys.
- CLEAN UP:** Vendors are required to leave their spaces clean. To continue vending at this market you cannot leave large amounts of trash in the park in *or near* trash cans any time of day. **YOU MUST TAKE ALL LARGE OR SMALL ITEMS THAT YOU HAVE NOT SOLD WITH YOU!!** This includes furniture, lamps, glass, clothing, toys etc. It is important that we leave the park neat and clean so we can keep using the park. At the end of the day you can leave small trash items in the trash cans.
- FEES** This marketplace is a project of Black Star Industries and co sponsored by The African Peoples Education (APEDF), a non-profit organization. All proceeds benefit APEDF programs for health, economic development & human rights for the black community. Fees: \$25 for 6'X6' space, \$45 for spaces 14'X14'. Food Vendors \$75. **Only the April Health Fest & Flea and Sept Book Fair are \$100 for all Food Vendors.**
- PAYMENTS ACCEPTED FOR SPACES: OAON Markets accepts money orders or cash only.**
 - Signed & completed registration form & fee must be received **A MINIMUM OF 1 WEEK** before the flea date to guarantee your space, and you must be accepted verbally or by email during this process.
 - Mail your payments, or drop off at Uhuru Furniture, 832 N. Broad St, (at Parrish) during store hours.
 - Money-orders are payable to "OAON Marketplace"**. Please put your name & phone # on payment.
 - Include your full name and return address on the front of the envelope.
 - We will call or email you to confirm receipt of registration if received at least 1 week before the market.
- RAIN DATES** are Sunday, the following day. *(Please bring a tarp/plastic for possible light rain)*
Call the OAON Market voice mail at 267-875-3532 after 5:00 am on the scheduled morning of the flea market to find out if a rain date has been called. We make the decision at that time.

9. CANCELLATION POLICY: CANCELLATION DEADLINE:

YOUR CANCELLATION MUST BE RECEIVED AT LEAST 7 DAYS AHEAD OF THE MARKET

- Please call **267-875-3532** or email philly.vendors@oneafricamarket.com at least a week before the market. YOU MUST TALK TO A PERSON or get an email confirmation for your cancellation to be valid.
- Your fees will be refunded or moved to another month of your choice if we have vacancies.

We will confirm your cancellation by phone/email. **IF YOU DO NOT CANCEL A WEEK IN ADVANCE you will be marked as a NO SHOW and will not be entitled to a refund.** If this occurs, your payment will be processed as a donation. There are no exceptions.

10. LOST OR MISDIRECTED MAIL: OAON MARKET is not responsible for lost or misdirected mail.

Please inform us of any changes of address, duplicate mailing, name change, new email/phone number.

11. PRIVACY POLICY: OAON MARKETS will not rent, sell or share your information with third parties.

12. DAMAGE/LOSS: OAON MARKETS is not responsible for any damage and/or loss to property. Make sure that your space is secured.

13. ADVERTISING & MARKETING: OAON MARKETS advertises the flea markets in local & online newspapers, email lists, local and regional calendar announcements and Facebook, as well as flyer distribution.

14. VENDOR SALES: Vendors keep their individual sales. OAON does not guarantee vendor sales.

15. ITEMS THAT CANNOT BE SOLD: We limit **new items** to a certain category & will discuss that individually with vendors prior to the flea market.

16. NO SALES OF WEAPONS INCLUDING COLLECTIBLE WEAPONS: Includes, but not limited to guns, bullets, knives, slingshots, swords, pepper-spray, fireworks, flammable liquids etc.

17. NO DRUGS OR DRUG PARAPHERNALIA: Including, but not limited to, drugs, head shop items, pipes, bongs etc.

18. OTHER RESTRICTED ITEMS: Including, but not limited to, stolen merchandise, bootleg DVDs or CDs and similar items.

19. NO PORNOGRAPHIC MATERIALS: Including, but not limited to, literature, magazines, video, DVDs, adult toys or similar items.

20. NO SOCIALLY OFFENSIVE ITEMS: Including Nazi or other white supremacist items or other items deemed offensive by coordinators or shoppers.
