Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

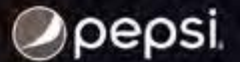

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#9 PIXIES LADY was one we were fond of last week and she was used hard early from the ten-hole to make the lead in 28.1. She ended up releasing The Prince to the lead to sit a perfect two-hole trip but was no match for that rival in the stretch when he went on to victory and she faded to be seventh. This filly went winless in seven last season but banked more than \$36,000 picking up small prizes at the OSS Gold level. With that start now under her belt, we will give her a whirl again and hope her journey from this outside draw is not as taxing.

#6 STORMONT BARBEQUE got away well from the nine-hole last week and travelled an inside trip through most of the mile to finish fifth to an impressive winner in The Prince. He seemed to be trotting well in the stretch and took strong support to the tune of 5-1. His connections thought enough of him last season to enter him in an OSS Gold event and he might produce a better result this time around from the center of the gate.

#5 ALL R WISHES sat the two-hole to a pumped-up winner last time in Tanzanite Trixx but was unable to hold the place spot over Wee Jill under the wire. She was still clearly the best of the rest in third though, as it was almost three lengths back to our fourth choice in fourth. This filly should be able to build off that effort and landing somewhere on the ticket again is a possibility.

#2 ANNA BOLENA finished fourth last week at this level in her first start out of the barn of Richard Moreau. She moved up to third on the final turn but then tired in the stretch and was well beaten by the one above under the wire. This filly might be able to take a step forward in this follow-up effort but we prefer the ones above.

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#5 NICOLE AND DIME was a \$92,000 yearling purchase at Harrisburg and will be sent out of for her lifetime debut by Aaron Bryon. She closed well to be victorious in her only qualifier on June 18th when she came her back-half in 57.1 and paced her final panel in 28.3. She is a half-sister to Century Farroh and her seven siblings have combined for 119 wins lifetime. This daughter of Fear The Dragon might be ready to win at first asking.

#3 WATCH HER DANCE is a homebred that will be making her first lifetime start for trainer Dave Menary. She comes into this off a solid looking qualifier in New Jersey where she paced her back-half in 56.3 and a final quarter in 28.3. Jody Jamieson gives this one his vote of confidence and this daughter of Hes Watching appears to be one of the main players in the first parimutuel baby race of the season at Mohawk Park.

#4 AMERICAN TICKET was a \$37,000 yearling purchase at the Lexington Select sale and will be sent out for the first start of her career by conditioner Black MacIntosh. She made a miscue in her first qualifier on June 12th but then followed it up with a front-end score on June 18th in 1:58.1 over a track that was two seconds off. This filly looks poised to make a good account of herself at first asking and merits consideration.

#2 BETTER DOUBLE FLIP was just an \$8,000 yearling purchase at the Lexington Select sale and is the stablemate of the one above. She turned in a pair of decent qualifying efforts and will have the hot hands of James MacDonald in her corner for the first start of her career. This filly is worth a look.

Hambletonian Winner, *TRIXTON*

Standing 11 Top Stallions at Winbak Farm of Ontario

This son of Chapter Seven will have to overcome the outside draw but showed enough early foot in that prep that he will likely be able to overcome it off the gate. He appears to be the one to beat and gets our vote of confidence.

#1 ROSE RUN XCENTRIC was a \$17,000 yearling purchase at Harrisburg and will be sent out for her first lifetime start by Clark Beelby. She was a front-end winner in her lone qualifying effort on June 11th and trotted her final quarter in 27.4. The inside post is not ideal for a young filly making her lifetime debut, but she has a chance at overcoming that with Bob McClure at the controls.

#8 GRACE will be sent out for her lifetime debut by Amy MacDonald and will do so off a solid win on the morning of June 18th when she trotted her mile in 2:02.1 over a track that was two seconds off. It was a front-end score on that occasion, and she trotted home well in 27.4 chasing rivals in the prep before that. She will have to leave from the outside draw but will have J-Mac at the controls.

#7 ESPLOSIONE was a \$20,000 yearling that will make her lifetime debut for conditioner Meg Crone. He turned in a decent qualifier over a five-eighths oval in New Jersey and might be ready to roll at first asking. We will opt to utilize this one on the bottom end of exotics, but a better result is possible.

#4 VICTORY MOVE raced better than his line indicates in his latest at Georgian Downs when he got away fifth but was then shuffled well back in the field before shaking loose in the later stages of the mile. She came her back-half in 57.1 with a final panel of 27.4 and was not asked for her best until deep in the stretch drive. This filly won three of six as a rookie and was the third-place finisher in the OSS Grassroots Final here last fall. She should take a big step forward in this follow-up effort off the bench but might have a hard time besting the one above.

#9 HP RUNNING MASS produced an eye-catching late stretch brush for the victory in NW1 last week but now must make the difficult transition to NW2. He blasted his final quarter in 27.3 and was a going away winner under the wire. This gelding will also have to overcome the outermost post but might be up to the challenge.

#10 LIFEINTHESLAMMER will be making his second start off the bench for conditioner John Bax and might offer some value to the bottom end of the exotics at a big price. She made steady gains last time to finish fourth at 71-1 in this class and a similar result is a possibility tonight.

This gelding followed that rival for most of the mile but was unable to stick with him in the early part of the stretch drive when he accelerated towards the leaders. He will leave from the pole position tonight and will hopefully bring forth his best in his second start off the bench.

#2 CHIEFS BEACH closed gamely in the stretch last week to win by a neck over Maintenance Man. He did not get the easiest journey either, as a rival abruptly came underneath him on the final turn and then stalled in front of him to impede this one's progress. This gelding was dead game to get the job done and might be hard to hold off again tonight. Hoping the one above can turn the tables on him, but he still merits big time respect coming off that victory.

#8 MAINTENANCE MAN went a big effort last week to claim the runner-up spot and only missed holding on by a neck under the wire. He made multiple moves and was right in the thick of those hot early fractions of 26.4 and 55.1. This gelding draws the outside post tonight but should be rolling early for Jamieson off the slanted starting gate. He is certainly among the chances in here.

#3 SAM MCKEE HANOVER comes into this off a big win at Georgian Downs but in a much easier spot where the lifetime earnings cap was only \$32,000. This gelding has picked up prizes in similar classes here at Mohawk Park in the past and might be able to get a piece of it.

#3 DEWY DEO had no chance last week when he got away ninth off the gate from this same position and was still more than 11 lengths out of it at the halfway point. He came his back-half in 59 seconds and with a final split in 28.1, which allowed him to close multiple positions to be fourth under the line. This colt had the best legs late in the mile and could not have achieved a better finishing position than he did after the leader stole a middle-half in 1:01.2. He was a \$75,000 yearling purchase at the Lexington Select sale and might give this group all they can handle if he is put into play by McClure in the second start of his sophomore season.

#9 EMERALD WINGS is a homebred for Doug Millard that will be sent out for his lifetime debut by Chantal Mitchell. He was an impressive winner in his qualifier on June 10th when he trotted his final quarter in 28.4 and then followed it up with a good looking third-place finish in another prep on June 17th where he finished with tight lines to MacDonald under the wire. The outside starting spot is not ideal for one that is making his first start, but he has flashed enough early foot in his qualifiers that he might be able to overcome it early.

#6 WARRAWEE WINDSOR finished ahead of the one above in his most recent morning prep and went up against a tough group in his previous qualifier on June 10th where he finished third. This gelding went winless as a rookie but managed to earn over \$33,000 with the bulk of that coming from a runner-up finish in the OSS Grassroots Final here in October of last year. He is one of the main chances in the race.

#8 ARLANDA made a break in stride behind the gate last time to squander any chance but did make a decent recovery to finish sixth on the end of it. He was sent wide around the final turn but had no chance of making a threatening move forward because of the pedestrian fractions that were set on the front-end. This gelding's first objective will likely be a flat line, but he showed enough last time to possibly land on the bottom end of the exotics.

He will also now get back into a regular rotation tonight and make his second start back at Mohawk Park, where he enjoyed what is still the lone victory of his career last season. He picks up James MacDonald for tonight's tilt and is our choice to take down the finale.

#1 CENTURY HANNIBAL closed well on the end of his mile last time to only miss by three quarters of a length in this class. He came his back-half in 55.1 with final quarter speed of 27 seconds flat. He was off for three weeks prior to that effort and now gets back into a regular rotation tonight from the pole position. This son of Control The Moment has only missed the board once in five lifetime starts and McNair gave him the vote of confidence going into this. He is one of the main contenders in the nightcap.

#2 UNCONTROLLABLE moves back north of the border after hitting the board in all three of his sophomore tries at Pocono Downs. He was an ultra-impressive winner in his lifetime debut last season when he crushed his competition to score by more than six lengths in 1:53 flat in an OSS Grassroots event. However, he made breaks in all three of his subsequent efforts including an attempt in an OSS Gold tilt last July. This gelding has been producing big speed south of the border and has been on his best behavior. He picks up Bob McClure and might be a force to be reckoned with.

#3 ISLAND BEACH BOY produced a moderate effort last time after going first-over in this class. He was picked up by our second choice in the stretch but went the more difficult journey of the two. This colt hit the board in four of six at two and just missed in the final of Dream Maker. He merits respect underneath.

#7 PLAY ROCK won back-to-back contests at Northfield Park and then was sixth here in this class last week. He might be hard pressed to go with the ones above but can get a smaller share.

- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials. All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race which the pool is operated. The above stated pools on races that have an entry (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in an Exacta wager, the Exacta payout will be on first and third.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
