### Liturgy of the Word

#### FIRST READING

1 Corinthians 13: 4 - 13

A reading from the first letter of Saint Paul to the Corinthians.

Love is always patient and kind; it is never jealous; love is never boastful or conceited; it is never rude or selfish; it does not take offence, and is not resentful.

Love takes no pleasure in other people's sins, but delights in the truth; it is always ready to excuse, to trust, to hope, and to endure whatever comes. Love does not come to an end.
