NARRATIVE:  
ON 06-25-97 AT 10:15 P.M. I WAS ASSIGNED TO WORK  
AT CAMP RANDALL STADIUM. THE ROCK BAND U2 WAS  
PERFORMING. THE LIGHTS IN THE STADIUM WERE TURNED  
OFF FOR THE STAGE SHOW. THE MUSIC WAS VERY LOUD  
AND I WAS WEARING AN EARPLUG IN ONE EAR AND A  
RADIO HEADSET ON THE OTHER. I WAS WEARING A FULL

POLICE UNIFORM AS WAS MY PARTNER SGT. DAVE KROMM. SGT. KROMM AND I WERE ASSIGNED TO THE NORTH WEST SECTION OF THE STADIUM. WE WERE STANDING ON THE FIELD NEAR THE NORTH END ZONE.

I OBSERVED TWO PERMAR SECURITY OFFICERS, ONE OF WHOM WAS LATER IDENTIFIED AS CHRISTENSEN, TRYING TO MOVE A WOMAN AWAY FROM THE CROWD AND TOWARD THE NORTH END ZONE. THE WOMAN WAS LATER IDENTIFIED AS PYZYNSKI. PYZYNSKI WAS THRASHING AND TRYING TO PULL HER ARMS AWAY FROM THE GRASP OF THE PERMAR GUARDS. SHE WAS BRACING HER FEET IN FRONT OF HER TO PREVENT HER FORWARD MOVEMENT. SGT. KROMM AND I MOVED TO ASSIST THE PERMAR OFFICERS. CHRISTENSEN ATTEMPTED TO EXPLAIN THE CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING THE EJECTION OF PYZYNSKI BUT THE MUSIC WAS TOO LOUD. WHEN SGT. KROMM AND I GRABBED PYZYNSKI'S ARMS TO ESCORT HER FROM THE FIELD AREA TO AN AREA WHERE AN INTERVIEW COULD BE CONDUCTED SHE CONTINUED TO STRUGGLE WITH US AS SHE HAD WITH PERMAR.

TO GAIN PYZYNSKI'S COOPERATION AND CREATE FORWARD MOVEMENT SGT. KROMM PLACED PYZYNSKI IN A WRIST COMPLIANCE HOLD. I HELD HER RIGHT ARM IN AN ESCORT HOLD. WE WERE ABLE TO MOVE PYZYNSKI OFF THE FIELD AND INTO THE NORTH END OF THE STADIUM. WHILE LEAVING THE FIELD PYZYNSKI COMPLAINED ABOUT THE COMPLIANCE HOLD. I HEARD SGT. KROMM TELL PYZYNSKI THAT HE WAS NOT PUTTING PRESSURE ON HER WRIST. I SAW KROMM STRAIGHTEN HER WRIST. ONCE INSIDE THE STADIUM AND AWAY FROM MOST OF THE NOISE WE ATTEMPTED TO IDENTIFY PYZYNSKI AND INTERVIEW PERMAR.

CHRISTENSEN STATED THAT PEOPLE IN THE SEATS NEAR PYZYNSKI WERE COMPLAINING ABOUT HER CONDUCT. PERMAR REPORTED THAT SHE BACKHANDED A WOMAN AND CHRISTENSEN SAW HER, "ON TOP OF A GUY SCRATCHING HIM." CHRISTENSEN STATED THAT WHEN THEY ATTEMPTED TO BRING HER OUT OF THE CROWD SHE SCRATCHED HIS ARMS AND FOUGHT WITH THEM. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT CHRISTENSEN AND OTHER PERMAR SECURITY PERSONNEL WERE WEARING RED T-SHIRTS WHICH IDENTIFIED THEM AS, "PERMAR SECURITY," AND, "EVENT STAFF.", AND WERE INDIVIDUALLY NUMBERED. PERMAR FIELD PERSONNEL ALSO CARRIED FLASHLIGHTS WITH ORANGE CONE TIPS.

PYZYNSKI SMELLED OF INTOXICANTS. SHE YELLED AND COMPLAINED ABOUT VARIOUS THINGS TO INCLUDE THAT SHE HAD BEEN ASSAULTED IN THE CROWD BY, "A 6 FOOT GUY." SHE WAS DEFENDING HERSELF WHEN PERMAR ATTEMPTED TO REMOVE HER. PYZYNSKI SAID THAT, "SOME GUY HIT ME BECAUSE HE THOUGHT I HIT HIS WIFE." SHE YELLED AT US FOR NOT ARRESTING THE GUY THAT HIT HER. SHE DID NOT APPEAR INJURED. DURING

THIS PROCESS I WAS ATTEMPTING TO GET PYZYNSKI TO PROVIDE IDENTIFICATION. SHE HAD WITH HER A LIGHT ZIPPERED JACKET WITH POCKETS. I HAD ASKED HER IF SHE HAD AN ID WITH HER AND SHE SAID YES IN HER JACKET. I MADE SEVERAL REQUESTS FOR HER ID. PYZYNSKI CONTINUED TO YELL AT US AND DID NOT ATTEMPT TO GIVE ME THE ID. I ATTEMPTED TO PICK UP THE JACKET TO CHECK FOR ID WHEN PYZYNSKI GRABBED THE JACKET AND WOULD NOT LET GO. I TOLD HER THAT SHE WAS UNDER ARREST AND TO LET GO OF THE JACKET. SHE REFUSED TO LET GO AND CONTINUED TO YELL THAT SHE WAS BEING ARRESTED FOR DEFENDING HERSELF. SHE BECAME VERY RIGID AND WOULD NOT RELEASE THE JACKET. SGT. KROMM REAPPLIED THE COMPLIANCE HOLD TO HER RIGHT WRIST AND SHE EVENTUALLY LET GO OF THE JACKET. SHE WAS THEN PLACED IN HANDCUFFS. PERMAR RETURNED TO THEIR POSTS ON THE FIELD AND WE ESCORTED PYZYNSKI TO THE POLICE CENTER NEAR GATE 15 WHICH IS THE PROCESSING AREA FOR ARRESTED PERSONS. BY POLICY ALL SUSPECTS ARE HANDCUFFED WHILE IN THE CENTER. THE CENTER IS STAFFED BY POLICE OFFICERS AND CIVILIAN STAFF OF THE UNIVERSITY POLICE DEPT. ONCE INSIDE THE CENTER I ATTEMPTED TO ID PYZYNSKI. I EXPLAINED THAT HER ID WAS NOT IN HER JACKET. SHE SAID THAT IT MUST BE IN HER CAR. SHE PROVIDED THE VERBAL ID OF VICKI MCKENNA. A DOT INQUIRY FOUND NO LISTING FOR MCKENNA. I ASKED HER FOR THE STATE IN WHICH SHE HAD A DRIVER'S LICENSE. SHE STATED ILLINOIS. USING MCKENNA FOR THE INQUIRY TO ILLINOIS WE COULD NOT FIND HER DRIVER'S RECORD. I AGAIN APPROACHED MCKENNA ABOUT HER IDENTITY. SHE THEN STATED THAT HER LICENSE WAS UNDER HER MARRIED NAME OF PYZYNSKI. USING THIS NAME FOR THE INQUIRY WE FOUND A DRIVER'S RECORD FILE FOR HER. PYZYNSKI STATED THAT SHE WAS NOT DRUNK AND ASKED FOR A BREATH TEST. I ADMINISTERED A PRELIMINARY BREATH TEST TO HER WITH A FINAL REPORTED VALUE OF .15 BAC. WHILE I COMPLETED PAPERWORK PYZYNSKI WAS ESCORTED TO A HOLDING CELL WHERE HER YELLING AND BEHAVIOR WOULD CAUSE LESS OF A DISTURBANCE. SGT. KROMM AND MYSELF CONTACTED PYZYNSKI IN THE HOLDING CELL TO ISSUE HER THE CITATION FOR DISORDERLY CONDUCT. I NOTED THAT SHE HAD SLIPPED ONE HANDCUFF OFF HER WRIST AND WAS SEATED IN THE HOLDING CELL WITH HER HANDS ON HER LAP. WHEN I ATTEMPTED TO EXPLAIN THE CITATION SHE BECAME AGITATED AND PULLED THE TICKET FROM MY HAND EXPLAINING THAT I DID NOT NEED TO EXPLAIN THE TICKET BECAUSE SHE KNEW HOW TO READ AND SHE HAS HAD TICKETS BEFORE. I CONTINUED WITH THE EXPLANATION OVER HER PROTESTS. PRIOR TO HER RELEASE FROM THE HOLDING CELL SGT. KROMM EXPLAINED

THAT IF SHE WERE TO CONTINUE WITH HER LOUD  
 OUTBURSTS IN THE POLICE CENTER SHE WOULD BE  
 RETURNED TO THE HOLDING CELL.  
 WE ESCORTED PYZYNSKI OUT OF THE CENTER AND  
 ATTEMPTED TO GET HER TO TURN LEFT UPON EXITING THE  
 CENTER SO THAT SHE COULD EXIT THE STADIUM BY GATE  
 15. SHE WALKED PAST THE EXIT AND IGNORED OUR  
 REQUESTS TO WALK TOWARD THE EXIT. SHE STATED THAT  
 SHE WAS LOOKING FOR HER FRIEND. SHE HAD WALKED  
 OVER TO A WALL OPPOSITE OF THE POLICE CENTER NEAR  
 A CLOSED PORTION OF GATE 15. I POINTED TO THE  
 OPEN GATE THAT SHE HAD PASSED AND TOLD HER TO WALK  
 TO IT AND LEAVE. SHE REFUSED. I PUT MY HAND ON  
 HER BACK AND AGAIN ASKED HER TO LEAVE BY THE GATE  
 I WAS POINTING TO. SHE YELLED, " TAKE YOUR HANDS  
 OFF ME, I'M LOOKING FOR MY FRIEND." POLICE CHIEF  
 DOUG CLEMENS APPROACHED TO ASSIST. HE TOLD  
 PYZYNSKI TO LEAVE AND SHE REFUSED.  
 CLEMENS GRABBED HER LEFT ELBOW WITH HIS RIGHT  
 HAND. PYZYNSKI PULLED HER ELBOW FROM HIS HAND.  
 SHE BROUGHT HER ARM UP AND STRUCK OUT WITH HER  
 HAND TOWARD CHIEF CLEMENS' HEAD. AT THE END OF  
 HER REACH SHE MADE A FORWARD SWIPE WITH HER HAND.  
 IT APPEARED THAT SHE WAS TRYING TO SCRATCH  
 CLEMENS. CLEMENS STEPPED BEHIND HER AND SECURED  
 HER ARM AND PUSHED HER TOWARD THE POLICE CENTER  
 WHICH WAS ABOUT TWELVE FEET AWAY. PYZYNSKI FOUGHT  
 AGAINST CLEMENS' EFFORTS TO MOVE HER. ONCE  
 CLEMENS AND PYZYNSKI WERE INSIDE THE DOOR OF THE  
 BOOTH SHE CONTINUED TO RESIST AND FIGHT.  
 LIEUTENANT GLEN MILLER ASSISTED CLEMENS IN TAKING  
 PYZYNSKI TO THE FLOOR WHERE SHE WAS RE-HANDCUFFED.  
 SHE WAS BRIEFLY PLACED IN A HOLDING CELL WHILE  
 JAIL BOOKING FORMS WERE COMPLETED.  
 OFFICER STEVE WEINBERGER AND I TRANSPORTED  
 PYZYNSKI TO THE DANE CO. JAIL. ONCE INSIDE THE  
 JAIL WE FOUND THAT THE MAIN STAGING ROOM WAS  
 OCCUPIED BY SEVERAL MALE PRISONERS. WE KEPT  
 PYZYNSKI ISOLATED FROM THEM BY HAVING HER SIT ON A  
 BENCH IN THE ENTRYWAY. PYZYNSKI COMPLICATED THE  
 BOOKING PROCESS BY REFUSING TO PROVIDE  
 INFORMATION, REMOVE HER JACKET, PUT ON JAIL SHOES  
 AND DEMANDING IMMEDIATE PHONE CALLS. SHE WAS  
 EVENTUALLY BOOKED INTO JAIL AND I HAD NO FURTHER  
 CONTACT WITH HER.

ON 06/25/97 AT APPROXIMATELY 10:40 P.M. WHILE WORKING CROWD CONTROL IN FULL POLICE UNIFORM AT THE U2 CONCERT IN CAMP RANDALL STADIUM, I WAS STANDING IN THE GATE #15 AREA WHEN I OBSERVED OFFICERS HORNBECK AND KROMM WITH A WHITE FEMALE WHO THEY WERE ATTEMPTING TO EVICT FROM THE STADIUM. THE FEMALE SUBJECT WAS REFUSING TO COMPLY WITH THEIR DIRECTIONS AND SHE WAS YELLING AT A LOUD AGGRAVATED VOICE AT THE OFFICERS. I OBSERVED THAT THE FEMALE WENT TO THE CLOSED PORTION OF GATE #15, I WENT TO ASSIST THE OFFICERS AND THE FEMALE BACKED HERSELF INTO A CORNER. THE FEMALE BEGAN YELLING AT THE OFFICERS TO TAKE THEIR HANDS OFF HER AND NOT TO TOUCH HER. ALL OFFICERS ATTEMPTED TO EXPLAIN THAT SHE NEEDED TO EXIT THE ADJACENT GATE. THE DEFENDANT CONTINUED TO MAINTAIN HER POSITION IN THE CORNER AND REFUSED TO MOVE TOWARDS THE EXIT. I ATTEMPTED TO GRASP HER LEFT ELBOW TO ATTEMPT TO MOVE HER TOWARDS THE EXIT AT WHICH TIME SHE TORE HER ELBOW FROM MY GRASP AND SWUNG HER ARM UP AND IN THE DIRECTION OF MY HEAD, GRAZING MY RIGHT EAR. AT THAT POINT I PLACED HER IN AN ARM BAR AND ESCORTED HER BACK INTO THE POLICE BOOTH WHERE SHE WAS CHARGED WITH DISORDERLY CONDUCT AND RESISTING ARREST. NO FURTHER ACTION TAKEN.

ON 6/25/97 I WAS ASSIGNED TO WORK THE U-2 CONCERT  
AT THE UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN CAMP RANDALL  
STADIUM. I WAS ASSIGNED TO SUPERVISE THE POLICE  
CENTER DURING THIS EVENT.

AT APPROXIMATELY 10:15 PM PO JOSEPH HORNBECK UWPD  
BROUGHT A WHITE FEMALE INTO THE POLICE CENTER. HE  
INDICATED SHE WOULD BE ISSUED A UW CODE CITATION  
FOR DISORDERLY CONDUCT. DURING THE IDENTIFICATION  
PROCESS PYZYNSKI WAS VERY LOUD, VERY VERBAL, AND  
WAS DISTURBING THE ENTIRE INTERIOR OF THE POLICE  
CENTER. LT. GLEN MILLER CONTACTED ME DURING THIS  
TIME AND ASKED IF I COULD ASSIST IN PLACING HER IN  
A SECURED HOLDING CELL. SHORTLY THEREAFTER  
CITATION #G70289 WAS ISSUED AND EXPLAINED TO HER.  
AFTER HORNBECK ISSUED THIS CITATION, HE REMOVED  
THE HANDCUFFS, WHILE STILL INSIDE THE POLICE  
CENTER, AND LEAD HER TO GATE #15. BECAUSE SHE HAD  
BEEN QUITE VERBAL AND ARGUMENTATIVE INSIDE THE  
POLICE CENTER, SEVERAL OFFICERS FOLLOWED HER AND  
HORNBECK TOWARD GATE #15. I TOO FOLLOWED,  
HOWEVER, STAYED AT THE ENTRANCE DOOR TO THE POLICE  
CENTER. PYZYNSKI WAS VERBALLY REQUESTED TO EXIT  
THROUGH THE WESTERNMOST GATE AT GATE #15, HOWEVER,  
SHE WALKED EAST, PAST THE DUMPSTERS, AND PROCEEDED  
TO THE NORTHEASTERNMOST CORNER OF GATE #15. AFTER  
SOME CONVERSATION BETWEEN PYZYNSKI, HORNBECK,  
CLEMENS, AND SEVERAL OTHER OFFICERS, CLEMENS TOOK  
HER BACK INTO CUSTODY AND LEAD HER BACK INTO THE  
POLICE CENTER. BECAUSE OF HER ACTIONS, CLEMENS  
INDICATED HE WOULD BE CHARGING HER WITH STATE DC  
AND RESISTING. THE BOOKING SHEET WAS COMPLETED,  
AFTER WHICH TIME SHE WAS TRANSPORTED TO AND  
INCARCERATED IN THE DANE COUNTY JAIL.

IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT WHILE THE BOOKING SHEET  
WAS BEING COMPLETED PYZYNSKI WAS IN THE  
WESTERNMOST HOLDING CELL. DURING THIS TIME SHE  
CAME TO THE DOOR AND EITHER KICKED OR POUNDED ON

THE DOOR TO GAIN MY ATTENTION. SHE INDICATED THAT THE HANDCUFFS WERE TOO TIGHT AND REQUESTED THAT I LOOSEN IT FOR HER. I ENTERED THE HOLDING CELL AND CONTACTED PYZYNSKI WHO WAS NOW SEATED ON THE WOODEN BENCH. SHE INDICATED THAT THE LEFT HANDCUFF WAS TOO TIGHT AND THAT SHE WAS LOOSING THE FEELING IN HER LEFT ARM. I CHECKED THE LEFT WRIST AND NOTED A SMALL ABRASION ON HER LEFT WRIST WHICH WAS NO DOUBT CAUSED BY THE HANDCUFF. I LOOSENED THE CUFF TWO NOTCHES AT THIS TIME. IT SHOULD ALSO BE NOTED THAT A SILVER WRIST WATCH WAS LYING ON THE WOODEN BENCH ALONG SIDE HER. SHE INDICATED SHE HAD NO POCKETS IN HER SHORTS, THEREFORE, I PLACED THIS WATCH IN HER LEFT BREAST POCKET. THE CELL WAS THEN RE-SECURED UNTIL TRANSPORTATION TO THE DANE COUNTY JAIL COULD BE ARRANGED. SHORTLY THEREAFTER SHE WAS REMOVED FROM THE CELL AND LED TO THE WAITING SQUAD JUST OUTSIDE GATE #15. DURING THIS SHORT ESCORT FROM THE CELL TO THE SQUAD SHE STATED SOMETHING LIKE, "BOY, IT TAKES FIVE GUYS TO HANDLE SOMEONE WHO IS 5 - 2, 103 POUNDS". SHE WAS THEN PLACED IN THE SQUAD FOR TRANSPORTATION.

ON 6/26/97, AT APPROXIMATELY 9:20 AM, I RECEIVED A PHONE CALL AT 262-4522, FROM A FEMALE WHO VERBALLY IDENTIFIED HERSELF AS VICKI PYZYNSKI. SHE REQUESTED THE NAMES OF THE OFFICERS INVOLVED IN HER ARREST LAST EVENING. I INDICATED PO HORNBECK WAS THE FIRST OFFICER TO ARREST HER, AND THAT CHIEF CLEMENS WAS THE SECOND. SHE INDICATED THAT SHE WAS RELEASED FROM JAIL, WAS GOING TO HAVE A 'SIT-DOWN MEETING WITH HER BOSS TODAY', THAT SHE WAS GOING TO THE DEAN CLINIC TO HAVE HER WRIST CHECKED, AND ALSO THAT THERE WERE MORE OFFICERS INVOLVED IN HER ARRESTS THAN JUST THE TWO. I INDICATED THAT ACTUALLY THERE WERE MANY OFFICERS INVOLVED IN HER ARRESTS, HOWEVER, SHE ISN'T ENTITLED TO A COPY OF THE POLICE REPORT AT THIS TIME. SHE INDICATED HER INITIAL APPEARANCE IS SCHEDULED FOR MONDAY, JUNE 30, 1997, AT 10:00 AM. I ADVISED HER SHE WOULD BE ISSUED A COPY OF THE 'CRIMINAL COMPLAINT' AT THAT TIME. NFA

ON THE MORNING OF 06/27/97 I CONTACTED ROLAND CHRISTENSON WHO HAD BEEN EMPLOYED BY PER MAR SECURITY DURING THE CONCERT OF U2 ON THE EVENING OF 06/25/97. I WAS ADVISED BY OFFICER JOE HORNBECK ON 06/26/97 THAT HE HAD NOT BEEN ABLE TO CONTACT MR. CHRISTENSON TO OBTAIN A STATEMENT FROM HIM REGARDING THE INCIDENT IN WHICH OFFICER HORNBECK ARRESTED VICKI A. PYZYNSKI ALSO KNOWN AS VICKI A. MCKENNA ON 06/25/97 AT APPROX. 10:15 PM. ON MAKING CONTACT WITH CHRISTENSON HE STATED THAT HE IN FACT HAD BEEN WORKING THE U2 CONCERT ON THE 25TH AND HAD BEEN ASSIGNED TO THE STADIUM FLOOR SEATING. CHRISTENSON STATED THAT SOME TIME EARLIER TO THE ARREST OF THE PARTY KNOWN AS MCKENNA HE HAD BEEN CONTACTED BY A FEMALE APPROX. 40 YEARS OF AGE WHO WAS COMPLAINING ABOUT A WOMAN IN THE ROW IN WHICH SHE WAS SEATED WHO WAS SWAYING BACK AND FORTH BUMPING INTO THE UNIDENTIFIED WOMAN'S HUSBAND AND OTHER PEOPLE IN THE ROW CAUSING A DISTURBANCE AND A DISRUPTION TO THOSE ATTEMPTING TO VIEW THE CONCERT. CHRISTENSON ADVISED THE UNKNOWN FEMALE MAKING THE COMPLAINT THAT HE HAD SOMETHING TO ATTEND TO AND WOULD BE OVER TO THEIR ASSIGNED SEATING AREA AS QUICKLY AS HE COULD. CHRISTENSON STATED THAT AS HE APPROACHED THE AREA IN QUESTION OF THE FIELD SEATING HE OBSERVED THE SUBJECT, LATER IDENTIFIED AS MCKENNA, LYING ON TOP

EXACTLY WHAT HE MEANT. CHRISTENSON STATED THAT NO THE INDIVIDUALS WERE STANDING AND THAT THE WOMAN IDENTIFIED AS VICKI MCKENNA WAS LYING ON TOP OF THEM SPREAD OUT AND ATTEMPTING TO, IN HIS OPINION, CLAW AT THEM OR HIT THEM. CHRISTENSON STATED THAT BOTH THE UNIDENTIFIED FEMALES WHO CONTACTED HIM WERE VERY UPSET AND CONCERNED ABOUT THE ACTIONS OF THE SUBJECT IDENTIFIED AS MCKENNA AND THE FACT THAT SHE WAS BUMPING INTO OTHER PEOPLE IN THE ROW AND JUST MAKING A DISRUPTION IN THE IMMEDIATE AREA. CHRISTENSON STATED THAT HE WAS ABLE TO CONTACT THE SUBJECT KNOWN AS MCKENNA AND ON DOING SO HER IMMEDIATE RESPONSE TO HIM WAS "THEY'RE HITTING ME" WHICH SHE REPEATED SEVERAL TIMES TO HIM. CHRISTENSON STATED HE THEN ASKED THE SUBJECT IDENTIFIED AS MCKENNA TO COME WITH HIM OUT OF THE ROW SO THEY COULD DISCUSS THE MATTER. CHRISTENSON STATED HE HELD ONTO MCKENNA'S ARM AND BEGAN ESCORTING HER OUT OF THE ROW SHE STRUCK HIM IN THE CHEST AND THEN ATTEMPTED TO GRAB HIS SHIRT. CHRISTENSON STATED AT ABOUT THIS TIME ANOTHER GUARD EMPLOYED BY PER MAR SECURITY, FIRST NAME KNOWN ONLY TO CHRISTENSON AS LAURIE, APPROACHED TO ASSIST HIM. MY ATTENTION WAS NEXT DRAWN AWAY FROM THE CONCERT AND BACK TO PYZYNSKI WHEN I OBSERVED HER JUMP ON TOP OF A MAN SEATED IMMEDIATELY TO HER RIGHT. ANOTHER MAN, SEATED DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF PYZYNSKI, THEN JOINED THE FRAY IN AN ATTEMPT TO REMOVE PYZYNSKI FROM THE MAN ON HER RIGHT. THE MAN PYZYNSKI JUMPED, REPEATEDLY ASKED HER TO RELAX AND CALM DOWN. HE ATTEMPTED TO HOLD HER ARM SO SHE COULD NOT HIT HIM. TO KEEP HER FROM HURTING THEM. PYZYNSKI DURING THIS TIME WAS KICKING, SCRATCHING AND SCREAMING. SHE WAS ALSO TRYING TO HIT PEOPLE BUT WAS PREVENTED FROM DOING SO BECAUSE OF THE TWO MEN WHO WERE HOLDING HER ARMS.

A SECURITY PERSON THEN ARRIVED WITH A FLASHLIGHT AND ASKED WHAT WAS GOING ON. PYZYNSKI CONTINUED SCREAMING AND HITTING UNTIL SHE WAS LED FROM THE AREA BY THE SECURITY PERSON. PYZYNSKI'S FEMALE COMPANION LEFT WITH HER AT THIS TIME. THIS WAS THE LAST I SAW OF EITHER OF THESE TWO WOMEN UNTIL I SAW PYZYNSKI'S PHOTO ON TV THE NEXT NIGHT. THERE WERE NO MORE PROBLEMS IN OUR SECTION FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE CONCERT. NO ONE ELSE IN OUR SECTION EVER ATTEMPTED TO STAND ON THEIR SEATS AND BLOCK THE VIEW OF OTHERS. WHEN PYZYNSKI WAS REMOVED FROM THE SECTION, EVERYONE SEATED AROUND HER BEGAN TO APPLAUD. THIS IS AN ACCURATE ACCOUNT OF WHAT I OBSERVED ON THE EVENING OF JUNE 25TH AT THE U2 CONCERT.

HORNBECK WENT ON TO STATE THAT PYZYNSKI STRUCK BOTH THIS PERSON AND HIS WIFE. HORNBECK STATED THAT HE THOUGHT THE PERSON'S NAME IS STEVEN MILLER AND HE WORKED AT M & I BANK. UPON CONTACTING M & I BANK, THEY DID NOT HAVE ANY STEVEN MILLER WORKING THERE BUT THEY DID HAVE A STEVEN MUELLER.

ON 7/09/97 AT 11:00 A.M., I MET WITH MUELLER AT THE M & I BANK-HILLDALE CONCERNING THIS CASE. MUELLER STATED THAT HE GOT HIS TICKETS FOR THE U2 CONCERT THROUGH Z-104 AND A PERSON WHO WORKS AT HIS OFFICE. MUELLER STATED HE AND HIS WIFE AND 8-10 OTHER PEOPLE WENT TO THE CONCERT. THEIR TICKETS WERE ON THE FLOOR APPROXIMATELY 20 ROWS BACK FROM THE SECOND STAGE.

CONCERNING THIS INCIDENT, MUELLER STATED THAT HE AND HIS PARTY WERE ALL SITTING IN THEIR SEATS AND U2 HAD JUST COME ON STAGE, WHEN PYZYNSKI AND ANOTHER WHITE FEMALE CAME INTO THE AISLE WHERE THEY WERE SEATED. THE WHITE FEMALE WHO MUELLER LATER IDENTIFIED FROM A PICTURE IN THE MADISON NEWSPAPER AS PYZYNSKI CAME TO THE AISLE AND TOLD THE PEOPLE, "GET THE FUCK OUT OF OUR SEATS." MUELLER STATED THERE WERE SOME EXTRA SEATS FURTHER ON DOWN THE AISLE SO THEY MOVED ON DOWN LEAVING TWO SEATS FOR PYZYNSKI AND HER GUEST. MUELLER STATED THAT THE TWO WOMEN IMMEDIATELY STOOD UP ON THEIR CHAIRS AND THAT PYZYNSKI'S ARM KEPT HITTING MUELLER'S WIFE'S (AMY) HEAD WHILE

PYZYNSKI WAS FLAILING HER ARMS WHILE DANCING. APPARENTLY THEIR WERE WORDS EXCHANGED BETWEEN AMY MUELLER AND PYZYNSKI AND THE NEXT THING STEVEN MUELLER OBSERVED WAS PYZYNSKI GRABBING AMY MUELLER BY THE ARMS. STEVEN MUELLER STATED THAT HIS SISTER-IN-LAW, HEATHER WEDERATH, WAS SEATED NEXT TO HIS WIFE AND THEY BOTH WENT TO HIS WIFE'S AID. MUELLER STATED THAT HE REACHED IN AND HELPED PULL PYZYNSKI'S ARMS OFF OF HIS WIFE'S ARMS. STEVE MUELLER STATED THAT HE HELD ON TO PYZYNSKI AFTER HIS WIFE LEFT JUST TO KEEP HER UNDER CONTROL. STEVEN MUELLER STATED THAT PYZYNSKI GRABBED HIS SHIRT AND THEN HER HANDS MOVED UP AND WENT AROUND HIS THROAT AND THIS CAUSED BRUISING. MUELLER STATED HE HAS PICTURES OF THIS BRUISING AND WILL MAKE THEM AVAILABLE. WHILE HOLDING ONTO PYZYNSKI, STEVEN MUELLER STATED THAT SHE WAS SWEARING AT HIM AND STATED SOMETHING TO THE EFFECT, "CAN YOU SAY LAW SUITE."

STEVEN MUELLER STATED THAT A SHORT TIME LATER THE SECURITY PEOPLE SHOWED UP AND THEY SEMI-DRAGGED PYZYNSKI FROM THE AREA.

STEVEN MUELLER TURNED OVER TO ME A STATEMENT WHICH IS INCLUDED IN THIS REPORT SPELLING OUT WHAT OCCURRED AT THE CONCERT. MUELLER KNEW PYZYNSKI BE HER RADIO NAME AS VICKI MCKENNA, AND THAT'S HOW HE DESCRIBES HER IN HIS STATEMENT.

MUELLER WAS ASKED IF HE COULD SMELL INTOXICANTS ON PYZYNSKI'S BREATH AND HE STATED HE POSSIBLY COULD BUT IT WAS VERY CROWDED IN THE AREA. WHEN ASKED IF THERE WERE OTHER PEOPLE STANDING ON CHAIRS IN THE AREA, MUELLER STATED THERE WAS NOT. MUELLER WENT ON TO STATE THAT SOME OF THE PEOPLE AROUND PYZYNSKI WERE UPSET AND ASKED HER TO SIT DOWN, BUT SHE REFUSED. MUELLER'S BIG CONCERN WAS THAT HIS WIFE IS THREE MONTHS PREGNANT AND SHE WAS BEING PUSHED AROUND AND UPSET BY PYZYNSKI.

MUELLER STATED THAT WHEN HE HAS THE PICTURES DEVELOPED HE WILL GET A COPY FOR THIS CASE.

ON 7/21/97 AT 2:00 P.M., I CONTACTED AMY MUELLER BY PHONE CONCERNING THIS CASE. MUELLER STATED THAT SHE HAD BEEN TAKING A COURSE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN AND WAS NOT HOME DURING THE DAY TO RE-CONTACT ME.

AMY MUELLER STATED THAT SHE AND THEIR PARTY HAD GOTTEN TO THE CONCERT AND LISTENED TO THE WARM-UP BAND AND JUST AFTER U2 STARTED, TWO FEMALES CAME IN AND WALKED ACROSS THE BACK OF THE CHAIRS WHICH MUELLER WAS STANDING IN FRONT OF. MUELLER STATED THAT PYZYNSKI TOLD HER TO MOVE FROM THE AREA BECAUSE SHE WAS IN HER SEAT. MUELLER STATED SHE DIDN'T REMEMBER THE EXACT WORDS BUT THAT PYZYNSKI WAS TALKING IN AN AGGRESSIVE, ALMOST HOSTILE

VOICE. AS THE CONCERT CONTINUED, MUELLER STATED THAT PYZYNSKI STOOD ON HER CHAIR AND WAS DANCING AND FLAILING HER ARMS AROUND. PEOPLE STANDING BEHIND PYZYNSKI COMPLAINED, TELLING HER TO SIT DOWN, BUT PYZYNSKI STATED SOMETHING TO THE EFFECT, "I PAID \$50 FOR THIS SEAT AND I'M GOING TO SEE THE SHOW." WHILE DANCING, MUELLER STATED THAT PYZYNSKI'S ARMS HIT HER SEVERAL TIMES ON THE TOP, SIDE, AND BACK OF THE HEAD. ACCORDING TO MUELLER, PYZYNSKI WAS JUST KIND OF FLAILING HER ARMS AS SHE WAS DANCING. AS THE SHOW WENT ON, PYZYNSKI GRABBED MUELLER BY HER ARM AND SAID SHE COULD SEE THE SHOW BETTER IF SHE STOOD UP ON THE CHAIR. MUELLER TOLD PYZYNSKI THAT SHE DIDN'T WANT TO AT WHICH TIME PYZYNSKI TOLD MUELLER, "O.K., BE THAT WAY." AFTER BEING HIT ON THE HEAD ONE OR TWO MORE TIMES, MUELLER STATED SHE SAID TO PYZYNSKI, "EXCUSE ME, COULD YOU PLEASE STAY IN YOUR OWN SPACE." PYZYNSKI BECAME UPSET AT THIS AND GRABBED MUELLER AND STATED, "ARE YOU GOING TO HIT ME, I'M GOING TO KICK YOUR ASS." WHILE YELLING AT MUELLER, PYZYNSKI WAS ALSO DIGGING HER FINGERNAILS INTO HER UPPER ARMS. MUELLER STATED SHE TRIED TO GET AWAY BUT COULDN'T AND HER SISTER ALONG WITH HER HUSBAND INTERVENED AND PULLED HER AWAY FROM PYZYNSKI. AS SHE WAS LEAVING THE AREA TO GO GET SECURITY GUARDS, MUELLER STATED SHE OBSERVED PYZYNSKI WITH HER HANDS AROUND HER HUSBAND'S THROAT. MUELLER STATED THAT SHE HAD BRUISING ON HE ARMS FROM WHERE SHE WAS GRABBED BY PYZYNSKI AND WAS IN SOME PAIN.

WHEN ASKED IF SHE COULD TELL IF PYZYNSKI WAS INTOXICATED, MUELLER STATED SHE COULDN'T SMELL ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BUT SAID THAT PYZYNSKI MUST HAVE BEEN INTOXICATED BECAUSE OF THE WAY SHE WAS ACTING. WHEN ASKED WHAT SHE MEANT BY THAT, MUELLER STATED THAT PYZYNSKI WAS JUST STANDING ON THE CHAIR FLAILING HER ARMS AROUND AND DIDN'T SEEM TO BE UNDER FULL CONTROL OF HER FACULTIES. CONCERNING HER BEING PREGNANT, I ASKED MUELLER IF SHE HAD ANY COMPLICATIONS BECAUSE OF THIS ALTERCATION AND SHE STATED SHE DID NOT. A COPY OF THE STATEMENT GIVEN TO ME BY STEVEN MUELLER WILL BE INCLUDED WITH THIS REPORT.
