

FISHING RULES

As a Holiday Home Owner or Guest at Patrington Haven Leisure Park, our well-stocked lake has been reserved for your exclusive use from 7 February to the 6 January annually. We as Patrington Haven Leisure Park will act as the head bailiff and will organise all other Park appointed bailiffs to oversee the good running of the fishing lake.

To use the fishing lake you will need an Owners/Visitors Fishing Day Ticket these are available to purchase at www.countryclubpatrington.co.uk. An Environment Agency Fishing Licence; 12 – 16 Junior, 17+ Senior, are available from local post offices or online. Please refer to the Park Rules for further information. **Bailiffs** do patrol this lake and have the right to ask you to leave if you do not have the correct licence and permit to fish.

The following rules apply and must be adhered to:

1. All anglers must hold a valid Environment Agency Licence and produce it together with a valid owner/visitor pass, when required.
2. No children, under the age of 15, are permitted to fish the water alone; they must be accompanied by an experienced adult angler.
3. The general rules and regulations adopted by all recognised angling clubs apply to this water.
4. Do not feed the ducks.
5. All fish must be landed using a landing net, this means one per angler.
6. All Anglers must have their own landing net and disgorgers – minimum requirement.
7. Anglers must reel in if you leave your peg.
8. Fishing is only allowed from the platforms provided.
9. Leave the peg clean of rubbish when finished angling - this includes cigarette ends.
10. Carp, when caught, must be unhooked on grass or carp mat.
11. You may only use barbless hooks with a maximum size of 12.
12. Running rigs only when using feeders and ledgers or bombs.
13. Fishing is only allowed from 7 a.m. until the Park's streetlights turn on at nightfall.
14. No extreme consumption of alcohol on or around the fishing pegs.

BAIT

Only the following baits are **ALLOWED**: natural carp pellets, natural carp pellet paste, maggots (any colour), luncheon meat on the HOOK ONLY & not coloured, sweet corn (yellow only), worms, bread (sinking only), castors, PVA. If it is not on the list above, it is **not allowed**.

THE FOLLOWING ARE NOT ALLOWED:

- A. No Additives to the bait clear or coloured.
- B. The use of Luncheon meat for feeding, it is hook bait only.
- C. No Floating Bait. (especially bread)
- D. No Barbed hooks.
- E. No Keep nets. (Unless special dispensation for matches, agreed by the Park)
- F. No Wading or boat fishing.
- G. No Ground baiting.
- H. Fishing more than one rod is not allowed.
- I. Media, without earphones.
- J. Parking by the lake.
- K. The throwing of any missile or the dumping of any form of refuse.
- L. Behaviour likely to cause hindrance or annoyance to fellow anglers.
- M. No dogs.
- N. No electronic bite alarms.
- O. No braided line allowed

Persistent offenders will lose their rights to fish the lake, with no re-imburement of fees. The companies' decision is final on all matters.
