Why are we meeting?

Migrants, refugees, asylum seekers - arrive and stay in our countries. The success of their integration depends mainly on how they are welcomed. The project "Together in Europe" focuses on practical issues related to the support of newcomers, the exchange of good practices in the field of inclusion and networking of youth workers.

An important element of the project is also to increase the knowledge of participants on EU legislation on protection. Particular attention will be paid to the deportation of migrants to the first EU Member State of arrival and the lack of a rapid response mechanism and continuation of support for deportees.

The aim of the project is to improve the quality of youth workers, build networks for effective international cooperation, increase the knowledge, and effectively prevent radicalization of youth, both in host communities and between immigrants.

For whom?

Association Zwrotnica (Poland) is happy to invite you to take part in our Training Course "Together in Europe". It will involve 23 youth workers from 7 countries: Greece, Italy, Poland, Spain, Slovenia - countries, which for asylum seekers are the first in EU/Schengen borders, Sweden and Germany - the final destinations.

For 8 days you will have the opportunity to: get acquainted with the situation of migrants in other EU countries get to know the experiences of other groups, build a network of contacts with activists and meet asylum seekers in Poland.

There will be time to talk, discuss, exchange experiences and start creating new cooperation.

Who can take part in the training:

- There is no age limit.
- There is no participation fee.
- The language of the project is English, so at least basic knowledge is a must.
- Training is dedicated to people working or interested in working with young migrants and refugees.
- Participants need to be over 18.

What we expect from you:

- Take full and active part in the program.
- Prepare and share information about asylum seekers situation in their countries.
- Fulfill participant's report by the need of activity.
- Disseminate the results of the project.

Participants will be chosen by the partner organizations with the cooperation of the leader one. All of those who has already contacted the partner organization and got a confirmation about being chosen to take part in the training are kindly asked to fill in [the form](#).

The results and final confirmation about the participants will be announced on 12th of March. Before this date please **DO NOT PURCHASE** any tickets.

Where and when?

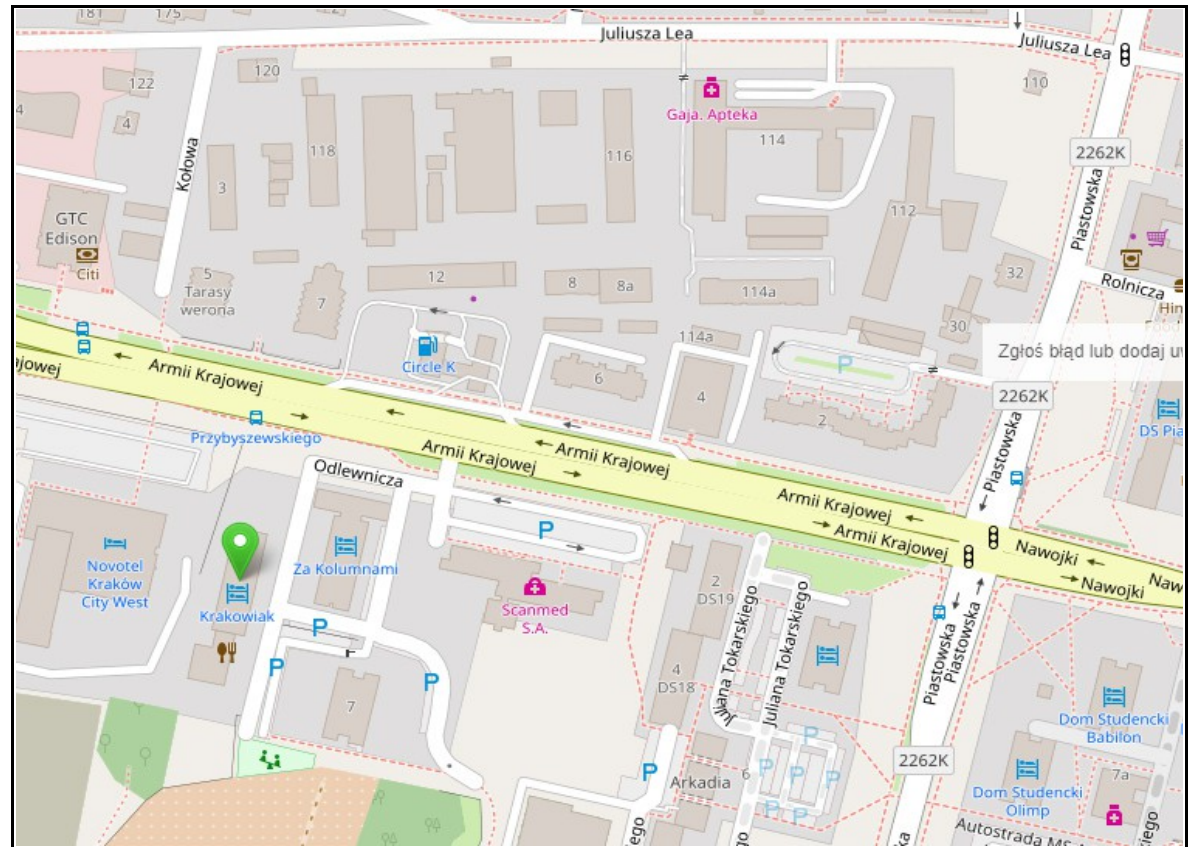
The training course "**Together in Europe**" will take place in **Krakow** from **7th (arriving day) to 14th (departure day) of April 2018**.

Lodging: The training course will take place in [Hotel Krakowiak](#).

Transport: From the Kraków – Balice Airport you can get to the city center by city buses (it costs 5 PLN). Bus 208 goes directly to hotel (stop: Przybyszewskiego). Bus 252 runs to the main trainstation. The time tabel you can chcek [here](#).

The costs of travel will be reimbursed according to Erasmus+ travel framework up to:

IMPORTANT! The reimbursements will be possible only upon submitting original travel documents: **E-ticket, Invoice, Proof of payment or receipt, Boarding passes**. Please remember to prepare all the documents in advance, which means – you must have with you return tickets as well! For those of you traveling by plane – please check if it is possible to do the check-in on-line. All travel documents must include: price, travel route, date of purchase, date of travel. Only the cheapest fair (2nd class) and route can be covered. Reimbursements will be done by bank transfer after the end of the mobility.

Insurance

The organizers do not provide participants with any form of insurance for the time of the project and the insurance won't be reimburse. You are strongly advised to make sure you have a valid medical insurance. We recommend if it is possible to bring with you European Medical Card. We will not be able to reimburse any of your losses so it is better for you to take care of that in advance.
