Subject : Living Conditions Route de Remich caused by continuous road works

Dear Mr. Roland Fox,

The purpose of this letter is to support the letter at reference – page 1 and 7 enclosed for your convenience – and to personally share with you the various nuisances, disturbances and unsafe situations that my family has been experiencing as a result of the continuous road works on and around Route de Remich.

My family moved to our current address in February 2016 and we have been astonished by the seemingly never-ending road works that are taking place on Route de Remich ever since. Aside from additional traffic jams on an already extremely busy road during traffic hours and holidays, my family has been experiencing amongst others:

- an at times extremely unsafe environment for my daughters (currently 9, 7 and 2 years old) directly around the house;
- damage to the house as a result of the trucks driving on the road which is full of uneven patches of asphalt – all the doorframes on my second floor came loose due to the vibrations;
- impact road work noise on my children – certainly for the youngest during nap time;
- lack of air quality – particles, nitrogen, etc.

We are looking forward to receiving an answer on the questions raised in the letter at reference.
