First, apply a primer coat of Epoxy-Shell Tinted (use Black Knight #950 for dark colors or use a light-colored primer for light metallics). Pigments are then mixed with Epoxy-Shell and applied on top of the primer. A topcoat of Poly-Shell is recommended for additional chemical and abrasion resistance.
