Response to your request for official information

Thank you for your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) to the Ministry of Health (the Ministry) on 10 March 2022 for information about the *Cumulative Analysis of Post-Authorization Adverse Event Reports of PF-07302048 (BNT162B2) Received Through 28-Feb-2021* document (hereafter the Cumulative Analysis Report). Specifically, you asked:

- “1) were you aware of ANY of these side effects before recommending ANY vaccination in this country?
- 2) were you aware of ANY of these side effects before recommending mass roll out?
- 3) were you aware of ANY of these side effects before mandating certain job types?
- 4) were you aware of ANY of these side effects before opening vaccination for 5-11 year olds?
- 5) when were you aware of some of these side effects?
- 6) when were you aware of many of these side effects?
- 7) when were you aware of all of these side effects?”

The Ministry received numerous requests about the genesis of the Cumulative Analysis Report and has published responses to three of them on its website. They are available under the 12 January 2022 publication date for *Information on Pfizer Cumulative Analysis Report* at: www.health.govt.nz/about-ministry/information-releases/responses-official-information-act-requests. Your request is therefore refused under section 18(d) of the Act on the grounds that the information sought is publicly available.
