May Allah put barakah, all goodness and blessings for everyone, in this short booklet. May it benefit everyone and may it be a beginning of Guidance, with Allah's will.



What are the types of Knowledge that needs to be learned?

The scope of discussion is extremely wide, when we discuss on knowledge. However, in general, Islamic knowledge is divided into two – Fardhu 'Ain and Fardhu Kifayah.

Fardhu 'Ain is the knowledge that is obligatory upon every sane Muslim individual that has reached the age of puberty, to learn and practice. One will be deemed sinful if they were to willingly abandon it.

This knowledge is within the scope of the basics of Islam, which is faith, code of living and manners.

Anas ibn Malik reported:

The Messenger of Allah , peace and blessings be upon him, said, "Seeking knowledge is an obligation upon every Muslim."



What is Fardhu 'Ain?

Fardhu 'Ain is that which is <u>obligated on</u> <u>every single Muslim</u> that falls under the category of Mukallaf (a sane minded person who has reached puberty) such as praying, fasting, pilgrimage for those who afford.

These acts of worship are obligatory for each individual accountable.



What is Fardhu Kifayah?

Fardhu Kifayah is that which is <u>obligated on</u> <u>a Muslim community</u>, not individually.

Meaning: When part of the community does it, the rest of the community will not be held accountable. However, when not a single person in the community does it, the whole community will be sinful.

For example: Funeral process.



Types of Fardhu 'Ain

The Proof of Islam by Imam Ghazali (may Allah be pleased with him), have deduced this knowledge into the Knowledge of dealings, which involves

1) Knowledge of Faith ('Ilm Akidah)

'Ilm Akidah touches on the Muslim witnessing pillars of faith and Islam. (Rukun Iman & Rukun Islam)

2) Knowledge of Actions ('Ilm Fi'il)

'Ilm Fi'il touches on the perfection of one's acts of worship ('Ibadah) such as purification, prayers, fasting, zakat and Hajj Pilgrimage.

3) Knowledge of avoidance ('Ilm Tark)

'Ilm Tark touches on prohibitions that is obligatory upon a Muslim to avoid, such as killing, adultery, drinking of alcohol, gambling and even illnesses of the heart that needs to be treated such as jealousy, hatred, revenge and others.

Some Branches of Islamic Knowledge

ISLAMIC CREED (TAWHID)

The word 'Tawhid' comes from the root word "wa-ha-da" which means One. Tawhid means monotheism, to declare the Oneness of Allah being the lord and share any partners in His Lordship. In Tawhid, we also learn the Names and Attributes of Allah to differentiate between Him and His Creation.

RECITATION OF AL-QURAN (QIRA'AH)

There are different levels of knowledge on reading the Qur'an. From the very basic level of learning the Arabic alphabets and phonetics (Iqra') to reading the Qur'an with full knowledge of Tajwid (set of rules for correct pronunciation)

SAYINGS AND ACTIONS OF PROPHET MUHAMMAD (HADITH)

Hadith is the compilation of actions and sayings of the Prophet Muhamad (peace be upon him) that were mainly gathered by his companions around him during his lifetime.

SPIRITUALITY (TASAWWUF)

Tasawwuf is the purification of the heart from the recurrence creaturely temptations, instilling good character and following the footsteps of Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him).

TRANSLATION OF AL-QURAN (TAFSIR)

Tafsir is the knowledge of understanding The Holy Qur'an in depth through the works of interpretations by classic Islamic Scholars.

HISTORY OF THE PROPHET(S) (SIRAH)

Sirah is the knowledge of history. There are wide ranges of Sirah, from the Prophets, the companions, men and women around the prophet and the pious people after them.

Specifically, from learning the Sirah of our Beloved Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him), our love for him will increase and we will strive to follow his noble character.

JURISPRUDENCE (FIQH)

Fiqh in literal translation means understanding. Another meaning for it, is the understanding and knowledge of the guidance and rulings that Allah SWT has placed upon us.





MEETING MUHAMMAD










MUQADDAM, LET'S RECITE THE QUR'AN

This edition also includes the step-by-step illustrations for the respective two, three, and four raka'at prayers. May these guides be useful to all Muslims and especially new converts to Islam.








THE SPLENDID PEARL IN KNOWING THE MUSLIM'S INDIVIDUAL OBLIGATIONS




THAHARAH: RULES OF PURIFICATION IN ISLAM

This volume covers the subject of Thaharah or purity. Purification is essential for Muslims as it is a requirement to be fulfilled before performing our daily prayers.








THE CHAPTER OF PRAYER


Written in a structured and easy-to-understand manner, this book helps readers refine their prayer and provide many answers to issues and queries encountered by many people in performing their prayer.






BOOK OF ASSISTANCE BY IMAM AL-HADDAD




AL-GHAZALI'S FORTY PRINCIPLES OF THE RELIGION




THR BOOK OF KNOWLEDGE FOR CHILDREN
