



Coach Mentoring Program

Make a lasting impact on a student through career mentoring!

Coach Mentoring is an impactful opportunity for professionals seeking to support young people along their career exploration journey. Coach Mentoring matches students with professionals via cohorts based on career industry or affinity space (i.e. Black, Spanish-speaking, Women in STEAM.)

How It Works:

PLAN: Join an informational meeting with DPS staff. Mentor onboarding includes completing the online application, a background check, interview, and a pre-session training.

MEET: Mentoring sessions are held at a variety of Denver Public Schools, ensuring there is a convenient location for all mentors

EXPLORE: Through each monthly session, mentors collaborate with students as they develop their career identity and learn about career pathways.

RELATE: Support your assigned student with creating their own career plan and developing work-readiness and soft skills.

Coach Mentoring Program Highlights

- **Middle/High School** Students
- **Cohort Size** 10-14 students
- **2.5 Hours/Month** Sept-April
- **No Cost Opportunity** for companies/mentors



Program Outcomes

- **95% of mentors** report being well-matched with their mentee and feeling comfortable in the relationship.
- **100% of mentors** said they feel proud to work for an organization that gives back to programs like Coach Mentoring.
- **96% of mentors** said the programming helped them prepare their mentee for the future.
- **96% of students** said they have an increased understanding of their career path after participating in the program
