2. Provide only the information that is asked. When filling out an online resume, fill out only the details that the employer will need to assess you and your competency for the job offer. Other than these pieces of information do not provide any other especially your social security number.
3. If you are applying through an agency, make sure that the agency is licensed and accredited. This is another step that is very important especially if you are applying for overseas jobs. There have been a lot of stories where people get scammed by people posing as representatives from accredited agencies when in fact, the person and the agency that they represent are both bogus.
4. Be vigilant and wary about job offers that you receive. There will be instances when you will receive job offers through email and they will be offering you salary packages that are just too good to be turned down. Before you respond to these email, research first about the company. There have been a lot of identity theft criminals who send email scams to lure you into divulging your personal identity. Be very cautious!
5. Do not give out cash. When you apply for [jobs](#) and you get a reply asking you to pay a certain amount, think twice before dealing with the site. This is a very unusual practice and no legitimate recruitment agency will do such thing. That would be a clear sign that the job post that you applied to was a scam.
