



COMPETITION RULES

The competition to be developed within the framework of the Master's Surf Reunion will be held under the rules of the ISA and the WSL, the highest recognized organizations in the sport of surfing at an international level.

Categories:

Master: 35 years and over.

Grand Master: 40 years and over.

Kahuna: 45 years and older.

Great Kahuna: 50 years and older.

Legend: 55 years and over.

Master Ladies: Ladies over 35 years of age.

Father-Son: Competition in teams made up of a Master father and his son of any age.

Grand Final Top 8 MSR7: Competition between the best 8 competitors of the event, 4 national and 4 international.

To apply for a specific category the competitor must have reached the required age by the date of the event.

A competitor may compete in one or several additional categories of younger age, if it is authorized by the Competition Director, depending on the number of competitors in the event and the time available.

Verification of the category to which the competitor belongs will be carried out by an official of the event at the time of its registration, presenting the competitor's identity document or passport.

In addition to the categories to which the competitor applies by age, he can always participate in the Father-Son category where the father must be a Master competitor and the son can be of any age.

Due to the large number of competitors expected in the Master's Surf Meeting 7, participation in two categories maximum + Father-Son will be allowed. This could change the day of confirmation of registrations.

Registration cost: US\$40. Second category US\$30 and third US\$20.

Note: In the case of father son these amounts are for the team (father + son)

From the Heats:

Heats must have a minimum time of 15 minutes and a maximum of 30 minutes. This will be determined by the Competition Director depending on the number of competitors in the event, available time, and wave conditions.

The start of each heat will be determined by a blast of the horn; the end will be determined by two blasts of the horn. In addition, there will be flags for visual orientation. The green flag will mean that the heat is active; the yellow flag that remains 5 minutes; the red flag that the heat is over or that it is time out.

5 minutes before the end of a heat, the competitors of the next heat will be sent to the water to wait for the start of their heat in the water. While on standby they must stay out of the peak zone so as not to interfere with the competitors in the active heat.

The heats will be 4 competitors, and this amount can be varied in special cases with a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 6.

Each competitor must take a maximum of 10 waves in the heat, of which the 2 waves with the highest score will be counted.

The qualification of repechage rounds will depend on the availability of time and the number of competitors at the discretion of the competition director.

The heats will be structured according to the known ranking of the participants.

In extreme surfing conditions, the use of caddies will be allowed and assistance with Jet Ski will be enabled.

From the discretion of the judges

Wave scores will be from 1-10 points. 1-2: Bad; 2-4: Regular; 4-6: Good; 6-8: very good; 8-10: Excellent.

The competitor will need to execute controlled radical maneuvers in the most critical sections of the wave with speed, power, and fluidity to maximize his scoring potential. An innovative and progressive surfing as well as a good variety of maneuvers will be valued by the judges. The competitor who performs under this criteria with the highest degree of difficulty and determination in the waves, will have the highest score.

Father Son Category: The heats will be made up of 2 or 3 teams of (1) Father and (1) Son; the best wave of the father and son will be added to determine the positions in the heat.

Expression session

The competitors that will be invited to the Expression Session will be the highest level Open. The heats will be from 6 to 10 competitors from 20 to 25 minutes, depending on the amount registered. The best performance with 3 places will be rewarded and for the best executed maneuver, such as the best Aerial or the best Tube.

Overall and National Winners:

In the Master, Grand Master, Kahuna, Gran Kahuna and Legend categories, the first three (3) finalists of each category will be awarded in an Overall line and the best (3) national surfers in each category will also be awarded in a national line which a national surfer can opt for both prizes if he wins a category while also being the best national.

It will be a single competition, with a single draw, where those who occupy the first places in the competition will be the winners in the "Overall" line; the winners of the "National" category will be determined considering the Dominican competitors
