Q. What was your first "official" nudist event / action which you participated in?

A. Steve - Formally' that was finally going to a pretty avarage mid-sized camp. Typical storyline; frightened stiff (not there!) Angie - Different camp, same storyline!

Q. In your view, what is the difference between Nudism & Naturism? (If there's one)

A. Practically, not substantially. You can't tell a naturist from a naturist at a strand or camp, and most people don't care anyway. We share a mutual enjoyment of social nudity and subscribe to common ideals seeing social naturism, that's enough. Let

Q. What does it mean to be a naturist / nudist?

A. If you mix the interpretations provided by the world's naturist/naturist organizations you develop a community ideal that will be environmentally conscious, socially inclusive, family friendly, non-sexual by nature, non judgmental, respectful and well behaved. We can go with that. Oh, and naked!

We have the highest hopes for FKK. The organization is doing a spectacular job of getting the word out that it exists and in marketing its social plan and events, but has neglected to reach into the entire naturist/naturist community to make its philosophical position clear. We here online can hear you, but most nudists /naturists will not. They will, however, hear about FKK from friends and/or easily misunderstood media promotions or news articles.

Is this a common occurrence in the naturist movement, and why would you believe this is occurring?

A. If it is, not freely. Any negative statements we learn about organizations are either scenario-specific, ie, failure to act, issues of propriety, or generalized questions/gripes such as, "What are they doing for us?" or more specifically, "What am I getting for my money?"

Q. If you could offer one bit of guidance, for the nudist / naturist movement generally or FKK specifically, what would that be?

A. Unite. Infighting hurts everyone and separate plans divide us. Balanced Bare only posted an article about a planned convention directed towards young naturist groups, but we would

expand it to include any and all who'd participate. Naturism has lived this far because we all subscribed to much of exactly the same ideals; that solidarity is endangered now by intergroup competitions and differing concepts of what naturism should represent. We desire a commonly agreed upon creed we can all support and uphold together.
