An Old New-World Wine Country

- Wine has been made in Chile since the mid 16th century
- Vines were brought by the Spanish 'Conquistadors'
- The 'classic' vine varieties such as Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot,
 Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc were brought from France in the middle of 19th century
- Carmenere arrived from Bordeaux in mid-19th century (before phylloxera) but was not properly identified until 1994
- Although best known for its red wines, mainly Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Carmenere, some of Chile's most exciting wines are now from Sauvignon Blanc, Viognier, Gewürztraminer, Pinot Noir, and Syrah/Shiraz

Chile's Unique Geography

Chiles geographic barriers – the Atacama Desert to the north, the Andes Mountains to the east, the Patagonian ice fields to the south and the Pacific Ocean to the west – make Chile a veritable agricultural 'island'.

Together they help maintain healthy conditions and protect vineyards against pests and disease. With a geography as diverse as Chile's you can be sure that the climate will have terrific variation.

Facts about Chile

- 1. Chile is one of only two countries in the whole of South America that does not border Brazil.
- 2. Over a fifth of the world's copper production is produced in Chile. The Escondida Copper Mine in Northern Chile is the world's largest producing mine with 350 million tons per year.
- 3. Valparaiso is one of the most prosperous cities in Chile and is known as "The Garden City". It has now been recognised as one of the world's Great Wine Capitals.
- 4. Chile has one of the world's largest and most arid deserts known as the Atacama. The longest spell without rain was 40 years.
- 5. Chile has farmed salmon for many years and it is one of its main exports.
- 6. Contrary to popular belief that soccer is the most popular sport in Chile it is actually tennis.
- 7. Chile's Andes mountains have some of the world's largest active volcanoes, there are over 1500.
- 8. Most of the Chilean population (17.5 million) lives in and around the capital city of Santiago (7million).
- 9. The "Maoi" island, 3600 km off the coast of Chile, belongs to Chile and was renamed Easter Island in the late 1700's.
- 10. One of the fastest growing cities in Chile is La Serena. It has grown by as much as 30 % in the last 30 years.
- 11. The inlet at the top of Africa was part of Chile in the days of the Pangaea (a supercontinent that existed during the Paleozoic period and formed 300 million years ago.)
- 12. The city of Valparaiso hosts the largest annual fireworks show in the whole of South America.
- 13. Chile owns a part of Antarctica, as well as the southernmost island known as Joses.
- 14. The city at the very tip of Chile called Punta Arenas is the southernmost city on a continent in the world.
- 15. The southernmost village in the world is also in Chile, it is called Puerto Williams.

More facts about Chile

- 16. Chile has the one of the highest lakes above sea level in the world called Lake Chungara. At 4600 metres above sea level, 196 km north of Arica, it is inhabited by thousands of flamingos.
- 17. Chile has one of the longest coastlines in the world.
- 18. The name, Chile, is thought to have come from the native population that used to roam the land and it meaning translates as "where the land's end".
- 19. The Observatory Paranal located on the Paranal Mountain in Atacama contains one of the largest telescopes in the world. In this area the skies are clear 350 nights a year.
- 20. Some of the best ski slopes in the Southern Hemisphere are only one hour's drive from Santiago.
- 21. Chile has produced two Nobel Prize winners: Gabriela Mistral and Pablo Neruda, both poets.
- 22. Valparaiso, one of Chile's main ports, has been declared a World Heritage Site.
- 23. Chile is one of the few countries in the world where selling an item to a customer and not giving a receipt is considered a crime and is punishable.
- 24. One of the biggest pot plants in the world, a Chilean palm, can be found in the glasshouse in Kew Gardens. The magnificent specimen of Jubaea Chilensis rises almost 18 m in height, it was re-potted in 1930.
- 25. In the 1930's the sub editor of the Times ran a competition to see who could write the most boring headline. The winner was 'Small Earthquake in Chile. Not many dead'. It proved to be a hollow joke, 30 years later when the strongest earthquake ever recorded hit Chile, over 3000 people died and 18000 homes were lost.
- 26. The biggest swimming pool in the world is in Chile. It is located on the coastal resort of San Alfonso del Mar.
- 27. The Chilean word *achaplinarse* means to run about in the style of Charlie Chaplin!
- 28. Manchester City's manager Manuel Pellegrini is Chilean! As is Arsenal's Alexis Sanchez.
