## Mandate reconfirmation: follow up

We are writing to seek a response to our 7 June 2016 letter to you that requested Te Rūnanga-ā-iwi o Ngāti Kahu undertakes a mandate reconfirmation process with the people of Ngāti Kahu.

In that letter, we outlined a process (**attached** for your reference at Appendix One) that is designed to be robust and transparent. We seek confirmation of whether Te Rūnanga-ā-iwi o Ngāti Kahu is willing to undertake the proposed mandate reconfirmation process.

As stated in our 7 June letter, if Te Rünanga-ā-iwi o Ngāti Kahu does not agree to undertake a mandate reconfirmation process we will need to consider whether it remains appropriate to continue to recognise its mandate to represent Ngāti Kahu in Treaty settlement negotiations with the Crown.

Please respond to this matter by 9 September 2016.
