## **THE PLAN**

### **What is Project 2024?**

*“A collective effort to break the two-party system by flooding the United States House of Representatives with Independent candidates in the 2024 November Elections.”*

1. Unite under the common understanding that neither democrats NOR republicans are fit to hold office and organize with the intent of replacing them with independent candidates who represent the will of the people.

2. Focus on the U. S. House of Representatives (ALL 435 seats are up for election in November 2024, and some go unopposed).

3. Organize within our local congressional districts to identify candidates we believe will uphold our values (ie; have never and will never accept money from special interests groups, private or corporate lobbyists, or political action committees (PACs).

4. Campaign and crowdfund for the candidates using social media and technology as integral tools to achieve end-goal of candidates election

5. Take the House

6. Take the Senate

7. Take the state congressional seats

8. Take EVERY level of government all the way down to the school boards

9. [Campaign Finance Reform](#) as a #1 priority

9. Build a better world

## **STEP 1**

### **Finding Your Community**

Finding your community is STEP 1.

Your community HAS to consist of the people nearest you - The people in your town, city, district, and state. You will need a majority of their buy-in to achieve the goal of electing an independent candidate to your desired seat.

Project 2024 aims to take over seats in the U. S. House of Representatives in the November elections of 2024.

The U. S. House of Representatives consists of 435 elected positions. These elected officials are also the ones who decide how our American tax dollars are spent.

ALL 435 U. S. House seats are up for grabs in 2024.

Some of the seats go **unopposed**.

**NONE** of the seats should go to a republican OR or Democrat, as we have awakened to the fact **the two-party system is a sham meant to pit us against each other.**

**Step 1** is to find your community within your congressional district.

There are several ways to do this:

1. [Join the Discord](#)
2. Reach out to local labor unions.
3. Reach out to local organizers as they have been leading the resistant and revolution for many years. Some of these may include the [Party for Socialism and Liberation](#) (PSL) or [Democratic Socialists of American](#) (DSA). Ask these leaders how you can help. Ask if they have a candidate in mind.
4. Unite under the goal of putting an independent into U. S. House of Representatives.
5. Become a real part of this newfound community, lending a hand in whatever capacity is available to you.

## STEP 2

### Finding Your Community's Candidate

As stated in the previous chapter, try to find local unions/socialist groups in your area and see if they already have candidates in mind.

If there are no candidates, find one along with the help of your newfound community.

## **STEP 3**

### **Organizing with your Community**

## **Step 4**

### **Getting Your Candidate's Name on the Ballot**

1. Pay attention to filing deadlines!
2. You WILL need to collect signatures from voters in the district
3. There will be some administrative paperwork to be filled out

## **Step 5**

### **Campaigning For Your Candidate**

1. Social media/technology are key parts of the strategy
  2. You will also need people with boots on the ground
  3. DO NOT ENGAGE with anyone trying to sew discord or spout hateful rhetoric — these are not your target audience
  4. Your target audience is the people who are undecided, the people who are reasonable but misinformed, and ANYONE who voices disdain for the two-party system
  5. Your mission is to bring people in while protecting yourself from the ops

## Step 6 After the Election

The below is the agenda that **must** be supported by any person who wishes to hold an elected position within the United States of America:

1. [Campaign Finance Reform](#)
2. Implementation of Term Limits
3. Tax-dollar-funded healthcare
4. Tax-dollar-funded education
5. No more aid/money to ANY foreign entity for the purposes imperialist expansion, genocide, war, or subjugation of a population
6. Automatic voter registration
7. Time off to vote on election days
