

Minecraft Player Builds Playable Uno

Have you ever every played Uno? It's all about losing your hand the quickest, and it tends to deliver out the shark in anybody who plays. Someone's made a totally functioning model in Minecraft, and the multiplayer game is no much less ruthless.

Uno has its personal, particular form of 108 card deck, and rounds can involve up to 4 players. Below the desk is a minecart that takes the playing cards, and leads them again to into the mechanism that distributes them back out.

Cards are drawn from the deck by way of a chest that, when activated, is given a seemingly-random card from the deck, every player does this till they've a full hand. The cards have all been designed using completely different kinds of redstone, and shulkers that match as much as the values of said redstone then hand them out. It's an elaborate system, however it works, as you may see within the video under.
