Iriel, the 'blue poster', has a lengthy post about the changes to the UI elements in Wrath of the Lich King. Tech-savvy UI-tweaks will find a lot there, with new unit functions as well as many tweaks to how the old ones worked. Even better, it sounds almost like a lot of our user-created information, from Macros key bindings and UI settings, will be stored on Blizzard servers.
